## What you will need:

RED HEART ${ }^{*}$ Baby Hugs Medium: 2 balls 4001 Frosting A and 1 ball 4724 Pinkie B

Susan Bates ${ }^{\circledR}$ Crochet Hook 5 mm [US H-8] and 6 mm [US J-10]

Yarn needle, $2(3,3,4) 3 / 4$-inch buttons, sewing needle and thread to match buttons

GAUGE: 7 V-sts $=4^{\prime \prime}(10 \mathrm{~cm})$; 14 rows $=4^{\prime \prime}(10 \mathrm{~cm})$. CHECK YOUR GAUGE. Use any size hook to obtain the gauge.


Perfect for the next baby shower, this onesie set is crocheted with easy-care quality yarn. Trimmed with fashionable flowers, it is special enough for her first photo shoot. Choose this yarn with the blue heart on the ball band and know that it has been tested for harmful substances.

## Onesie directions are for size 6 months. Changes for

 sizes 12 months, 18 months, and 24 months are in parentheses.Hat directions are for size 6-12 months. Changes for size 18-24 months are in parentheses.

## Onesie measures 16 (18, 20, 22)" [40.5 (45.5, 51, 56) cm]

 chest.Hat measures 14 (16)" [35.5 (40.5) cm] circumference at brim.

## Special Stitches

beg V-st2tog (beginning V-stitch 2 together) = Sc2tog in first 2 V -sts, ch 1, sc in 2nd V-st just worked end $V$-st2tog (ending $V$-stitch 2 together) = Sc in next V-st, ch 1, sc2tog in same V-st just worked and last V-st. lg petal (large petal) = (Slip st, ch 3, 3-dc cl, ch 3 slip st) in indicated stitch
petal cl (petal cluster) = Yarn over, insert hook in indicated space, yarn over and pull up loop, yarn over, draw through 2 loops on hook (2 loops remain on hook); *yarn over twice, insert hook in same space, yarn over and pull up loop, [yarn over, draw through 2 loops on hook] twice; repeat from * once (4 loops remain on hook), yarn over, insert hook in same space yarn over, pull up a loop, yarn over, draw through 2 loops on hook (5 loops remain on hook), yo, draw through all 5 loops on hook.
sc2tog = [Insert hook in next stitch, yarn over and pull up a loop] twice, yarn over and draw through all 3 loops on hook.
sm petal (small petal) $=(2-\mathrm{dc} \mathrm{Cl}, \mathrm{ch} 3$, slip st) in indicated stitch.
V-st (V-stitch) $=(\mathrm{Sc}, \mathrm{ch} 1, \mathrm{sc})$ in indicated stitch.
2-dc Cl (2 double crochet cluster) = Yarn over, insert hook in indicated stitch, yarn over and pull up loop, yarn over, draw through 2 loops on hook (2 loops remain on hook); yarn over, insert hook in same stitch, yarn over and pull up loop, yarn over, draw through 2 loops, yarn over, draw through all 3 loops on hook

3-dc Cl (3 double crochet cluster) = Yarn over, insert hook in indicated space, yarn over and pull up loop, yarn over, draw through 2 loops on hook (2 loops remain on hook); [yarn over, insert hook in same space, yarn over and pull up loop, yarn over, draw through 2 loops] 2 times, yarn over, draw through all 4 loops on hook.

## Notes

1. Onesie is made from front and back pieces worked in turned rows, then sewn together. Crotch closes with buttons.
2. Hat is worked in continuous rounds. Do not join unless instructed to do so. Place marker for beginning of round and move marker up as each round is completed.
3. When instructed to work into a V-stitch, work into the chain-1 space of the V-stitch.
4. Beginning and ending V-stitch 2 together count as V -stitches.
5. To change color, work last stitch of old color to last yarn over. Yarn over with new color and draw through all loops on hook to complete stitch. Proceed with new color. Cut old color.

## ONESIE <br> BACK

## Leg Openings

With larger hook and A, ch $10(14,14,18)$,
Row 1 (right side): V-st in 2nd ch from hook, *skip next ch, V-st in next ch; repeat from * across, turn-5 (7, 7, 9) V-sts.
Row 2 (buttonhole row): Ch 1, V-st in first V-st, *ch 1, skip next V-st, V-st in next $V$-st; repeat from * to end, turn-3 $(4,4,5) \mathrm{V}$-sts and $2(3,3,4) \mathrm{ch}$ - 1 buttonholes.


