CROCHET | SKILL LEVEL: **EASY**

ABBREVIATIONS

Approx = Approximately

Beg = Beginning

Ch = Chain(s)

Cont = Continuity

Dc = Double crochet

Pat = Pattern

Rep = Repeat

Rnd(s) = Round(s)

RS = Right side

Sc = Single crochet

Sl st = Slip stitch

St(s) = Stitch(es)

MEASUREMENTS

Approx 30" x 34" [76 x 86.5 cm].

GAUGE

11 sc and 13 rows = 4" [10 cm].

INSTRUCTIONS

Notes: Worked over a foundation chain of 10 + 9.

Ch 3 at beg of row counts as dc. To change colors, work to last 2 loops on hook of first color. Draw new color through last 2 loops and proceed with new color.

With MC, ch 79.

1st row: (RS). 1 dc in 4th ch from hook. 1 dc in each of next 5 ch. *1 sc in each of next 3 ch. 1 dc in each of next 7 ch. Rep from * to end of row. Turn.

2nd row: Ch 3. 1 dc in each of next 6 dc. *1 sc in each of next 3 sc. 1 dc in each of next 7 dc. Rep from * to last 7 sts. 1 dc in each of last 7 sts. Turn. Break MC. Join A.



MATERIALS

Red Heart® Hygge™ (5 oz/141 g; 132 yds/121 m)

Main Color (MC) Pearl (8406) **3 balls**

Contrast A Rust (8319) **1 ball**

Contrast B Powder (8724) **1 ball**

Size U.S. K/10½ (6.5 mm) crochet hook **or size needed to obtain gauge.**

3rd row: Ch 1. 1 sc in each of next 7 sts. *1 dc in each of next 3 sts. 1 sc in each of next 7 sts. Rep from * to end of row. Turn.

4th row: As 3rd row. Break A. Join MC.

5th row: Ch 3. *1 dc in each of next 6 sts. 1 sc in each of next 3 sts. Rep from * to last 7 sts. 1 dc in each of last 7 sts. Turn.

6th row: As 5th row. Break MC. Join B.

7th row: As 3rd row.

8th row: As 7th row. Break B. Join MC.

9th row: As 5th row.

10th row: As 9th row. Break MC. Join A.

Rep 3rd to 10th rows until work from beg measures approx 32" [81.5 cm] ending on a WS row.

Border: 1st rnd: (RS) *With RS facing join MC with sl st to top right corner, 1 sc in each st to end of row. 3 sc in corner. Work 88 sc evenly along side of Blanket. 3 sc in corner. Rep from * around. Join with sl st to first st.

2nd rnd: Work 1 sc in each st around, working 3 sc in in each corner. Join with sl st to first st.

3rd rnd: As 2nd rnd. Fasten off.
