What you will need:

RED HEART® Super Saver®: 1 skein each 530 Orchid A and 316 Soft White B

Susan Bates® Crochet Hook: 6mm [US J-10]

Yarn needle, stitch marker (optional)

GAUGE: 13 sts = 4" (10 cm); 9 rows = 4" (10 cm), in half double crochet. CHECK YOUR GAUGE. Use any size hook to obtain the gauge.

Chevron Chic Baby Dress

This is a darling dress for the modern baby!
Crocheted chevrons circle around the skirt
with eye-catching style.
For little girl version, see Child's Chevron
Dress LW4366.

Directions are for size 3 months. Changes for sizes 6 months, 12 months, 18 months, and 24 months are in parentheses.

Finished Chest: 16 (17, 18, 19, 20)" [40.5 (43, 45.5, 48.5, 51) cm]

Finished Length: 12½ (13½, 14½, 16, 17½)" [32 (34.5, 37, 40.5, 44.5) cm]

Special Stitches

dc3tog = [Yarn over, insert hook in next stitch, yarn over and pull up loop, yarn over, draw through 2 loops] 3 times, yarn over, draw through all 4 loops on hook.

Fhdc (Foundation half double crochet (This technique creates a foundation chain and a row of half double crochet stitches in one) = **Step 1:** Place a slip knot on hook, ch 3, yarn over, insert hook in 3rd ch from hook and draw up a loop; yarn over and draw through one loop on hook (the "chain"); yarn over and draw through 3 loops on hook (the "half double crochet").

Step 2: Yarn over, insert hook into the "chain" of the previous stitch and draw up a loop, yarn over and draw through one loop on hook (the "chain"), yarn over and draw through 3 loops on hook (the "half double crochet"). Repeat step 2 for the length of foundation.

hdc2tog = [Yarn over, insert hook in next
stitch, yarn over and pull up loop] 2 times,
yarn over and draw through all 5 loops on
hook.

Notes

- 1. Dress is worked from the top down in 2 sections: bodice and skirt.
- Bodice is worked in seamlessly joined rounds with right side facing at all times.
 One stitch is skipped at the beginning of each round and the last stitch(es) are worked into the skipped stitch before joining the round with a slip stitch.

- Skirt is made in a chevron pattern which consists of a series of 3-dc "peaks" and dc3tog "valleys" with double crochet stitches worked between. You may need to work several rows before the chevron is clearly visible.
- To change color, work last stitch of old color to last yarn over. Yarn over with new color and draw through all loops on hook to complete stitch. Proceed with new color. Cut old color.

DRESS

Bodice

Round 1 (right side): With A, Fhdc 35 (38, 40, 45, 48); taking care not to twist sts, join with slip st in first Fhdc—35 (38, 40, 45, 48) sts. Note When completing round, work last stitch(es) in front of beginning chains and in skipped stitch before joining last stitch to first hdc.

Round 2: Ch 2 (does not count as a st here and throughout), skip next st, *hdc in next 6 (18, 19, 8, 23) sts, 2 (2, 1, 2, 2) hdc in next st; repeat from * around; join with slip st in first st—40 (40, 40, 50, 50) sts.

Round 3: Ch 2, skip next st, *hdc in next 3 (3, 3, 4, 4) sts, 2 hdc in next st; repeat from * around; join with slip st in first st—50 (50, 50, 60, 60) sts.

Round 4: Ch 2, skip next st, *hdc in next 4 (4, 4, 5, 5) sts, 2 hdc in next st; repeat from * around; join with slip st in first st—60 (60, 60, 70, 70) sts.

Round 5: Ch 2, skip next st, *hdc in next 5 (5, 5, 6, 6) sts, 2 hdc in next st; repeat from * around; join with slip st in first st—70 (70, 70, 80, 80) sts.

Continued...



Size 3 months only:

Round 6: Ch 2, skip next st, 2 hdc in next st, hdc in next 8 sts, 2 hdc in next st, *hdc in next 9 sts, 2 hdc in next st; repeat from * around; join with slip st in first st—78 sts.

Round 7: Ch 2, skip next st, *hdc in next 17 sts, ch 1, skip next 17 sts, hdc in next 22 sts (armhole made), ch 1, skip next 17 sts, hdc in last 5 sts (armhole made); join with slip st in first st—44 sts and 2 ch.

Size 6 months only:

Round 6: Ch 2, skip next st, *hdc in next 6 sts, 2 hdc in next st; repeat from * around; join with slip st in first st—80 sts.

Round 7: Ch 2, skip next st, *hdc in next 19 sts, 2 hdc in next st; repeat from * around; join with slip st in first st—84 sts.

Round 8: Ch 2, skip next st, 2 hdc in next st, hdc in next 18 sts, ch 1, skip next 18 sts, 2 hdc in next st, hdc in next 23 sts (armhole made), ch 1, skip next 18 sts, hdc in last 5 sts (armhole made); join with slip st in first st—50 sts and 2 ch.

Size 12 months only:

Round 6: Ch 2, skip next st, *hdc in next 6 sts, 2 hdc in next st; repeat from * around; join with slip st in first st—80 sts.

Round 7: Ch 2, skip next st, *hdc in next 9 sts, 2 hdc in next st; repeat from * around; join with slip st in first st—88 sts.

Round 8: Ch 2, skip next st, hdc in each st around: join with slip st in first st.

Round 9: Ch 2, skip next st, hdc in next 20 sts, ch 1, skip next 19 sts, hdc in next 25 sts (armhole made), ch 1, skip next 19 sts, hdc in last 5 sts (armhole made); join with slip st in first st—50 sts and 2 ch.

