RED HEART ${ }^{*}$ Fleece Hugs: one ball 7015 Airplane

Susan Bates ${ }^{\circledR}$ Crochet Hook: 8 mm [US L-11]

Yarn needle
GAUGE: 9 sts $=4^{\prime \prime}[10 \mathrm{~cm}] ; 4$ rows $=4$ " $[10 \mathrm{~cm}]$ in pattern stitch. CHECK YOUR GAUGE. Use any size hook to obtain the gauge.

> One-Ball Gentle Ripple Crochet Baby Blanket

This blanket is made with just one ball of soft, fun, self-striping yarn making it perfect for gifts and naps.

## SPECIAL ABBREVIATIONS

dc2tog: [Yarn over, insert hook in next stitch, yarn over and pull up loop, yarn over, draw through 2 loops] 2 times, yarn over, draw through all loops on hook.

## BLANKET

## Ch 83.

Row 1: Dc in 3rd ch from hook, ch 1, skip next st, [dc in next st, ch 1, skip next st] twice, [dc2tog] twice, ch 1, skip next st, [dc in next st, ch 1, skip next st] twice, *work 2 dc in each of next 2 sts, ch 1, skip next st, [dc in next st, ch 1, skip next st] twice, [dc2tog] twice, ch 1, skip next st, [dc in next st, ch 1, skip next st] twice; repeat from * last st, 2 dc in last st.
Row 2: Ch 3 (counts as first dc here and throughout), turn, dc in same st, dc in next 5 sts, [dc2tog] twice, dc in next 5 sts, *work 2 dc in each of next 2 sts, dc in next 5 sts, [dc2tog] twice, dc in next 5 sts; repeat from * to last st, 2 dc in last st.
Row 3: Ch 3, turn, dc in same st, ch 1, skip next st, [dc in next st, ch 1 , skip next st] twice, [dc2tog] twice, ch 1, skip next st, [dc in next st, ch 1, skip next st] twice, *work 2 dc in each of next 2 sts, ch 1 , skip next st, [dc in next st, ch 1, skip next st] twice, [dc2tog] twice, ch 1, skip next st, [dc in next st, ch 1, skip next st] twice; repeat from * to last st, 2 dc in last st.

Repeat Rows 2-3 until piece measures $34 "$ [86 cm] from beginning, end with a Row 3. Fasten off.

Weave in ends
