What you will need:

RED HEART® Boutique Treasure™:
3 balls 1918 Abstract, 1901
Mosaic, or 1913 Spectrum

Susan Bates® Crochet Hook:
6mm [US J-10]

Stitch marker, yarn needle

GAUGE: 12 sts = 4" [10cm]; 9
rows/rounds = 4" [10cm]. **CHECK**
YOUR GAUGE. Use any size hook
to obtain the gauge.

SHOP KIT



Igloo Snail Hat and Scarf

*This clever hat is crocheted without joining
the rounds and reminded the designer of a
snail's shell...thus the name, Snail Hat. Add a
scarf for the perfect set to warm you. This is
a superb gift set idea!*

Directions are for size Small; changes for
sizes Large are in parentheses

Hat Circumference: 20 (22)" (51 (56) cm)
Scarf measures 6" x 60", (15 cm x 152.5 cm)

NOTE

Hat is worked in continuous rounds, working
in back loops only of each st throughout.
Scarf is worked in front loops of only of each
st throughout.

HAT

Ch 4, slip st to first ch to form a ring.

Round 1: Ch 3 (counts as dc here and
throughout), work 11 dc into ring – 12 dc.
Place marker for beginning of round.

Round 2: Working in back loops only
throughout, 2 dc in each dc around – 24 dc.

Round 3: [2 dc in next st, dc in next dc]
around – 36 dc.

Round 4: [2 dc in next st, dc in next 2 dc]
around – 48 dc.

Round 5: [2 dc in next st, dc in next 3 dc]
around – 60 dc.

For Large Size Only

Round 6: [2 dc in next st, dc in next 9 dc]
around – 66 dc.

For All Sizes

Next Round: Dc in each dc around.

Repeat last round until piece measures 6"
[15cm] from beginning, end 3 sts before
beginning marker, hdc in next st, sc in next st,
slip st in last st.
Fasten off.

SCARF

Ch 22.

Row 1: Working in front loops only, dc in 4th
ch from hook and in each ch across – 20 dc.

Row 2: Ch 1, turn, working in front loops only,
sc in each st across.

Row 3: Ch 3, turn, dc in each st across.
Repeat last 2 rows until piece measures 60"
[152.5cm], end with Row 2.
Fasten off.

FINISHING

Weave in ends.

Abbreviations

ch = chain; **dc** = double crochet; **hdc** = half
double crochet; **mm** = millimeters; **sc** = single
crochet; **st(s)** = stitch(es); **[]** = work directions
in brackets the number of times specified.