Row 3: Ch 1, (sc, V-st) in first V-st, V-st in each $V$-st and ch-1 buttonhole across to last $V$-st, ( $V$-st, sc) in last $V$-st, turn-5 (7, 7, 9) V-sts and 2 sc.
Row 4: Ch 1, V-st in first sc, V-st in each V -st across, V -st in last sc, turn-7 (9, 9, 11) V-sts.

Row 5: Ch 1, V-st in each V-st across, turn.
Row 6: Repeat Row 5.
Rows 7-14: Repeat Rows 3-6 twice-11 (13, 13, 15) V-sts.
Rows 15 and 16: Repeat Rows 5 and 6.
Rows 17 and 18: Repeat Rows 3 and
4-13 (15, 15, 17) V-sts.
Sizes 18 months and 24 months only:
Rows 19 and 20: Repeat Rows 3 and
4-17 (19) V-sts.
Row 21: Repeat Row 5.

## All sizes:

Body
Repeat Row 5 of Leg Openings 17 (19, 23) times.

## Armholes

Row 1: Slip st in first V-st, ch 1, V-st in each $V$-st across to last $V$-st; leave last V-st unworked, turn-11 $(13,15,17)$ V-sts. Row 2: Repeat Row 5 of leg openings. Row 3: Ch 1, beg V-st2tog in first 2 V -sts V -st in each V -st across to last 2 V -sts, end V-st2tog, turn-9 (11, 13, 15) V-sts. Rows 4-9 (11, 13, 15): Repeat Row 5 of leg openings.

## First Shoulder and Neck

Row 1: Ch 1, V-st in first 3 V -sts, slip st in next $V$-st; leave remaining sts unworked, turn-3 V-sts.
Row 2: Ch 1, beg V-st2tog, V-st in last V-st, turn-2 V -sts.
Row 3: Repeat Row 5 of leg openings.
Row 4: Ch 1, beg V-st2tog, turn-1 V-st. Row 5: Ch 1, working in each sc of V-st, sc2tog-1 sc. Fasten off.

## 2nd Shoulder and Neck

Row 1 (wrong side): With wrong side of back facing, join $\mathbf{A}$ with sc in first V -st of Row 1 of armhole, ch 1 , sc in same st (first V -st made), V -st in next 2 V -sts, slip st in next V -st; leave remaining st unworked, turn-3 V-sts.
Rows 2-5: Repeat Rows 2-5 of first shoulder and neck; change to $\mathbf{B}$ at end of row 5 . Do not fasten off.

## Contrast Band

Row 1: Ch 1, working in ends of rows, sc evenly spaced across neck edge. Fasten off.


## FRONT

Leg Openings
With A, ch 6 (10, 10, 14).
Row 1 (right side): Repeat Row 1 of back leg openings-3 (5,5, 7) V-sts. Row 2: Repeat Row 5 of back leg openings.
Rows 3-5: Repeat Rows 3-5 of back leg openings-5 (7, 7, 9) V-sts.
Rows 6-11: Repeat Rows 3 and 4 of back leg openings 3 times-11 (13, 13, 15) V-sts.
Row 12: Repeat Row 5 of back leg openings.
Rows 13 and 14: Repeat Rows 3 and 4 of back leg openings-13 ( $15,15,17$ ) V-sts. Sizes 18 months and 24 months only: Rows 15-17: Repeat Rows 3-5 of back leg openings-17 (19) V-sts.

## All sizes: <br> Body

Work same as back body.

## Armholes

Rows 1-3: Repeat Rows 1-3 of back
armholes.
Rows 4-6 (8, 10, 12): Repeat Row 5 of leg openings.

## First Shoulder and Neck

Row 1: Ch 1, V-st in first 3 V -sts, slip st in next $V$-st; leave remaining sts unworked, turn-3 V -sts.
Row 2: Ch 1, slip st in first V-st, V-st in each V-st across-2 V-sts. Fasten off.

## 2nd Shoulder and Neck

Row 1 (wrong side): With wrong side of front facing, join $\mathbf{A}$ with sc in first V -st of Row 1 of armhole, ch 1 , sc in same st (first V -st made), V -st in next 2 V -sts, slip st in next V -st; leave remaining st unworked, turn-3 $V$-sts.
Row 2: Repeat Row 2 of first shoulder and neck; change to B. Do not fasten off.

## Contrast Band

Work same as contrast band of back.

## ASSEMBLY

Sew side seams from last row of leg opening to armhole.
With right side facing, overlap Row 5 of back shoulder to Row 1 of front shoulder and sew in place.

## First Sleeve

Round 1 (right side): With front facing, join $\mathbf{A}$ with sc in first $V$-st of Row 1 of left armhole, ch 1 , sc in same st (first V -st made); working in ends of rows, work 7 $(9,11,13)$ V-sts evenly around armhole; join with slip st in first sc, turn-8 (10, 12, 14) V-sts.

