



# **Camo Corset**

This camisole may be made in camouflage yarn, but it is an item that will stand out in any wardrobe.

# LW2345



Designed by Double Stitch.

Directions are for size Small; changes for sizes Medium, Large, X-Large and XX-Large are in parentheses.

Finished Bust: 20 (20½, 27½, 30, 35)".

Finished Length: 13½" at shortest edge, 16½" at longest.

RED HEART® "Super Saver®": 1 skein each 971

Camouflage **A** and 376 Burgundy **B**. **Crochet Hook:** 5mm [US H-8].

Yarn needle.

GAUGE: 14 hdc = 4"; 11 rows = 4". CHECK YOUR GAUGE. Use any size hook to obtain the gauge.

#### **CORSET TOP**

# Panel 1

With A, ch 55.

**Row 1:** Working in back loops only throughout, hdc in 2nd ch from hook and each ch across.

Rows 2-11 (13, 15, 17, 19): Ch 2 (counts as hdc here and throughout), turn, skip first hdc, hdc in each hdc across – 54 sts.

Fasten off.

#### Panel 2

With A, ch 50.

**Row 1:** Working in back loops only throughout, hdc in 2nd ch from hook and each ch across.

**Rows 2-11 (13, 15, 17, 19):** Ch 2, turn, skip first hdc, hdc in each hdc across – 49 sts.

Fasten off.

# Panel 3

With A, ch 45.

**Row 1:** Working in back loops only throughout, hdc in 2nd ch from hook and each ch across.

**Rows 2-11 (13, 15, 17, 19):** Ch 2, turn, hdc in each hdc across – 44 sts.

Fasten off.

# **FINISHING**

# **Corset Center**

With right side facing and long edges together, arrange Panels 1, 2 and 3 with Panel 1 on left, Panel 2 in center and Panel 3 on right. All Panels should have one short edge aligned for Top edge and opposite short edges stepped for bottom edge.

# Joining

With wrong sides together, join **B** through both layers at Top edge with a slip st, ch 1, working through both layers, sc in each st along one long edge to join Panel 1 and Panel 2 together, ending at side edge of Panel 2. Leave remaining sts of Panel 1 unworked.

Fasten off.



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Repeat to join Panel 3 to opposite long edge of Panel 2, leaving remaining sts of Panel 2 unworked.

## **Right Side Panel**

**Row 1:** With right side facing, join **B** with a slip st in first st along opposite long edge of Panel 1, ch 2, hdc in next 44 sts across, leave remaining sts unworked – 45 hdc.

Rows 2-10 (12, 14, 16, 18): Ch 2, turn, hdc in each hdc across.

Row 11 (13, 15, 17, 19): Ch 4 (counts as hdc and ch 2), turn, skip next 2 hdc, hdc in next 3 hdc, [ch 2, skip 2 hdc, hdc in next 3 hdc] across.

Fasten off.

#### **Left Side Panel**

**Row 1:** With right side facing, join **B** with a slip st in first st along opposite long edge of Panel 3, ch 2, hdc in next 44 sts across – 45 hdc.

Rows 2-10 (12, 14, 16, 18): Ch 2, turn, hdc in each hdc across.

Row 11 (13, 15, 17, 19): Ch 2, turn, hdc in next 2 hdc, [ch 2, skip 2 hdc, hdc in next 3 hdc] across to last 2 sts, ch 2, hdc in last st.

Fasten off.

## **Side Panel Boning**

With right side facing, join **B** in first row of Right Side, working in rows of first row of Right Side, sc in each row of Right Side to Top Edge.

Fasten off.

Repeat along first row of Left Side.

#### **Neck Ties**

With right side facing, join **B** in last st of last row of Left Side, sc evenly spaced along edges of rows to last 9 rows of Panel 3, ch 100, skip 2 rows, sc evenly spaced along remaining rows of Panel 1, all rows of Panel 2 and first 7 rows of Panel 1, ch 100, skip 2 sts, sc evenly spaced to last row of of Right Side.

Fasten off.

#### Ruffle

**Row 1:** With right side facing, join **B** in last st of last row of Right Side, hdc evenly spaced along Bottom edges of rows of Right Side, hdc in unworked sts of Panel 3, hdc along edges of rows of Panel 3, hdc in unworked sts along opposite edge of Panel 3, hdc along edges of rows of Panel 2, hdc in unworked sts of Panel 2, hdc along edges of rows of Panel 1 and Left Side.

**Row 2:** Ch 3 (counts as dc), turn, work 2 dc in same space, work 3 dc in each st across.

**Row 3:** Ch 2, turn, hdc in each dc across. Fasten off.

Weave in ends.

#### **Corset Tie**

Ch 300.

Fasten off.


Weave Corset Tie through eyelets made on last row of Sides.

Art. E300 available in solid color 7 oz (198 g), 364 yd (333 m); multi color and print 5 oz (141 g), 244 yd (223 m), flecks 5 oz (141g), 260 yds (238 m) skeins.

Abbreviations: A, B, C = Color A, B, C; ch = chain; dc = double crochet; hdc = half double crochet; mm = millimeters; sc = single crochet; st(s) = stitch(es); [] = work directions in brackets the number of times specified.



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
