What you will need:
RED HEART ${ }^{\oplus}$ Super Saver ${ }^{\oplus}$ : 1 skein each 512 Turqua A, 3955 Wildflower B, 316 Soft White C, and 312 Black D.

Susan Bates ${ }^{\circledR}$ Crochet Hook: 4mm [US G-6].

Yarn needle, polyester fiberfill, stitch marker.

GAUGE: 16 sts $=4^{\prime \prime}(10 \mathrm{~cm})$ and 13 rows $=4^{\prime \prime}(10 \mathrm{~cm})$. CHECK YOUR GAUGE. Use any size hook to obtain the gauge. RED HEART ${ }^{\oplus}$ Super Savere ${ }^{\text {, Art. }}$ E300 MEDIUM available in solid color $70 z(198 \mathrm{~g}), 364 \mathrm{yd}(333 \mathrm{~m})$; multicolor, heather and print $50 z$ ( 141 g ), 244 yd ( 223 m ), flecks 5 $0 z(141 \mathrm{~g}), 260 \mathrm{yds}(238 \mathrm{~m})$ skeins


## Baby Bug Hood

Just as cute as a bug in a rug, your smallest trick-or-treater will stay warm on Halloween! The googly eyes and antennae are stuffed to keep their shape.

Instructions are for Babies size 6-12 months.
Changes for size 12-24 months, are in parentheses.

Hood Height: 7½ (8½)" [19 (21.5) cm], not including Antennas.
Hood Width: 13½ (15)" [34 (38) cm], not including Collar.

## Notes

1. Ch-2 at the beginning of the row counts as a hdc throughout the pattern
2. Unless otherwise indicated, do not join rounds; instead, place marker in first st of 2nd round and move up as work progresses.
3. When changing colors, work last st of old color until 2 loops are left on hook, drop old color, yarn over with new color and complete st. Fasten off old color.

## Special Stitches

sc2tog = [Draw up a loop in next st] twice, yarn over and draw through all 3 loops on hook. hdc2tog = [Yarn over, draw up a loop in next st] twice, yarn over and draw through all 5 loops on hook.

## HOOD

With A, ch 54 (62).
Row 1: Hdc in 3rd ch from hook and in each ch across; ch 2, turn - 52 (60) sts
Row 2: Hdc in each st across; ch 2, turn. Repeat Row 2 until piece measures $71 / 2(81 / 2)$ " [19 (21.5) cm]
Next Row: Hdc in next 15 (19) sts, [hdc2tog] 10 times, hdc in next 16 (20) sts, slip st in next st - 32 (50) sts.
Do not fasten off. Fold Hood in half, with Right Sides facing; join top edges together by sc or sewing. Fasten off. Weave in ends

## Collar (Make 2)

Join B with slip st in first row. Work sts into row ends along front edge of Hood.
Row 1: Ch 3 (counts as dc throughout), dc in next 8 sts (10); ch 3, turn - 9 (11) sts.
Row 2: Dc in next 7 sts (9); ch 3, turn - 8 (10) sts.
Row 3: Dc in next 6 sts (8); ch 3, turn - 7 (9) sts.
Row 4: Dc in next 5 sts (7); ch 3, turn - 6 (8) sts.
Row 5: Dc in next 4 sts (6); ch 3, turn - 5 (7) sts.
Row 6: Dc in next 3 sts (5); ch 3, turn - 4 (6) sts.
Row 7: Dc in next 2 sts (4); ch 3, turn - 3 (5) sts.
Row 8: Dc in next st (3); ch 3, turn - 2 (4) sts. Row 9: Dc in next st (2); ch 3, turn - 2 (3) sts.
Row 10: Dc in next st; ch 3, turn - 2 sts.
Rows 11-22 (25): Repeat Row 10, slip st after last st of last repeat. Fasten off. Weave in ends.

## Antenna (Make 2)

Note: Add stuffing as work progresses for best results.
With C, ch 2.
Round 1: 5 sc in first ch -5 sts.
Round 2: 2 sc in each st around - 10 sts.
Round 3: *2 sc in next st, sc in next st; repeat from * around - 15 sts.
Round 4: *2 sc in next st, sc in next 2 sts; repeat from * around - 20 sts.
Round 5: *2 sc in next st, sc in next 3 sts; repeat from * around - 25 sts.
Rounds 6-8: Sc in each st around.
Round 9: *Sc in next 3 sts, sc2tog; repeat from * around - 20 sts.
Round 10: *Sc in next 2 sts, sc2tog; repeat from * around - 15 sts.

Continued..

## Yarnspirations

Round 11: *Sc in next st, sc2tog; repeat from * around, changing to $A$ in last st - 10 sts

Fasten off C.
Rounds 12-21: With A, sc in each st around; join with a slip st to first sc after working last st of last repeat. Finish stuffing firmly. Fasten off, leaving a long tail for sewing

## Eye (Make 2)

With D, ch 2.
Round 1:5 sc in first ch; join with a slip st to
first sc - 5 sts.
Fasten off, leaving a long tail for sewing.

## FINISHING

Using photo as a guide, sew Eyes to Antennas between Rounds 5-7. Sew Antennas to Hood approximately 6 (8) rows from top. Weave in ends.

ABBREVIATIONS: A, B, C = Color A, Color B, Color C etc; ch = chain; dc = double crochet; hdc $=$ half double crochet; $\mathrm{mm}=$ millimeters; sc = single crochet; st(s) = stitch (es); [ ] = work directions in brackets the number of times specified; * or ** = repeat whatever follows the * or ** as indicated.
