CD110-02 Granny Square Turtleneck

Skill Level 3: Intermediate

Directions are for Size Small; changes for Sizes Medium, and Large made by using different size hooks.

J.&P. Coats® "Luster Sheen®", 100% acrylic, Art. E721, 4 oz (335 yard) skeins, 3 (4, 4) skeins No. 0001 White **CA**, 1 (2, 2) skeins No. 0517 Turquoise **CB**, 1 (2, 2) skeins No. 425 Blulette **CC**.

SUSAN BATES® Crochet Hook:
S = C-2 [2.75mm] and D-3 [3.25mm].
M = C-2 [2.75mm] and E-4 [3.5mm].
L = D-3 [3.25mm] and F-5 [3.75mm].

GAUGE: Each square = 2.25 (2.5, 2.75)".

CHECK YOUR GAUGE. Use any size hook to obtain the gauge given.

To Fit Chest: 32 (36, 40)"

Finished Chest Measurement: 36 (40, 44)".

2 color Granny Square:

30 CA/CB, 30 CB/CC

With larger hook and first color ch 4, slip st in first ch to form ring.

Rnd 1 WS: Ch 4 (counts as first tr now and throughout), work 3 dc, 2 tr, 3 dc, tr in ring changing to second color on last st, work tr, 3 dc, 2 tr, 3 dc, tr in ring, sl st in 4th ch of beg ch 4; turn.

Rnd 2 RS: Sl st in last tr worked, ch 4, work 2 dc in same st, * dc in next 3 dc, (2 dc, tr) in next tr, (tr, 2 dc) in next tr, dc in next 3 dc, (2 dc, tr) in next tr * changing to first color in last st, (tr, 2 dc) in next tr, rep from * to *, sl st in 4th ch of beg ch 4. Fasten off.

1 color Triangle (right armhole shaping):

CA

With larger hook and **CA** ch 4, slip st in first ch to form ring.

Row 1 WS: Ch 4, work 3 dc, 2 tr, 3 dc, tr in ring; turn.

Row 2 RS: Ch 4, work 2 dc in same st, * dc in next 3 dc, (2 dc, tr) in next tr *, (tr, 2 dc) in next tr, rep from * to *. Fasten off.

2 color Triangle (left armhole shaping):

CB/CC

With larger hook and **CB** ch 4, slip st in first ch to form ring.

Row 1 WS: Ch 4, work 3 dc, tr, in ring changing to **CC** in last st, work tr, 3 dc, tr, in ring, turn; turn.

Row 2 RS: Ch 4, work 2 dc in same st, * dc in next 3 dc, (2 dc, tr) in next tr * changing to **CB** in last st, (tr, 2 dc) in next tr, rep from * to *. Fasten off.

3 / 4 Granny (right neck shaping):

CB/CC

With larger hook and **CB** ch 4, slip st in first ch to form ring.

Row 1 WS: Ch 4, work 3 dc, tr in ring changing to **CC** in last st, work tr, 3 dc, 2 tr, 2 dc in ring; turn.

Row 2 RS: Ch 3 (counts as first dc now and throughout), dc in next dc, (2 dc, tr) in next tr, * (tr, 2 dc) in next tr, dc in next 3 dc, (2 dc, tr) in next tr * changing to **CB** in last st, rep from * to *. Fasten off.

3 / 4 Granny (left neck shaping):

CB/CC

With larger hook and **CB** ch 4, slip st in first ch to form ring.

Row 1 WS: Ch 3, work dc, tr in ring changing to **CC** in last st, work tr, 3 dc, 2 tr, 3 dc, tr in ring; turn.

Row 2 RS: Ch 4, work 2 dc in same st, * dc in next 3 dc, (2 dc, tr) in next tr *, (tr, 2 dc) in next tr, rep from * to * changing to **CB** in last st, (tr, 2 dc) in next tr, dc in next 2 dc. Fasten off.

Sew squares together according to chart to form front.

BACK: With larger hook and **CA** ch 73.

Row 1 RS: Sc in 2nd ch from hook and in each ch across; turn – 72 sc. **Row 2:** Ch 1, sc in each st across; turn.

Rep Row 2 till Back is same length as Front to beg of armhole shaping.

ARMHOLE SHAPING: Dec Row: Ch 1, sc dec over next 2 st, sc in each st across to last 2 st, sc dec over last 2 st; turn – 2 st dec.

Rep Dec Row 2 more times.

[Rep Row 2, work 3 Dec Rows] 2 times – last row will have 54 st.

Rep Row 2 till Back is .25" less than front.

FIRST NECK SHAPING: Ch 1, work 14 sc; turn.

Rep last row for .25". Fasten off.

SECOND NECK SHAPING: Sk next 26 st., attach yarn in next st. Rep as for First Neck Shaping.

Sew shoulder and side seams.

NECK EDGING: With **RS** facing, attach **CA** at neck opening, with larger hook ch 1, work an even number of sc evenly spaced around opening, join in beg sc. **RIBBING: Row 1:** With smaller hook, ch 36, sc in 2nd ch from hook, and in each ch across - 35 sc, sl st in last sc worked on neck edging, working up edging, sl st in next st; turn. **Row 2:** Sk sl sts, working in bk lp only, sc in next 35 st; turn. **Row 3:** Ch 1, working in bk lp only, sc in next 35 st; sl st in next 2 st on neck edging; turn. Rep last 2 rows working around neck opening. Fasten off.

Sew first and last row of ribbing together.

ARM EDGING: Work using same method as for Neck Edging. **RIBBING:** Work using same method as for Neck Ribbing using a beg ch 6 – 5 sc.

BOTTOM EDGING: Work using same method as for Neck Edging. **RIBBING:** Work using same method as for Neck Ribbing using a beg ch 11 – 10 sc.

Fold Neck ribbing in half to form turtleneck collar.

ABBREVIATIONS: **WS** = wrong side; **RS** = right side; **bk lp** = back loop; **sl st** = slip stitch; **rep** = repeat; **dec** = decrease; **beg** = begin(ning); **lp** = loop; **ch** = chain; **sc** = single crochet; **dc** = double crochet; **tr** = treble crochet; **st(s)** = stitch(es); **sk** = skip; * = repeat whatever follows the * as indicated; [] = work directions given in brackets the number of times specified.

Color Option 3: Solid color – 6 skeins No. 0519 Dark Mulberry .
