What you will need:

RED HEART® Baby Hugs™

Medium: 5 balls 4909

Ladybug **A**, 1 ball each 4012
Ink **B**, 4001 Frosting **C**, and
4255 Orange **D**

Note Only a small quantity of
D is needed for this project.

Susan Bates® Crochet Hook:

5mm [US H-8]

Yarn needle, stitch marker

GAUGE: 12 dc = 4" (10 cm);

9 rows = 4" (10 cm). **CHECK**

YOUR GAUGE. Use any size
hook to obtain gauge.

Playful Penguin Blanket

What a cute way to welcome baby
into the world! This happy penguin blanket
is perfect for keeping a newborn warm
and comforted, and will grow up with him
working as a play mat or any creative play.
This tested yarn is certified free from harmful
levels of over 300 substances.



Blanket measures 36" x 36" (91.5 x 91.5 cm).

Notes

Blanket is worked back and forth in
turned rows with border worked in
joined rounds.

To change color, work last stitch of old
color to last yarn over. Yarn over with
new color and draw through all loops on
hook to complete stitch. Proceed with
new color. Cut old color.

Penguin is worked in continuous (spiral)
rounds with right side facing at all
times. Do not join until instructed. Place
marker for beginning of round and move
marker up as each round is completed.

Special Stitches

Bpdc (back post double crochet) = Yarn
over, insert hook from back side of work
to front and to back again around the
post of indicated stitch; yarn over and
pull up a loop (3 loops on hook), yarn
over and draw through 2 loops (2 loops
on hook), yarn over and draw through
2 loops (1 loop on hook). Skip the stitch
"in front of" the Bpdc.

Fpdc (front post double crochet) = Yarn
over, insert hook from front side of work
to back and to front again around post
of indicated stitch; yarn over and pull up
a loop (3 loops on hook), yarn over and
draw through 2 loops (2 loops on hook),
yarn over and draw through 2 loops (1
loop on hook).

Special Technique

Join with sc = Place a slip knot on hook,
insert hook in indicated stitch, yarn over
and pull up a loop, yarn over and draw
through both loops on hook.

BLANKET

With **A**, ch 112.

Row 1 (right side): Dc in 4th ch from
hook (beginning skipped ch count as
first dc) and in each ch across, turn—110
dc.

Row 2: Ch 3 (counts as first dc here
and throughout), dc in next 4 sts, fpdc
around next 5 sts, *dc in next 5 sts, fpdc
around next 5 sts; repeat from * across,
turn.

Row 3: Ch 3, dc in next 4 sts, bpd
around next 5 sts, *dc in next 5 sts, bpd
around next 5 sts; repeat from * across,
turn.

Repeat Rows 2 and 3 until blanket
measures 32" (81.5 cm). Fasten off.

Border

Round 1 (right side): With right side
facing, join **A** with sc in any st in center
of last row, sc in each st across to last st,
3 sc in last st; working in ends of rows
of side edge, sc evenly spaced across;
working in opposite side of foundation
ch, 3 sc in first ch, sc in each ch across
to last ch, 3 sc in last ch; working in ends
of rows of other edge, sc evenly spaced
across, 3 sc in first st of last row, sc in
each remaining st across; join with slip
st in first sc—four 3-sc corners.

Round 2: Ch 1, sc in each st around,
working 3 sc in center st of each 3-sc
corner; join with slip st in first sc; change
to **B**.

Round 3: Repeat Round 2; change to **C**.

Rounds 4 and 5: Repeat Round 2; do
not change color.
Fasten off.

PENGUIN

Body

With **B**, ch 5.

Round 1: Sc in 2nd ch from hook and in next 2 ch, 3 sc in last ch; working on opposite side of foundation ch, skip first ch, sc in next 2 ch, 2 sc in last ch—10 sc. Place marker for beginning of round and move marker up as each round is completed.

Round 2: Work 2 sc in next st, sc in next 2 sts, 2 sc in next 3 sts, sc in next 2 sts, 2 sc in next 2 sts—16 sc.

Round 3: *Sc in next st, 2 sc in next st*, sc in next 2 sts; repeat from * to * 3 times, sc in next 2 sts; repeat from * to * twice—22 sc.

Round 4: *Sc in next 2 sts, 2 sc in next st*, sc in next 2 sts; repeat from * to * 3 times, sc in next 2 sts; repeat from * to * twice—28 sc.

Round 5: *Sc in next 3 sts, 2 sc in next st*, sc in next 2 sts; repeat from * to * 3 times, sc in next 2 sts; repeat from * to * twice—34 sc.

Round 6: *Sc in next 4 sts, 2 sc in next st*, sc in next 2 sts; repeat from * to * 3 times, sc in next 2 sts; repeat from * to * twice—40 sc.

Round 7: *Sc in next 5 sts, 2 sc in next st*, sc in next 2 sts; repeat from * to * 3 times, sc in next 2 sts; repeat from * to * twice; join with slip st in first sc—46 sc. Fasten off, leaving a long tail for sewing.

Head and Belly

With **C**, work same as Rounds 1–6 of body; at end of Round 6, join with slip st in first sc. Fasten off, leaving a long tail for sewing.

Wing (make 2)

With **B**, ch 2.

Round 1: Work 6 sc in 2nd ch from hook; join with slip st in first sc—6 sc. Fasten off, leaving a long tail for sewing.

Foot (make 2)

Work same as Wing.

FINISHING

Refer to photograph for placement of pieces.

With ending tails, sew head and belly, wings, and feet to body

With **B**, embroider eyes with short straight stitches. With **C** and straight stitches, embroider triangular beak between eyes.

Sew penguin to lower right corner of blanket or where desired.

Weave in ends.

ABBREVIATIONS

A, B, C = Color A, Color B, Color C, etc.; **ch** = chain(s); **dc** = double crochet; **sc** = single crochet; **st(s)** = stitch(es); ***** = repeat whatever follows the * as indicated.
