20 sts and 26 rows $=4$ " $[10 \mathrm{~cm}$ ] in stocking st.
8 sts + unraveled sps and 26 rows = 2 " $[5 \mathrm{~cm}$ ] in pat.

## INSTRUCTIONS

The instructions are written for smallest size. If changes are necessary for larger sizes the instructions will be written thus ( ). Numbers for each size are shown in the same color throughout the pattern. When only one number is given in black, it applies to all sizes.

Note: Top is worked in one piece from sleeve to sleeve.

## Yarnspirations

## Cable Panel

1st row: (RS). C8F.
2nd row: Purl.
3rd row: Knit.
4th to 15th rows: As 2nd and 3rd rows 6 times.
16th row: As 2nd row.
These 16 rows form Cable Panel.

## TOP

Cast on 86 (96-100-100-106-110) sts.
Left Sleeve Ribbing: 1st row: (RS).
*K1. P1. Rep from * to end of row.
Rep last row of (K1. P1) ribbing for 1 " [ 2.5 cm ], ending on a WS row. PM at end of last row.
Note: At beg of work width does not match required measurements. Only after unravelling indicated sts, finished measurements will match required measurements.
Foundation row 1: (RS). K2 (7-9-9-2-4). *Cast off 2 sts. K8 (including st on needle after cast off). Rep from * to last 4 (9-11-11-4-6) sts. Cast off 2 sts. K2 (7-9-9-2-4) (including st on needle after cast off).
Foundation row 2: P2 (7-9-9-2-4). *(yo) twice. P8. Rep from * to last 4 (9-11-11-4-6) sts. (yo) twice. P2 (7-9-9-2-4).

Foundation row 3: K2 (7-9-9-2-4). *P1, dropping extra yo. K8. Rep from * to last "(yo) twice". P1, dropping extra yo. K2 (7-9-9-2-4).
Foundation row 4: P2 (7-9-9-2-4). *K1. P8. Rep from * to last 3 (8-10-10-3-5) sts. K1. P2 (7-9-9-2-4). 77 (87-91-91-95-99) sts.

Note: All "P1" sts on RS or "K1" sts on WS will be unravelled later (excluding ribbing).

Proceed in pat as follows:
1st row: (RS). K2 (7-9-9-2-4). *P1. Work 1st row of Cable Panel. P1. Work 9th row of Cable Panel. Rep from * to last 3 (8-10-10-3-5) sts. P1. K2 (7-9-9-2-4).
2nd row: P2 (7-9-9-2-4). * P1. Work 10th row of Cable Panel. P1. Work 2nd row of Cable Panel. Rep from * to last 3 (8-10-10-3-5) sts. K1. P2 (7-9-9-2-4).
3rd row: K2 (7-9-9-2-4). *P1. Work 3rd row of Cable Panel. P1. Work 11th row of Cable Panel. Rep from

* to last 3 (8-10-10-3-5) sts. P1. K2 (7-9-9-2-4).
4th row: P2 (7-9-9-2-4). * P1. Work 12th row of Cable Panel. P1. Work 4th row of Cable Panel. Rep from
* to last 3 (8-10-10-3-5) sts. K1. P2 (7-9-9-2-4).
Cable Panel pat is now in position.
Cont in pat for Left Sleeve, keeping cont of Cable Panel pat until work from marked row measures $3^{\prime \prime}$ $[7.5 \mathrm{~cm}$ ], ending on a WS row.

Shape Front and Back: Keeping cont of pat, proceed as follows:
Foundation row 1: (RS). Cast on 58 (63-61-61-68-66) sts. K58 (63-61-61-68-66). Pat to end of row. PM at end of last row.
Foundation row 2: Cast on 58 (63-61-61-68-66) sts. (P1. K1) 5 times. [Cast off 2 sts. P8 (including st on needle after cast off)] 4 (5-5-5-5-5) times. Cast off 2 sts. P6 (1-0-0-6-4) (including st on needle after cast off). Pat across next 77 (87-89-89-95-99) sts. P6 (1-0-0-6-4). [Cast off 2 sts. P8 (including st on needle after cast off)] 4 (5-5-5-5-5) times. Cast off 2 sts. (K1. P1) 5 times.
Foundation row 3: (K1.P1) 5 times. [(yo) twice. K8] 4 (5-5-5-5-5) times. (yo) twice. Pat to last 58 (63-62-62-68-66) sts. K6 (1-0-0-6-4). [(yo) twice. K8] 4 (5-5-5-5-5) times. (yo) twice. (P1. K1) 5 times.

