

## Grandma's Favorite Baby Blanket

Start crocheting these two-round squares and rectangles when you hear there's going to be a new arrival, and you'll have the blanket made with time to spare!

Designed by Michele Maks.
Blanket measures approximately $36^{\prime \prime} \times 40$ ".
RED HEART® "Soft Baby®": 2 skeins each 7881
Powder Blue A and 7737 Powder Pink B; 1 skein 7001 White C.

Crochet Hooks: 6 mm [US J-10] and 5.5mm [US I-9].
Yarn needle.
GAUGE: Square $=3$ " $\times 3$ "; Rectangle $=3 " \times 5$ " using 2 strands yarn and larger hook. CHECK YOUR GAUGE. Use any size hook to obtain the gauge.

NOTE: Hold 2 strands of the same color together throughout.

## BLANKET

## Square 1 (Make 35)

With larger hook and $\mathbf{A}$, ch 3 ; join with a slip st to form a ring.
Round 1: Ch $3,2 \mathrm{dc}$ in ring, ch 3 , [ 3 dc in ring, ch 3] 3 times; join with a slip st to top of ch-3.
Round 2: Slip st across next 2 dc and into space; ch 3, (2 dc, ch 3, 3 dc) all in same ch-3 space, ch 1, [(3 dc, ch 3, 3 dc) all in next ch-3 space, ch 1] 3 times; join with a slip st to top of ch-3. Fasten off.

## Square 2 (Make 30)

Work same as Square 1 with B.

## Rectangle 1 (Make 28)

With larger hook and B, ch 14.
Row 1 (Right Side): Dc in 6th ch from hook, dc in next 2 ch, ch 1 , skip next ch, dc in next 3 ch, ch 1 , skip next ch, dc in last ch. Fasten off.
Round 1: With right side facing, attach $\mathbf{C}$ in ch 1 space at end of last row; ch 3, 2 dc in same space, ch 3,3 dc over dc at end of row, ch 3,3 dc over last skipped ch, ch 1,3 dc over next skipped ch, ch 1, (3 dc, [ch 3, 3 dc] twice) all in beginning ch-5 space, ch $1,3 \mathrm{dc}$ in next ch-1 space, ch 1 ; join with a slip st to top of ch-3. Fasten off.
Round 2: With right side facing, attach $\mathbf{A}$ in first ch-3 corner space after the joining; ch 3, ( 2 dc , ch $3,3 \mathrm{dc}$ ) all in same space, * ch 1, ( 3 dc , ch $3,3 \mathrm{dc}$ ) all in next corner ch-3 space, ch 1 , [ 3 dc in next ch 1 space, ch 1] twice **, ( 3 dc , ch $3,3 \mathrm{dc}$ ) all in next corner ch-3 space; repeat from * to **; join with a slip st to top of ch-3. Fasten off.

## Rectangle 2 (Make 24)

Work same as Rectangle 1 EXCEPT use $\mathbf{A}$ to start and for Row 1; $\mathbf{C}$ for Round 1; and $\mathbf{B}$ for Round 2.

## FINISHING

Sew pieces together as follows:
Strip 1 (Make 7): [Square 1, Rectangle 1] 4 times, Square A. Strip 2 (Make 6): [Square 2, Rectangle 2] 4 times; Square B. Now sew strips together as follows: [Strip 1, Strip 2] 6 times, Strip 1. Weave in ends.

## Edging

Round 1: With right side facing and smaller hook, attach C in any corner; ch 1 , * work 3 sc in corner, sc to next corner taking care to keep work flat; repeat from * around; join with a slip st to first sc.

## Picot Edging

Round 2: * Ch 2, slip st in 2nd ch from hook, skip next sc, slip st in next 2 sc; repeat from * around, adjusting as necessary at corners and end of round to keep work flat; join. Fasten off. Weave in ends.

ABBREVIATIONS: A, B, C = Colors A, B, C; ch = chain; dc = double crochet; $\mathbf{m m}=$ millimeters; $\mathbf{s c}=$ single crochet; slip st = slip stitch; * or ** $=$ repeat whatever follows the * or ** as indicated; [ ] = work directions in brackets the number of times specified.
