What you will need:

RED HEART® Anne Geddes Baby™:
1 ball each of 100 Lily A, 203
Daffodil B, 504 Robin C, 702 Rosie
D and 591 Posy E for **Version 1**
OR 1 ball each of 100 Lily A, 504
Robin C and 801 Bluebell F for
Version 2

Susan Bates® Crochet Hook: 4mm
[US G-6], 3.5mm [US E-4] and 3.25
[US D-3]

Folding fabric storage cube, 11" [28
cm] tall x 10½" [26.5 cm] wide x
10½" [26.5 cm] deep, elastic thread,
⅞" [22mm] diameter coordinating
colored buttons, black embroidery
thread, matching sewing thread and
needle, yarn needle

GAUGE: 17 sc = 4" [10cm]; 19
rows = 4" [10cm] in single crochet
using 4mm [US G-6] hook. **CHECK**
YOUR GAUGE. Use any size hook to
obtain the gauge.

SHOP KIT



Royal Cube Cozy

Purchased containers from organizer departments can become nursery decorator pieces with the addition of a crocheted cozy. Our fun design features striped cozy and buttoned together bunting with sweet bear and bunny appliques. Crochet yours to coordinate with colors of your baby's nursery. For coordinating pillow and bunting designs see patterns LW3650 and LW3651.

Finished Measurement: 11" [28 cm] high x
10½" [26.5 cm] wide x 10½" [26.5 cm] deep

NOTES

Cozy is made up of 4 striped side pieces and 1 bottom piece. Version 1 uses 4 Squares with 4 different contrasting colors **CC**. Version 2 uses 2 Squares each of different contrasting colors **CC**. Carry colors not in use loosely along side of work.

SPECIAL ABBREVIATIONS

sc2tog: [Insert hook in next st, yarn over, draw yarn through st] twice, yarn over, draw yarn through 3 loops on hook.

COZY

Bottom Piece

With **A** and 4mm [US G-6] hook, ch 4, slip st in first ch to form a ring.

Round 1: Ch 3, (counts as dc here and throughout), work 11 dc in ring, slip st in top of beginning ch to join – 12 dc.

Round 2: Ch 3, *(2 dc, tr) in next dc, (tr, 2 dc) in next dc, dc in next dc; repeat from * twice more, (2 dc, tr) in dc, (tr, 2 dc) in next dc, slip st in top of beginning ch – 28 sts.

Round 3: Ch 3, dc in next 2 dc, *(2 dc, tr) in next tr, (tr, 2 dc) in next tr, dc in next 5 dc; repeat from * twice more, (2 dc, tr) in next tr, (tr, 2 dc) in next tr, dc in next 2 dc, slip st in top of beginning ch – 44 sts.

Round 4: Ch 3, dc in next 4 dc, *(2 dc, tr) in next tr, (tr, 2 dc) in next tr, dc in next 9 dc; repeat from * twice more, (2 dc, tr) in next tr, (tr, 2 dc) in next tr, dc in next 4 dc, slip st in top of beginning ch – 60 sts.

Round 5: Ch 3, dc in next 6 dc, *(2 dc, tr) in next tr, (tr, 2 dc) in next tr, dc in next 13 dc;

repeat from * twice more, (2 dc, tr) in next tr, (tr, 2 dc) in next tr, dc in next 6 dc, slip st in top of beginning ch – 76 sts.

Round 6: Ch 3, dc in next 8 dc, *(2 dc, tr) in next tr, (tr, 2 dc) in next tr, dc in next 17 dc; repeat from * twice more, (2 dc, tr) in next tr, (tr, 2 dc) in next tr, dc in next 8 dc, slip st in top of beginning ch – 92 sts.

Round 7: Ch 3, dc in next 10 dc, *(2 dc, tr) in next tr, (tr, 2 dc) in next tr, dc in next 21 dc; repeat from * twice more, (2 dc, tr) in next tr, (tr, 2 dc) in next tr, dc in next 10 dc, slip st in top of beginning ch – 108 sts.

Round 8: Ch 3, dc in next 12 dc, *(2 dc, tr) in next tr, (tr, 2 dc) in next tr, dc in next 25 dc; repeat from * twice more, (2 dc, tr) in next tr, (tr, 2 dc) in next tr, dc in next 12 dc, slip st in top of beginning ch – 124 sts.

Round 9: Ch 3, dc in next 14 dc, *(2 dc, tr) in next tr, (tr, 2 dc) in next tr, dc in next 29 dc; repeat from * twice more, (2 dc, tr) in next tr, (tr, 2 dc) in next tr, dc in next 14 dc, slip st in top of beginning ch – 140 sts.

Fasten off.

Note

Make 1 each with A and B, C, D or E as contrasting color CC for Version 1 OR make 2 each with A and C and F as contrasting color CC for Version 2.

If desired, change to smaller hook on last rows for a tighter fit.

Side Panel

With **A** and 4mm [US G-6] hook, ch 40.

Row 1: Sc in 2nd ch from hook and each ch – 39 sts.

Continued...



Rows 2-3: Change to **CC**, ch 1, turn, sc in each st across.

Rows 4-5: Change to **A**, ch 1, turn, sc in each st across.

