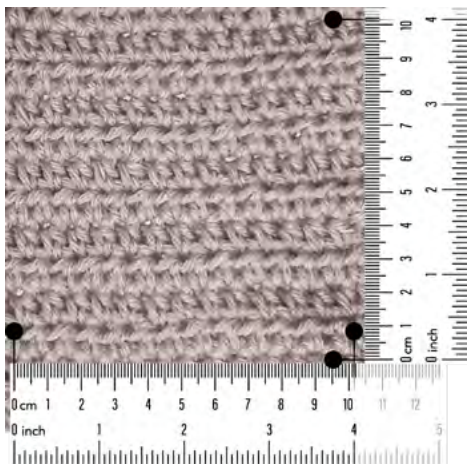
## WHAT YOU'LL NEED



[SHOP KIT](#)

## GAUGE

12 **half double crochet** (hdc) and 10 rows = 4" [10 cm].



## YARN

**Red Heart® Super Saver®**  
(7 oz/198 g; 364 yds /333 m)

## COLORS

### Quantity

- **Contrast A** Aran (0313)  
1 ball or 50 yds/46 m
- **Contrast B** Perfect Pink (0706)  
1 ball or 40 yds/36.5 m
- **Contrast C** Cherry Red (0319)  
1 ball or 6 yds/5.5 m
- **Contrast D** Medium Thyme (0406)  
1 ball or 6 yds/5.5 m

## TOOLS

- Size U.S. 1/9 (5.5 mm) Susan Bates® crochet hook **or size needed to obtain gauge.**
- Susan Bates® yarn needle.
- Small amount of stuffing.
- Tape measure.

## ABBREVIATIONS

<b>Beg</b> = Beginning	<b>Rep</b> = Repeat	<b>Sl st</b> = Slip stitch
<b>Ch</b> = Chain(s)	<b>Rnd(s)</b> = Round(s)	<b>St</b> = Stitch
<b>Cont</b> = Continue	<b>Sc</b> = Single crochet	<b>St(s)</b> = Stitch(es)
<b>Dc</b> = Double crochet	<b>Sc2tog</b> = Draw up a loop in each of next 2 stitches. Yoh and draw through all loops on hook.	<b>Yoh</b> = Yarn over hook
<b>Hdc</b> = Half double crochet		<b>RS</b> = Right side
<b>PM</b> = Place marker		

## INSTRUCTIONS

### USING THIS GUIDE

Click on the underlined words throughout the pattern to access our library of helpful tools.

### NOTE

- Work into back bumps of foundation **chain** (ch) for a tidier beginning (beg) edge.

## SIZE

One size to fit Adult.





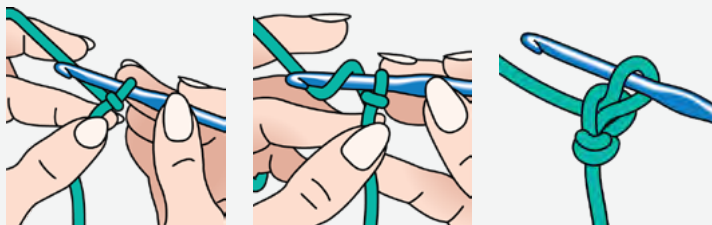
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## INSTRUCTIONS

**Chain** (ch) 52.



**1st row:** Right Side (RS). 1 **half double crochet** (hdc) in 3rd ch from hook. 1 hdc in each of next 3 ch. 2 hdc in next ch.\*1 hdc in each of next 4 ch. 2 hdc in next ch. Repeat (rep) from \* to end of chain. Turn. 60 hdc



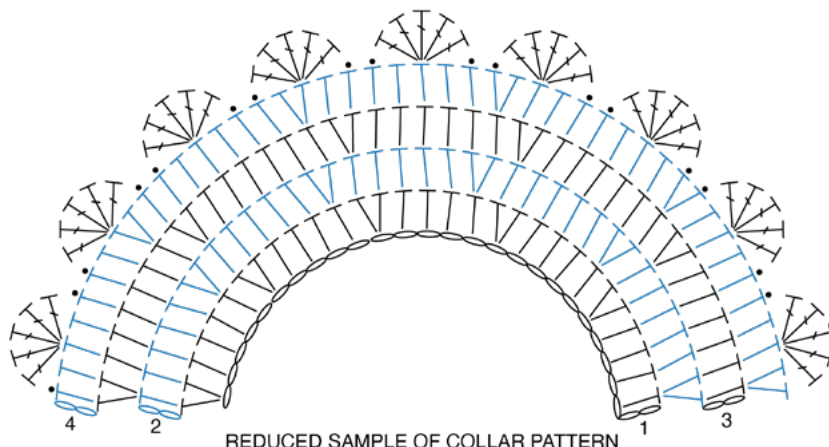
**2nd row:** Ch 2. \*1 hdc in each of next 5 hdc. 2 hdc in next hdc. Rep from \* to end of row. Turn. 70 hdc.

**3rd row:** Ch 2. \*1 hdc in each of next 6 hdc. 2 hdc in next hdc. Rep from \* to end of row. Turn. 80 hdc.

**4th row:** Ch 2. \*1 hdc in each of next 7 hdc. 2 hdc in next hdc. Rep from \* to end of row. Break A. Join B. Turn. 90 hdc.

