#### What you will need:

RED HEART<sup>®</sup> Baby Hugs<sup>™</sup> Medium: 6 balls 4952 Safari

Susan Bates<sup>®</sup> Crochet Hook: 6.5mm [US K-10½)]

Yarn needle

**GAUGE:** 11 sts = 4" (10 cm); 10 rows = 4" (10 cm). CHECK YOUR GAUGE. Use any size hook to obtain the gauge.

# **Fun-and-Hugs** Blanket

This easy crochet blanket is soft and cuddly so baby will love having fun playing with it! This quality yarn has been tested and certified free of over 300 harmful substances, perfect for showing your baby some love.

Blanket measures 36" x 36" (91.5 x 91.5 cm).

### **BI ANKFT**

#### Ch 97.

Row 1: Sc in 4th ch from hook (beginning skipped ch count as first dc). dc in next ch, \*sc in next ch, dc in next ch; repeat from \* across, turn-95 sts. Row 2: Ch 3 (counts as first dc here and throughout), \*sc in next sc, dc in next dc; repeat from \* across working last dc in top of beginning ch, turn. Repeat Row 2 until piece measures 34" (86.5 cm).

#### Border

Round 1: Ch 1, sc in each st across to beginning ch, 3 sc in top of beginning ch; \*working in ends of rows, sc evenly spaced to last row, 3 sc in last row\*; working in opposite side of foundation ch, sc in each ch across to last ch, 3 sc in last ch; repeat from \* to \*; join with slip st in first sc. turn.

Round 2: Ch 4 (counts as first dc and ch 1), dc in next st, (ch 1, dc) in each st around; ch 1; join with slip st in 3rd ch of beginning ch. Fasten off.

## FINISHING

Weave in ends.

#### ABBREVIATIONS

ch = ch(s); dc = double crochet; sc = single crochet; st(s) = stitch(es); () = work directions in parentheses into same st; \* = repeat whatever follows the \* as indicated.
