## ABBREVIATIONS

#### SIZES

To fit chest measurementXS/S/M28-38" [71-96.5 cm]L/XL40-46" [101.5-117 cm]2/3/XL48-54" [122-137 cm]4/5XL56-62" [142-157.5 cm]

#### **GAUGES**

17 sts and 23 rows = 4" [10 cm] in stocking stitch (st). 16 sts and 34 rows = 4" [10 cm] in garter st (Knit every row).

#### **INSTRUCTIONS**

The instructions are written for **XS/S/M**. If changes are necessary for larger sizes the instructions will be written **XS/S/M** (L-XL-2/3XL-4/5XL). Numbers for each size are shown in the same color throughout the pattern. When only one number is given in black, it applies to all sizes.

#### FRONT AND BACK (Make alike)

Beginning (beg) at lower edge, cast on **85** (102-119-136) stitches (sts). **Do not** join. Working back and forth across needle, proceed as follows:

**1st row:** [Right Side (RS)]. Knit (K) 7. Purl (P)3. \*K14. P3. Repeat (rep) from \* to last 7 sts. K7.

Shape at Sleeves: Cast on 32 (32-40-40) sts beg of next 2 rows. 144 (160-192-208) sts at end of second row. Place marker (PM) at end of second row.

Continue (cont) in garter st until work from marked row measures **7** (8-9-10)" [18 (20.5-23-25.5) cm].


Shape shoulders: Next 12 (8-10-

12) rows: Cast off 8 (14-14-13) sts.
Knit to end of row.
48 (48-52-52) sts remain (rem).

**Collar:** Cont in garter st over rem **48** (**48-52-52**) sts for 8" [20.5 cm], ending on a RS row. Cast off knitwise.

Pin both pieces to schematic measurements. Cover with a damp cloth, leaving cloth to dry. Sew Front and Back side seams using vertical mattress st, as shown in diagram below. Sew shoulder seams as shown in

diagram ending at the Collar.



Sew Collar seams using vertical mattress st. Fold Collar down to RS. Fold back sleeve cuffs if desired.
