## Daisy Farm Crafts



CROCHET | SKILL LEVEL: **EASY**

### ABBREVIATIONS

**Approx** = Approximately  
**Beg** = Beginning  
**Ch** = Chain(s)  
**Cont** = Continue(ity)  
**Pat** = Pattern  
**Rep** = Repeat  
**Rnd(s)** = Round(s)  
**RS** = Right side

**Sc** = Single crochet  
**Sl st** = Slip stitch  
**Sp(s)** = Space(s)  
**St(s)** = Stitch(es)  
**Tog** = Together  
**WS** = Wrong side  
**Yoh** = Yarn over hook

### MEASUREMENTS

Approx 32" by 37" [81.5 by 94 cm].

### GAUGE

14 sc and 14 rows = 4" [10 cm].

### INSTRUCTIONS

#### Hannah's Notes:

- Ch-2 at beg of row counts as a ch-1 sp.
- When changing yarn colors, work to last 2 loops on hook
- of first color. Draw new color through last 2 loops and proceed in new color, leaving old color at WS of work.
- After changing colors, you can either leave a long tail to weave in, or you can carry the colour not in use across the top of your work, crocheting over it as you go.
- For my version, I carried A along the top of rows worked in B. I did

### MATERIALS

**Red Heart® With Love™** (7 oz/198 g; 370 yds/338 m)

**Contrast A** Mallard (1623) **2 balls**

**Contrast B** White (1001) **1 ball**

Size U.S. K/10½ (6.5 mm) crochet hook **or size needed to obtain gauge.** Yarn needle.

not carry B across rows worked in A, and instead cut yarn and wove in all ends.

### Stripe Pat

With A, work 9 rows.

\*\*With B, work 1 row.

With A, work 3 rows.

With B, work 1 row.

With A, work 9 rows.\*\*

Rep from \*\* to \*\* 6 times more.

These 107 rows form stripe pat.

With A, ch 100.

**1st row:** (WS). 1 sc in 4th ch from hook (counts as ch-1 sp). \*Ch 1. Skip next ch. 1 sc in next ch. Rep from \* to end of row. Turn.

**2nd row:** (RS). Ch 1. \*1 sc in next ch-1 sp. Ch 1. Rep from \* to end of row. Work last sc in ch-1 sp between first sc and turning ch. Turn.

First two rows of Stripe Pat are now complete. Rep 2nd row for Moss St Pat until all 107 rows of Stripe Pat are complete.

Fasten off, and weave in all ends.

### Border

**Note:** When working border on corners of Blanket, in first of three corner sts worked in first rnd, slip stitch into **only one sc**, before turning and working to edge of Border. (Upon return, slip stitch into the corner space. Turn and work back to edge of Border) three times. Upon return, slip st into only one sc. Cont as established to next corner.

When you reach starting corner, sl st in corner and fasten off, leaving a long tail. Use tail to seam first and last rows of Border tog.

With RS facing, join A with sl st to any corner.

**1st rnd:** Ch 2. Work 1 rnd of Moss St evenly around Blanket working (1 sc. Ch 1. 1 sc) in each corner. Join with sl st to first sc.

Beg working in rows as follows:

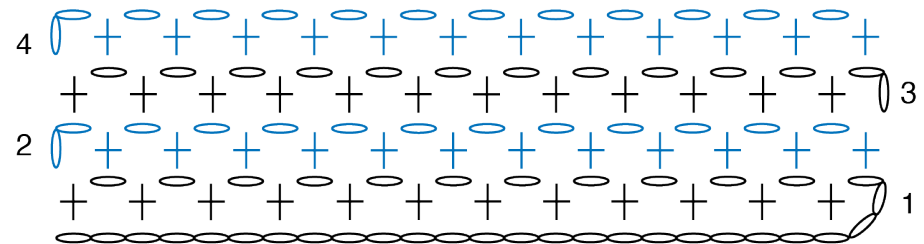
**1st row:** Ch 8. 1 sc in 2nd ch from hook. 1 sc in each of next 6 ch. Sl st in each of next 2 sts/ch-1 sps on edge of Blanket. Turn.

**2nd row:** Ch 1. *Working in back loops only*, work 1 sc in each sc to end of row. Turn.

**3rd row:** Ch 1. *Working in back*

loops only, work 1 sc in each sc to end of row. Sl st in each of next 2 sts/ch-1 sps on edge of Blanket. Turn.

Rep 2nd and 3rd rows until you have worked around entire perimeter of Blanket.
