What you will need:

RED HEART® Fleece Hugs: one ball 7015 Airplane

Susan Bates® Crochet Hook: 8mm [US L-11]

Yarn needle

GAUGE: 9 sts = 4" [10 cm]: 4 rows = 4" [10 cm] in pattern stitch. CHECK YOUR GAUGE. Use any size hook to obtain the gauge.

One-Ball Gentle Ripple Crochet Baby Blanket

This blanket is made with just one ball of soft, fun, self-striping varn making it perfect for gifts and naps. Blanket measures 34" [86 cm] x 34" [86 cm].

SPECIAL ABBREVIATIONS

dc2tog: [Yarn over, insert hook in next stitch, yarn over and pull up loop, yarn over, draw through 2 loops 2 times, varn over, draw through all loops on hook.

BLANKET

Row 1: Dc in 3rd ch from hook, ch 1, skip next st, [dc in next st, ch 1, skip next st] twice, [dc2tog] twice, ch 1, skip next st, [dc in next st, ch 1, skip next st] twice, *work 2 dc in each of next 2 sts, ch 1, skip next st, [dc in next st, ch 1, skip next st] twice, [dc2tog] twice, ch 1, skip next st, [dc in next st, ch 1, skip next st] twice; repeat from * last st, 2 dc in last st. Row 2: Ch 3 (counts as first dc here and throughout), turn, dc in same st, dc in next 5 sts, [dc2tog] twice, dc in next 5 sts, *work 2 dc in each of next 2 sts, dc

Row 3: Ch 3, turn, dc in same st, ch 1, skip next st, [dc in next st, ch 1, skip next st] twice, [dc2tog] twice, ch 1, skip next st, [dc in next st, ch 1, skip next st] twice, *work 2 dc in each of next 2 sts, ch 1, skip next st, [dc in next st, ch 1, skip next st] twice, [dc2tog] twice, ch 1, skip next st, [dc in next st, ch 1, skip next st] twice; repeat from * to last st, 2 dc in last st.

in next 5 sts, [dc2tog] twice, dc in next

5 sts; repeat from * to last st, 2 dc in last

Repeat Rows 2-3 until piece measures 34" [86 cm] from beginning, end with a Row 3. Fasten off.

FINISHING

Weave in ends.

ABBREVIATIONS

ch = chain; cm = centimeters; dc = double crochet; mm = millimeters; **p** = purl; **p2tog** = purl 2 sts together; st(s) = stitch(es); tog = together [] = work directions in brackets the number of times specified; * or ** = repeat whatever follows the * or ** as indicated.
