What you will need:
RED HEART ${ }^{\circ}$ Soft Baby Steps ${ }^{\bullet}$ : 2 balls 9600 White $\mathbf{C}$ and 1 ball each 9702 Strawberry A, 9401 Elephant B, and 9700 Baby Pink C

Susan Bates ${ }^{\bullet}$ Crochet Hook: 6.5 mm [US K-10.5]

Yarn needle
GAUGE: 4 pattern repeats $=3^{\prime \prime}$ ( 7.5 cm ) (one pattern repeat consists of one puff stitch and one ch -1 space); Rounds $1-5=6$ " ( 15 cm ). CHECK YOUR GAUGE. Use any size hook to obtain the gauge.

## Sweet Baby

 Hexagon BlanketPink and grey tones are a sweet combination for this cozy puff-stitch baby blanket. This easy pattern is crocheted from the center outward in hexagon-shaped rounds. This is a favorite way to create a blanket with few ends to weave in when you are done crocheting.

## Blanket measures 39 " ( 96.5 cm )

 diagonally from point to point.
## Special Stitches

Beg puff st (beginning puff stitch) = Pull up loop on hook $1 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ ( 1.5 cm ), yo, insert hook in indicated space, pull up a loop [yo, insert hook in same space, pull up a loop] twice ( 7 loops on hook) yo, pull thru all 7 loops on hook.
Beg puff V-st (beginning puff V-stitch) = (Beg puff st, ch 2, puff st) in indicated space. Lg shell (large shell) $=(\mathrm{dc},[\mathrm{ch} 1, \mathrm{dc}] 4$ times) in indicated stitch.
Puff st (puff stitch) = Yo, insert hook in indicated space, pull up a loop [yo, insert hook in same space, pull up a loop] 3 times (7 loops on hook) yo, pull thru all 7 loops on hook.
Puff V-st (puff V-stitch) $=($ Puff st, ch 2, puff st) in indicated space.
Sm shell (small shell) $=(\mathrm{dc},[\mathrm{ch} 1, \mathrm{dc}] 2$ times) in indicated stitch.

## Notes

1. When instructed to work into a puff V -st, work into the ch-2 space of that stitch.
2. To change color, work last stitch of old color to last yarn over. Yarn over with new color and draw through all loops on hook to complete stitch. Proceed with new color. Cut old color.

## BLANKET

With $\mathbf{A}$, ch 6 , join with slip st in first ch to form a ring.
Round 1: Beg puff st in ring, *ch 2, puff st in ring; repeat from * 4 times, ch 2; join with slip st in beg puff st-6 puff sts and 6 ch-2 spaces, Round 2: Slip st in first ch-2 space, beg puff $V$-st in same space, *ch 1 , puff $V$-st in next ch-2 space; repeat from * 4 times, ch 1; join with slip st in beg puff st-6 puff V-sts and 6 ch-1 spaces.

Round 3: Slip st in ch-2 space of first puff V-st, beg puff V -st in same space, *ch 1, puff st in next ch-1 space, ch 1 , puff $V$-st in next puff $V$-st; repeat from * 3 times, ch 1 , puff st in last ch-1 space, ch 1 ; join with slip st in beg puff st-6 puff V -sts and $12 \mathrm{ch}-1$ spaces. Round 4: Repeat Round 3-6 puff V-sts and 18 ch-1 spaces.
Round 5: Repeat Round 3; change to $\mathbf{B}-6$ puff V-sts and 24 ch-1 spaces.
Rounds 6-30: Repeat Round 3 twenty-five times and change color as in the following color sequence: Work *1 round with B, 5 rounds with $\mathbf{C}, 1$ round with $\mathbf{B}^{*}, 5$ rounds with $\mathbf{D}, 1$ round with $\mathbf{B}, 5$ rounds with $\mathbf{A}$; repeat from * to * once-6 puff V-sts and $174 \mathrm{ch}-1$ spaces at end of Round 30. Fasten off.

## Edging

Join $\mathbf{D}$ with slip st in ch-2 sp of any puff V -st, ch 4 (counts as first dc, ch 1 ), (dc, [ch 1, dc] 3 times) in same space (first lg shell made), *[ch 1, sc in next ch-1 space, ch 1 , sm shell in next ch-1 space] across to next puff V -st**, ch 1 , Ig shell in next puff V-st; repeat from * around, ending last repeat at ${ }^{* *}$; join with slip st in 3rd ch of beginning ch. Fasten off. Weave in ends.
