# What you will need:

RED HEART® Snuggle Bunny™: 8 balls 9936 Dragonfly

Susan Bates® Crochet Hook: 9mm [US N-13]

GAUGE: 1 ripple =  $5\frac{1}{2}$ " (14 cm) from peak to peak; Rows 1–8 rows =  $4\frac{1}{2}$ " (10 cm) in single crochet. CHECK YOUR GAUGE. Use any size hook to obtain the gauge.

# Ripple Baby Blanket

Whether its cuddle time or playtime, this blanket will always be there to comfort baby. This multi-color, super bulky yarn makes it quick to crochet and is wonderfully colorful without having a lot of ends to weave in.

Blanket measures 35" wide x 38½" long (89 x 98 cm).

# **Special Technique**

**Join with sc** = Place a slip knot on hook, insert hook in indicated stitch, yarn over and draw up a loop, yarn over and draw through both loops on hook.

#### **Notes**

Blanket is made in a ripple pattern which consists of a series of 3-stitch "peaks" and 2-skipped stitch "valleys", with 14 stitches worked between peaks and valleys. You may need to work several rows before the ripple is clearly visible.

## **BLANKET**

Ch 98.

Row 1 (wrong side): Work 2 sc in 2nd ch from hook, \*sc in next 7 ch, skip next ch, sc in next 7 ch\*\*, 3 sc in next ch; repeat from \* 5 times ending at \*\*, 2 sc in last ch, turn—103 sc.

Rows 2—8: Ch 1, 2 sc in first sc, \*sc in next 7 sc, skip next 2 sc, sc in next 7 sc\*\*, 3 sc in next sc; repeat from \* 5 times ending at \*\*, 2 sc in last sc, turn.

Row 9: Ch 4 (counts as dc, ch 1 here and throughout), skip first sc, dc in next sc, \*[ch 1, skip next sc, dc in next sc] 3 times, skip next 2 sc, dc in next sc, [ch 1, skip next sc, dc in next sc] 3 times\*\*, [ch 1, dc in next sc] twice; repeat from \* 5 times ending at \*\*, ch 1, dc in last sc, turn—55 dc and 48 ch-1 spaces.

Row 10: Ch 4, dc in next dc, [ch 1, dc in next

Row 10: Ch 4, dc in next dc, [ch 1, dc in next dc] 3 times, \*dc in next dc, [ch 1, dc in next dc] 8 times; repeat from \* 4 times, dc in next dc, [ch 1, dc in next dc] 3 times, ch 1, dc in 3rd ch of beginning ch, turn.

Row 11: Ch 1, 2 sc in first dc, \*[sc in next ch-1 space, sc in next dc] 3 times, sc in next ch-1 space, skip next 2 dc, [sc in next ch-1 space, sc in next dc] 3 times, sc in next ch-1 space\*\*, 3 sc in next dc; repeat from \* 5 times ending at \*\*, 2 sc in 3rd ch of beginning ch-4, turn—103 sc.

Rows 12–51: Repeat Rows 2–11 four times. Rows 52–58: Repeat Rows 2–8. Do not fasten off.

#### **Edging**

First edge (right side): Ch 1, working across ends of rows, sc in each sc row and 2 sc in each dc row—68 sc. Fasten off.

Second edge: With right side of 2nd edge facing, join yarn with sc in end of first row, working across ends of rows, sc in each sc row and 2 sc in each dc row—68 sc.

Fasten off.

## **FINISHING**

Weave in ends.

**ch** = chain; **dc** = double crochet; **sc** = single crochet; **st(s)** = stitch(es); [] = work directions in brackets the number of times specified; \* = repeat whatever follows the \* as indicated.