**5th row:** With B, skip first 2 hdc. \*5 **double crochet** (dc) in next hdc. Skip next hdc. **Slip stitch** (sl st) in each of next 2 hdc. Skip next hdc. Rep from \* to end of row.

**Fasten off.**



REDUCED SAMPLE OF COLLAR PATTERN

### STITCH KEY

- = chain (ch)
- = slip stitch (sl st)
- ⊥ = single crochet (sc)
- ⌋ = half double crochet (hdc)
- ⌋ = double crochet (dc)
- △ = single crochet 2 together (sc2tog)



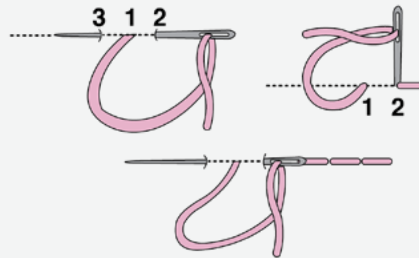
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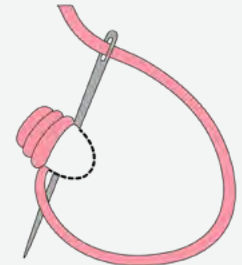
## INSTRUCTIONS

With length of D, use back stitch to embroider cherry stems on Collar as shown in photo.



Back stitch

With length of C, use satin stitch to embroider cherries on Collar as shown in photo.



Satin stitch

## Cherry Drawstring

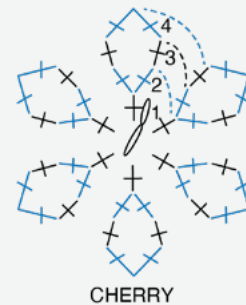
With D, ch 120.

**Fasten off.** Leave ends for sewing.

Using yarn needle, weave Drawstring in and out through sts of 1st row.

## Cherries (make 2).

**Note:** Do not join at ends of rounds (rnds) unless otherwise stated. Cont working in spiral placing marker on first st of rnd for easier counting.

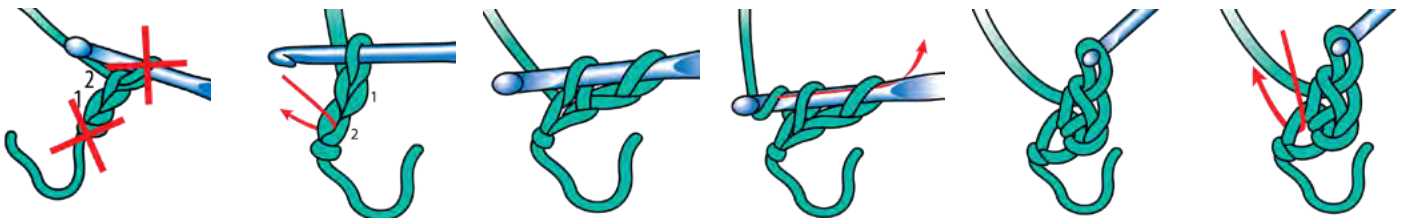


STITCH KEY

- = chain (ch)
- = slip stitch (sl st)
- + = single crochet (sc)
- ┌ = half double crochet (hdc)
- └ = double crochet (dc)
- △ = single crochet 2 together (sc2tog)

With C, ch 2.

**1st rnd:** 6 **single crochet** (sc) in 2nd ch from hook. Place marker (PM). 6 sc.



**Do not** join, cont working in spiral as follows. PM (first marker) for beg of rnd. Move marker up on rnds as work progresses.



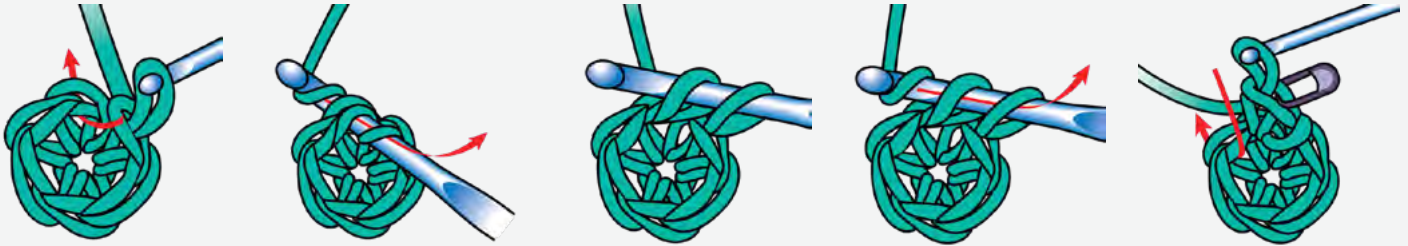
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## INSTRUCTIONS

**2nd rnd:** 2 sc in each sc around. 12 sc.



**3rd to 5th rnds:** 1 sc in each sc around.

**6th rnd:** Sc2tog 6 times. 6 sc.

**Fasten off** leaving long end. Stuff cherry firmly.

Sew Cherries to ends of Drawstring using ends left for sewing as shown in photo