Rows 6-55: Continue to work in sc, alternating **A** and **CC** every 2 rows, end with 2 rows of **CC**. Fasten off.

FINISHING

Side Panel Edging

With right side facing and 4mm [US G-6] hook, join **A** at side edge of Side Panel, sc 50 sts evenly spaced along edge. Fasten off. Repeat along opposite side edge. Repeat Edging along each side edge of each Side Panel.

With stripes running horizontally and foundation ch of each Side Panel along edges of Bottom piece, join **A** at one corner, working through both layers, sc lower edge of Side Panels and Bottom piece together. Fasten off. For Version 2, alternate **C** and **F** Side Panels.

With right side facing and 4mm [US G-6] hook, join **A** at side edge of two Side Panels, working through both layers, sc side edges together, taking care to line up stripes. Fasten off. Repeat to join all sides.

Top Edging

Round 1: With 3.5mm [US E-4] hook, join **A** in any st along top edge, ch 1, sc in same st and in each st around, working 1 st in each side seam, slip st in first sc to join – 160 sts.

Round 2: Ch 1, sc in same st and in each st around.

Round 3: Ch 1, sc in same st and in next 7 sts, sc2tog, *sc in next 8 sc, sc2tog; repeat from * 15 times, slip st in first sc – 144 sts.

Round 4: Ch 1, sc in same st and in each st around, slip st in first sc. Fasten off.

Weave in ends.

Thread a length of elastic thread around top of Cozy to pull in. Cut and knot ends.

Sew a button in each corner and in center of each side along top edge of Cozy for Pennant Bunting.

PENNANT BUNTING

Make 8

With 3.5mm [US E-4] hook and **A**, ch 24.

Row 1: Sc in 2nd ch from hook and each ch across – 23 sts.

Row 2: Ch 1, turn, sc in each st across.

Decrease Row: Ch 1, turn, skip first st, sc in each st to last 2 sts, sc2tog – 21 sts.

Next Row: Ch 1, turn, sc in each st across. Repeat last 2 rows until 3 sts remain.

Last Row: Ch 1, turn, skip first st, sc2tog. Fasten off.

Edging Round: With 3.5mm [US E-4] hook, join **A** in first ch along opposite edge of foundation ch, ch 8, slip st in same st for button loop, sc in each ch across, ch 8, slip st in same st for button loop, turn to work along side edge, sc 20 sts evenly spaced along edge to last st, 3 sc in point, turn to work along opposite side edge, sc 20 sts evenly spaced along opposite side edge, slip st to first st. Fasten off.

Bunny or Bear Head

Make 8 Bunnies or Bears; 2 each in **B**, **C**, **D** and **E**

With 3.25 [US D-3] hook, ch 4.

Row 1: Sc in 2nd ch from hook, 2 sc in next ch, sc in last ch – 4 sts.

Row 2: Ch 1, turn, sc in first st, 2 sc in next 2 sts, sc in last st – 6 sts.

Row 3: Ch 1, turn, 2 sc in next st, sc in next 4 sts, 2 sc in last st – 8 sts.

Row 4: Ch 1, turn, 2 sc in next st, sc in next 6 sts, 2 sc in last st – 10 sts.

Rows 5-7: Sc in each st across.

Row 8: Ch 1, turn, skip first st, sc in each st to last 2 sts, sc2tog – 8 sts.

Row 9: Ch 1, turn, sc in next 2 sts, [sc2tog] twice, sc in last 2 sts – 6 sts.

Row 10: Ch 1, turn, skip first st, sc in next 3 sts, sc2tog – 4 sts.

Edging Round: Sc evenly spaced around edges to first st, slip st in first sc. Fasten off.

Bunny Ears

Make 2 for each Bunny

With same color and 3.25 [US D-3] hook, ch 5.

Round 1: Sc in 2nd ch from hook and next 2 ch, 5 hdc in last ch, turn to work opposite edge of foundation ch, sc in next 3 ch, slip st to first sc to join. Fasten off.

Bear Ears

Make 2 for each Bear

With same color and 3.25 [US D-3] hook, ch 2.

Round 1: 8 sc in 2nd ch from hook, slip st in first sc. Fasten off.

Muzzle

Make 8

With **A** and 3.25 [US D-3] hook, ch 4.

Round 1: Sc in 2nd ch from hook and next ch, 3 sc in last ch, turn to work opposite edge of foundation ch, sc in next 2 ch, slip st to first sc to join.

Fasten off.

Abbreviations

A, B, C = Color A, B, C; **ch** = chain; **dc** = double crochet; **hdc** = half double crochet; **mm** = millimeters; **sc** = single crochet; **st(s)** = stitch(es); **tog** = together; **tr** = triple or treble crochet; **yo** = yarn over; **[]** = work directions in brackets the number of times specified; ***** or ****** = repeat whatever follows the ***** or ****** as indicated.

FINISHING

Using black embroidery thread and following photograph, work nose on Muzzle in satin st. Sew Muzzle to Bunny or Bear face. Embroider eyes on face. Sew Ears in place.

Sew a Bunny or Bear Head in center of each Pennant. Button each Pennant on Cozy.
