## What you will need:

**Red Heart® Comfort®:** 2 balls  
4134 Bambi Prints

**Susan Bates® Crochet Hook:**  
5mm [US H-8] and 5.5mm  
[US I-9]

Yarn needle

**GAUGE:** 17 dc = 5" (12.5 cm); 9½  
dc rows = 5" (12.5 cm) with larger  
hook. **CHECK YOUR GAUGE.**  
**Use any size hook to obtain the  
gauge.**

# Baroque Baby Blanket

*Welcome a new baby with an extra special baby  
blanket! Wonderful in any color of yarn, you'll  
enjoy watching the pretty stitch pattern emerge as  
you crochet. And since it is all one color, the only  
finishing will be weaving in a few yarn ends.*

**Blanket measures 38 X 41" (96.5 x 104  
cm) including edging**

## BLANKET

Ch 120.

**Row 1 (RS):** Sc in 2nd ch from hook and in  
each ch to end, turn – 119 sc.

**Row 2:** Ch 3 (counts as 1 dc), dc in each of  
next 5 sc, \* ch 2, skip 5 sc, (dc, ch 1) 3 times  
and dc in next sc, ch 2, skip 5 sc, dc in each  
of next 5 sc; repeat from \* to last sc, dc in  
last sc, turn.

**Row 3:** Ch 3 (counts as 1 dc), dc in each of  
next 5 dc, \* ch 2, (sc, ch 3) in each of next 3  
dc, sc in next dc, ch 2, dc in each of next 5 dc;  
repeat from \* to last dc, dc in last dc, turn.

**Row 4:** Ch 3 (counts as 1 dc), dc in each of  
next 5 dc, \* ch 2, skip next 2 spaces, (dc, ch  
1) 3 times and dc in next ch-3 space, ch 2,  
skip next 2 spaces, dc in each of next 5 dc;  
repeat from \* to last dc, dc in last dc, turn.

**Rows 5-70:** Repeat Rows 3 and 4 alternately.

**Row 71:** Repeat Row 3.

**Row 72:** Ch 1, turn, sc in each of first 6 dc, \*  
(ch 2, sc) in each of next 3 ch-3 spaces, ch 2,  
sc in each of next 5 dc; repeat from \* to last  
dc, sc in last dc, turn.

Do not fasten off.

## Edging

Change to smaller hook.

**Round 1 (RS):** Ch 1, 3 sc in first sc, sc in  
each of next 2 sc, skip next sc, sc in each of  
next 2 sc, \* (sc in next ch-2 space, sc in next  
sc) 4 times, sc in next sc, skip next sc, sc in  
each of next 2 sc; repeat from \* to last sc, 3  
sc in last sc, sc evenly along side edge to  
foundation ch working approximately 3 sc  
for every 2 rows, 3 sc in first foundation ch,  
sc in each of next 2 ch, skip 1 ch, sc in each  
of next 2 ch \*\*, [skip next ch, sc in each of

next 2 ch] 4 times, sc in next ch, skip next ch,  
sc in each of next 2 ch; repeat from \*\* to last  
ch, 3 sc in last ch, sc evenly along remaining  
side edge, join with slip st in first sc, turn.

**Round 2:** Ch 3 (counts as 1 dc), dc in each st  
around, working 3 dc in each of 4 corner sts,  
join with slip st in top of beginning ch-3, turn.

**Rounds 3 and 4:** Ch 1, sc in each st around,  
working 3 sc in each of 4 corner sts, join  
with slip st in first sc, turn.

Fasten off.

## FINISHING

Weave in ends.

## ABBREVIATIONS

**ch** = chain; **dc** = double crochet; **sc** =  
single crochet; **st(s)** = stitch(es); **[ ]** = work  
directions in brackets the number of times  
specified; **\***, **\*\*** = repeat whatever follows the  
\* or \*\* as indicated.



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
