

## Crochet Stroller Blanket

## LW1578



Designed by Michele Wilcox.
Blanket measures 26" x 30".

RED HEART ® "Baby Econo®": 2 skeins 1001 White A; 1 skein each of 1722 Lt Pink B; 1668 Serene Green C.

Crochet Hook: 5mm [US H/8].
Yarn needle.
GAUGE: 14 sts and 10 rows = 4" in pattern. CHECK YOUR GAUGE. Use any size hook to obtain gauge.

SPECIAL ABBREVIATION:
shell = work 5 dc in specified st

## SWATCH PATTERN:

Ch 15.
Row 1: Sc in 2nd ch from hook and in each remaining ch across - 14 sc . Ch 3 (counts as dc on next row now and throughout), turn.
Row 2: Dc in next sc and in each remaining sc across 14 dc . Ch 1, turn.
Row 3: Sk first dc; *dc in next dc, slip st in next dc; repeat from * across; dc in 3rd ch of turning ch-3-7 dc, 6 slip sts and 1 ch. Ch 3, turn.
Row 4: *Dc in next slip st, dc in next dc; repeat from * across; dc in turning ch-1-14 dc. Ch 1, turn.
Rows 5-10: Repeat rows 3 and 4 three times more.
Swatch should measure $4^{\prime \prime} \times 4 " / 10.2 \mathrm{~cm} \times 10.2 \mathrm{~cm}$. If necessary, adjust hook size to obtain correct gauge.

## BLANKET:

Beginning at bottom edge; with A, ch 80 .
Row 1 (wrong side): Sc in 2nd ch from hook and in each remaining ch across - 79 sc. Ch 3 (counts as dc on next row now and throughout), turn.
Row 2 (right side): Dc in next sc and in each remaining sc across - 79 dc . Ch 1, turn.
Row 3: Sk first dc, dc in next dc; *slip st in next dc, dc in next dc; repeat from * across; slip st in 3rd ch of turning ch-3-39 dc and 40 slip sts. Ch 3 , turn.
Row 4: Dc in next dc; *dc in next slip st, dc in next dc; repeat from * across; dc in turning ch-1 - 79 dc . Fasten off A. Turn.

Row 5: Join B with slip st in first dc, dc in next dc; *slip st in next dc, dc in next dc; repeat from * across; slip st in 3rd ch of turning ch-3-39 dc and 40 slip sts. Fasten off B. Turn.
Row 6: Join A with slip st in first slip st, ch 3 (counts as dc); *dc in next dc, dc in next slip st; repeat from * across 79 dc . Fasten off A. Turn.
Row 7: Join C with slip st in first dc, dc in next dc; *slip st in next dc, dc in next dc; repeat from * across; slip st in 3rd ch of turning ch-3-39 dc and 40 slip sts. Fasten off B. Turn.
Rows 8: Join A with slip st in first slip st, ch 3 (counts as dc); *dc in next dc, dc in next slip st; repeat from * across 79 dc . Ch 1, turn.
Row 9: Repeat Row 3.
Row 10: Dc in next dc; *dc in next slip st, dc in next dc; repeat from * across; dc in turning ch-1 - 79 dc. Ch 1, turn.
Rows 11 and 12: Repeat Rows 9 and 10 once. At end of Row 12, fasten off A. Turn.
Rows 13-36: Repeat rows 5-12 three times more.
Row 37: Repeat Row 7.
Row 38: Repeat Row 6.

Row 39: Repeat Row 5.
Rows 40-44: Repeat Rows 8-12.
Rows 45-60: Repeat Rows $37-44$ two times more.
Rows 61-66: Repeat Rows 37-42 once.
Row 67: Sc in first dc and in each dc across, sc in 3rd ch of turning ch-3-79 sc. Ch 1, turn. Do not fasten off.

## EDGING:

Round 1: Work 3 sc in first sc (corner made), sc in next 77 sc across top, 3 sc in last sc (corner made), sc in left edge of Rows 66-2, working 2 sc around post of each dc on even numbered rows and 1 sc in each slip st or ch on odd numbered rows, 3 sc in edge of row 1 (corner made), sc in free loop of next 77 chs across bottom, 3 sc in free loop of last ch (corner made), sc in right edge of rows 2-66, working 2 sc around turning ch-3 spaces of each even numbered row and 1 sc in each slip st on odd numbered rows - 362 sc. Join with slip st in first sc. Fasten off A. Rnd 2: Join B with slip st in 2nd sc of 3 sc in any corner, ch 3 (counts as dc), 2 dc in same sc as joining; 3 dc in next sc; *2 dc in next sc and in each sc across to next corner**; 3 dc in each of 3 sc in corner; repeat from * 3 times more, ending final repeat at ${ }^{* *}$; 3 dc in first sc of 3 sc in last corner - 736 dc . Join with slip st in first sc.
Rnd 3: Slip st in next dc, ch 1, sc in same dc;* sk next 2 dc, shell in next dc, sk next 2 sc , sc in next dc; repeat from * to next corner; sc in next dc; repeat from * around - 122 shells. Join with slip st in first sc. Fasten off B.

FINISHING:
Weave in all ends.