Size 18 months only:

Round 6: Ch 2, skip next st, *hdc in next 7 sts, 2 hdc in next st; repeat from * around; join with slip st in first st—90 sts.

Round 7: Ch 2, skip next st, *hdc in next 44 sts, 2 hdc in next st; repeat from * around; join with slip st in first st—92 sts.

Rounds 8 and 9: Ch 2, skip next st, hdc in each st around; join with slip st in first st.

Round 10: Ch 2, skip next st, hdc in next 21 sts, ch 1, skip next 20 sts, hdc in next 26 sts (armhole made), ch 1, skip next 20 sts, hdc in last 5 sts (armhole made); join with slip st in first st—52 sts and 2 ch.

Size 24 months only:

Round 6: Ch 2, skip next st, *hdc in next 7 sts, 2 hdc in next st; repeat from * around; join with slip st in first st—90 sts.

Round 7: Ch 2, skip next st, hdc in next 10 sts, *hdc in next 9 sts, 2 hdc in next st; repeat from * around; join with slip st in first st—98 sts

Rounds 8–10: Ch 2, skip next st, hdc in each st around; join with slip st in first st.

Round 11: Ch 2, skip next st, hdc in next 23 sts, ch 1, skip next 21 sts, hdc in next 28 sts (armhole made), ch 1, skip next 21 sts, hdc in last 5 sts (armhole made); join with slip st in first st—56 sts and 2 ch.

All sizes:

Round 8 (9, 10, 11, 12): Ch 2, skip next st, hdc in each st and ch; join with slip st in first st—46 (52, 52, 54, 58) sts.

Round 9 (10, 11, 12, 13): Ch 2, skip next st, *hdc in next 22 (25, 25, 26, 28) sts, 2 (2, 2, 1, 2) hdc in next st; repeat from * once; join with slip st in first st—48 (54, 54, 54, 60) sts.

Skirt

Round 10 (11, 12, 13, 14): Ch 3 (counts as first dc here and throughout), 2 dc in same st as join, *dc in next st, dc3tog, dc in next st, 3 dc in next st; repeat from * to last 5 sts, dc in next st, dc3tog, dc in last st; join with slip st in top of beginning ch—48 (54, 54, 54, 60) sts. Note The following rounds (except the last) begin with a slip st in center dc of first 3-dc group. The "last st" of each round is worked in the first dc of the first 3-dc group (same as the joining stitch of the previous round).

Round 11 (12, 13, 14, 15): Slip st in next st; change to B, ch 3, 2 dc in same st, *dc in next 2 sts, beginning in last st worked, dc3tog, dc in same st as last "leg" of dc3tog, dc in next st, 3 dc in next st; repeat from * to last 5 sts, dc in next 2 sts, beginning in last st worked, dc3tog, dc in same st as last "leg" of dc3tog, dc in last st; join with slip st in top of beginning ch—64 (72, 72, 72, 80) sts.

Round 12 (13, 14, 15, 16): Slip st in next st, ch 3, 2 dc in same st, *dc in next 3 sts, beginning in st just worked, dc3tog, dc in same st as last "leg" of dc3tog, dc in next 2 sts, 3 dc in next st; repeat from * to last 7 sts, dc in next 3 sts, beginning in st just worked, dc3tog, dc in same st as last "leg" of dc3tog, dc in last 2 sts; join with slip st in top of beginning ch—80 (90, 90, 90, 100) sts.

Round 13 (14, 15, 16, 17): Slip st in next st; change to A, ch 3, 2 dc in same st, *dc in next 3 sts, dc3tog, dc in next 3 sts, 3 dc in next st; repeat from * to last 9 sts, dc in next 3 sts, dc3tog, dc in last 3 sts; join with slip st in top of beginning ch.

Rounds 14 (15, 16, 17, 18)–21 (24, 25, 28, 30): Repeat Round 13 (14, 15, 16, 17) eight (ten, ten, twelve, thirteen) times and change color as in the following color sequence: Work 1 (1, 1, 1, 1) round with **A**, 2 (2, 2, 2, 2) rounds with **B**, 2 (2, 2, 2, 2) rounds with **A**, 2 (2, 2, 2, 2, 2)

2) rounds with **B**, 1 (2, 2, 2, 2) round(s) with **A**, 0 (1, 1, 2, 2) round(s) with **B**, 0 (0, 0, 1, 2) round(s) with **A**.

Do not change color.

Last Round: Ch 1, sc in first 3 sts, hdc in next 2 sts, dc in next 3 sts, hdc in next 2 sts, *sc in next 3 sts, hdc in next 2 sts, dc in next 3 sts, hdc in next 2 sts; repeat from * around; join with slip st in first sc. Fasten off.

Neckline

Round 1 (right side): With right side facing, join A with slip st in center st at back of Round 1, ch 1, sc in same st and in each st around; join with slip st in first sc—35 (38, 40, 45, 48) sts. Fasten off.

Sleeve Edging (work 2)

Notes Edging is worked in continuous rounds. Do not join at end of Round 1. Flatten dress so you can determine the center stitch of the underarm. You may want to place a stitch marker on this stitch.

Round 1 (right side): With right side facing, join A with slip st in st at back of sleeve, ch 1, skip first st, hdc in each st to 2 sts before center st of underarm, hdc2tog, hdc in center st, hdc2tog, hdc in remaining sts, working last hdc in first skipped st—18 (19, 20, 21, 22). Round 2: Ch 1, sc in each st around; join with slip st in first st. Fasten off.

FINISHING

Weave in ends. Block if necessary.

ABBREVIATIONS

A, B = Color A, Color B; ch = chain; dc = double crochet; hdc = half double crochet; sc = single crochet; st(s) = stitch(es); * = repeat whatever follows the * as indicated.