Foundation row 4: (P1. K1) 5 times. *K1, dropping extra loop over cast on sts. P8. Rep from * to last 11 sts. K1, dropping extra loop. (K1. P1) 5 times. 183 (201-201-201-219-219) sts.
Note: All "P1" sts on RS or "K1" sts on WS will be unravelled later (excluding ribbing).
Keeping cont of Cable Panel, proceed in pat as follows:
1st row: (RS). (K1. P1) 5 times. *P1. Work appropriate row of Cable Panel. Rep from * to last 11 sts. P1. (P1. K1) 5 times.
2nd row: (P1. K1) 5 times. *K1. Work appropriate row of Cable Panel. Rep from * to last 11 sts. K1. (K1. P1) 5 times.
Cable Panel pat and bottom (K1. P1) ribbing sections are now in position.

Cont in pat, keeping cont of Cable Panel pat until work from last marked row measures $41 / 2\left(5-6-6 \frac{1}{2}-\right.$ 8-9 $1 / 2$ )" $[11.5$ (12.5-15-16.5-20.524) cm ], ending on a WS row.

## Divide for neck opening: 1 st row:

 (RS). Pat across 91 (100-100-100-109-109) sts. Turn. Leave rem sts on a st holder.
## Yarnspirations <br> spark your inspiration!

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Cont in pat on these 91 (100-100-100-109-109) sts for Back for 10 (11-11-12-12-13)" [25.5 (28-28-$30.5-30.5-33) \mathrm{cm}$ ], ending on a RS row. Leave these sts on a spare needle. Break yarn.

Front: Drop first"P1" st off st holder and unravel to bottom of work. Rejoin yarn to rem 91 (100-100-100-109-109) sts and proceed in pat for 10 (11-11-12-12-13)" [25.5 (28-28-30.5-30.5-33) cm], ending on a RS row.
Next row: (WS - joining row). Pat across 91 (100-100-100-109-109) sts for Front. (yo) twice. Pat across 91 (100-100-100-109109) sts for Back. PM at end of row. Next row: Pat across 91 (100-100-100-109-109) sts. P1, dropping extra loop. Pat across 91 (100-100-100-109-109) sts. 183 (201-201-201-219-219) sts.

Cont in pat, keeping cont of Cable Panel pat until work from last marked row measures 41⁄2 (5-6-6½-8-91⁄2)" [11.5 (12.5-15-16.5-$20.5-24) \mathrm{cm}$ ], ending on a RS row.

Note: Use crochet hook to work 'Ch 3'. Last chain of Ch 3 is placed
back onto left-hand needle and treated like stitch.
Next row: (WS). Cast off 9 sts. [Drop next st (K1) off needle and unravel to bottom of work. Ch 3. Cast off 9 sts (including last chain of Ch 3)] 4 (5-5-5-5-5) times. Drop next st (K1) off needle and unravel to bottom of work. Ch 3. Cast off 7 (2-1-1-7-5) st(s) (including last chain of Ch 3). Pat to last 58 (63-62-62-68-66) sts. Drop next st (K1) off needle and unravel to bottom of work. Ch 3. Cast off 7 (2-1-1-7-5) $\mathrm{st}(\mathrm{s})$ (including last chain of Ch 3 ). [Drop next st (K1) off needle and unravel to bottom of work. Ch 3. Cast off 8 sts (including last chain of Ch 3)] 4 (5-5-5-5-5) times. Drop next st (K1) off needle and unravel to bottom of work. Ch 3. Cast off rem 11 sts (including last chain of Ch 3). 77 (87-91-91-95-99) sts rem. Break yarn.

Right Sleeve: With RS facing rejoin yarn to rem 77 (87-91-91-95-99) sts and cont in Cable Panel pat for Right Sleeve for 3" $[7.5 \mathrm{~cm}]$, ending on a WS row.

Right Sleeve Ribbing: 1st row: (RS). K2 (7-9-9-2-4). *Drop next
st (K1) off needle and unravel to bottom of work. Cast on 2 sts. K8. Rep from * to last 3 (8-10-10-3-5) sts. Drop next st (K1) off needle and unravel to bottom of work. Cast on 2 sts. K2 (7-9-9-2-4). 86 (96-100-100-106-110) sts.
Beg and ending on a WS row, work in (K1. P1) ribbing as given for Left Sleeve for 1" [ 2.5 cm ]. Cast off in ribbing.

## FINISHING

Pin piece to measurements. Cover with a damp cloth leaving cloth to dry. Sew side and sleeve seams.