Rounds 2 and 3: Ch 1, V-st in each V-st around; join with slip st in first sc, turn. Round 4: Ch 1, *beg V-st2tog, V-st in next $1(2,3,4)$ V-st(s); repeat from * once, end $V$-st2tog, turn-5 (7, 9, 11) V-sts.
Round 5: Ch 1, V-st in each V-st around; join with slip st in first sc, turn.
Round 6: Ch 1, sc in first V-st, hdc in next $1(1,2,2) V$-st(s), dc in next $1(3,3$, 5) V-st(s), hdc in next $1(1,2,2) V$-st(s), sc in last V-st; join with slip st in first sc; change to B, turn-5 (7, 9, 11) sts.
Round 7: Ch 1, sc in each st around; join with slip st in first sc-5 (7, 9, 11) sc. Fasten off.

## 2nd Sleeve

Round 1 (right side): With back facing, join $\mathbf{A}$ with sc in first $V$-st of Row 1 of right armhole, ch 1 , sc in same st (first V -st made); working in ends of rows, work 7 (9, 11, 13) V-sts evenly around armhole; join with slip st in first sc, turn-8 (10, 12, 14) V-sts.
Rounds 2-7: Repeat Rounds 2-7 of first sleeve.

## Flower (make 4)

With A and smaller hook, ch 2.
Round 1: Work 5 sc in 2nd ch from hook; join with slip st to first sc.
Round 2: *Ch 3, sm petal in each sc around; change to $\mathbf{A}$, do not join-5 small petals.
Round 3: Ch 3 (does not count as a st or ch-3 space), (sc, ch 3) in first ch-3 space of each small petal; join with slip st in top of beginning ch-3-5 ch-3 spaces. Round 4: Slip st in next sc, Ig petal in each ch-3 space around, do not join-5 large petals.
Round 5: Holding ch-3 to wrong side, (slip st, ch 3) in first slip st of each large petal around, do not join-5 ch-3 spaces.

Round 6: (Slip st, ch 5) in each ch-3 space around, do not join-5 ch-5 spaces.
Round 7: (Slip st, ch 3, petal cl, ch 3, slip st) in each ch-5 space; join with slip st in first slip st. Fasten off, leaving a long tail for sewing.

## FINISHING ONESIE Edging

Round 1: With right side of front
facing and working in opposite side of foundation ch, join B with sc in first ch, sc in same ch, sc in each ch across to last ch, 2 sc in last ch; working in ends of rows, sc evenly spaced across front and back of left leg openings; working on opposite side of foundation ch of back, 2 sc in first ch, sc in each ch across to last ch, 2 sc in last ch; working in ends of rows, sc evenly spaced across front and back of right leg openings; join with slip st in first sc. Fasten off.

Referring to photograph as a guide, sew 3 flowers to lower back above leg openings.
Weave in ends.

## HAT

With larger hook and A, ch 4; join with slip st in first ch to form a ring.
Round 1: Work 4 V -sts in ring, do not join-4 V-sts. Place marker.
Round 2: Work 2 V -sts in each V-st-8 V-sts.
Round 3: * Cl in next V -st, 2 V -sts in next V -st; repeat from * around- 12 V -sts. Round 4: * Cl in next 2 V -sts, 2 V -st in next V-st; repeat from * around-16 V-sts.
Round 5: * Cl in next 3 V -sts, 2 V -st in
next V-st; repeat from * around-20
V-sts.

Round 6: * Cl in next 4 V -sts, 2 V -st in next V-st; repeat from * around-24 V-sts.

## Size 18-24 months only:

Round 7: *V-st in next 5 V-sts, 2 V-st in next $V$-st; repeat from * around-28 V-sts.
Both sizes:
Rounds 7-14 (8-15): V-st in each V-st around; change to $\mathbf{B}$ at end of last round. Rounds 15 and 16 (16 and 17): Sc in each sc and ch-1 space around; change to $\mathbf{A}$, turn-72 (84) sc.
Round 17 (18): Ch 1, sc in each sc around; join with slip st in first sc. Fasten off.

## FINISHING HAT

Sew 1 flower to hat.
Weave in ends.

## ABBREVIATIONS

A, B, C = Color A, Color B, Color C, etc.; $\mathbf{c h}=$ chain(s); dc = double crochet; hdc = half double crochet; sc = single crochet; st(s) = stitch(es); ( ) = work directions in parentheses into same st; [ ] = work directions in brackets the number of times specified; * = repeat whatever follows the * as indicated.
