# What you will need:

RED HEART® Anne Geddes Baby™: 2 balls of 100 Lilv A: 1 ball each of 112 Night Night B, 902 Ladybug C and 691 Grass D

Susan Bates® Crochet Hooks: 4.25 mm [US G-6]

Yarn needle, stitch marker and three ½" (13mm) sew-on snaps.

GAUGE: 14 sts and 16 rows in Puff Stitch Pattern = 4" (10 cm), CHECK YOUR GAUGE. Use any size hook to obtain the gauge given.

# Snowman Cutie Baby Set

Your little snowman will be ready for the winter season in this huggable crocheted outfit. Hat has attached scarf, puff stitch sweater is closed with big black "coal" buttons and red boots have white cuffs and black soles.

Sweater directions are for child's size 6 months. Changes for 12 months and 18 months are in parentheses.

Hat directions are for size Small. Changes for Large are in parentheses.

Finished Chest: 20 (22, 24)" (51 [56, 61] cm) Finished Length: 9 (10½, 12)" (23 [26.5, 30.5) cm)

Hat: To fit head size 15 (17)" (38 [43] cm)

## **Special Abbreviations**

Puff stitch (Puff st): [Yarn over, insert hook in next st, yarn over, draw up a loop] 4 times in same st, yarn over, draw yarn through all 9 loops on hook.

single crochet 2 together (sc2tog): [Insert hook in next st, yarn over, draw yarn through st] twice, varn over, draw varn through 3 loops on hook.

# **Puff St Pattern (patt)**

(Worked on a multiple of 4 + 1 sts). Ch a multiple of 4 + 1 + 1 (for turning ch). **Set-up Row:** Sc in 2nd ch from hook, sc in each ch across turn.

Row 1 (wrong side): Ch 1, sc in each of first 3 sc, \*puff st in next sc\*\*, sc in each of next 3 sts; repeat from \* across, ending last repeat at \*\*, sc in last ch, turn.

Row 2: Ch 1, sc in each st across, turn.

Row 3: Ch 1, sc in first sc, \*puff in next sc, sc in each of next 3 sc; repeat from \* across, turn.

Row 4: Repeat Row 2. Repeat Rows 1-4 for patt.

# **SWEATER**

Sweater is worked in one piece to underarm. then divided into fronts and back.

#### Body

With **A**, ch 70 (78, 86)

Set-up Row: Sc in 2nd ch from hook, sc in each ch across turn - 69 (77, 85) sc. Work even in patt until body measures 5 (6, 7)" (12.5 [15, 18] cm) from beginning, ending with a wrong side row.

# **Divide for Fronts and Back** Right Front

**Row 1:** Work in patt across first 17 (19, 21) sts. turn.

Work even in patt on 17 (19, 21) sts until front measures 2 (2½, 3)" (5 [ 6.5, 7.5] cm), ending with a right side row.

### **Shape Neck**

Next Row: Work in patt across to last 8 sts, turn, leaving remaining sts unworked - 9 (11, 13) sts.

Work even on 9 (11, 13) sts until Right Front measures 4 (4½, 5)" (10 [11.5, 12.5] cm) from beginning of armhole. Fasten off.

#### Back

Row 1: With right side facing, join A with a slip st in first st to the left of Row 1 of Right Front. work in established patt across first 35 (39, 43) sts, turn, leaving remaining sts unworked. Work even on 35 (39, 43) sts. until Back measures 4 (4½, 5)" from beginning of armhole. Fasten off.

#### Left Front

Row 1: With right side facing, join A with a slip st in first st to the left of Row 1 of Back, work in established patt across last 17 (19, 21) sts, turn.

Work even in patt on 17 (19, 21) sts until Left Front measures 2 (2½, 3)" (5 [ 6.5, 7.5] cm), ending with a wrong side row.

# **Shape Neck**

**Next Row:** Work in patt across to last 8 sts, turn, leaving remaining sts unworked – 9 (11, 13) sts.

Work even on 9 (11, 13) sts until Right Front measures 4 (4½, 5)" (10 [11.5, 12.5] cm) from beginning of armhole. Fasten off. Sew Fronts to Back at shoulders.

## Sleeve (make 2)

With A, ch 22 (22, 26).

**Set-up Row:** Sc in 2nd ch from hook, sc in each ch across turn -21 (21, 25) sc. Work in patt, inc 1 st at each end of every 4th row 4 (6, 7) times. Then, work even in patt on 29 (33, 39) sts until Sleeve measures 6 (7, 8)" (15 [18, 20.5] cm) from beginning. Fasten off, leaving a long sewing length. Sew Sleeve seams. Sew top of Sleeves into armholes.

## **Left Front Band**

**Row 1:** With right side facing, join **A** with a slip st to top left-hand corner of Left Front edge, ch 1, work 27 (33, 38) sc evenly space across to bottom edge, turn.

**Rows 2-4:** Ch1, sc in each st across, turn. Fasten off.

# **Right Front Band**

**Row 1:** With right side facing, join **A** with a slip st to bottom right-hand corner of Right Front edge, ch 1, work 27 (33, 38) sc evenly space across to neck shaping, turn.

**Row 2:** Ch 1, sc in each st across, turn. Fasten off.

# **Edging**

Row 1: Ch 1, sc in each st across Right Front to neck, 2 sc in corner st, sc evenly around neck edge, 2 sc in corner st, sc in each st across Left Front edge to bottom edge. Turn.

Row 2: Ch 1, sc in each st across Left Front to neck, 2 sc in corner st, sc evenly around neck edge, 2 sc in corner st, sc in each st across Right Front edge to bottom edge. Fasten off.

## Big Black Buttons (make 3)

With B. ch 2.

**Round 1:** Work 6 sc in 2nd ch from hook, do not join, work in a spiral. Mark beginning of each round, moving marker up as work progresses.

Round 2: 2 sc in each sc around - 12 sc.

Round 3: Sc in each sc around.

Round 4: [Sc2tog over next 2 sts] around – 6 sts. Fasten off, leaving a 12" (30.5 cm) sewing length. Thread sewing length onto yarn needle. Run through top of sts in last round and gather.

## **FINISHING**

With Right Front Band over left for girls and Left Front Band over Right for boys, sew snaps to appropriate front band starting 1" (2.5 cm) below neck edge, and spacing remaining snaps 2 (2½, 3)" (5 [6.5, 7.5] cm) apart down front band. Sew one Button over each snap on top band.

# HAT Back

With A. ch 2.

**Round 1:** Work 8 sc in 2nd ch from hook, do not join, work in a spiral. Mark beginning of each round, moving marker up as work progresses.

**Round 2:** 2 sc in each sc around -16 sc.

**Round 3:** \*Sc in next sc, 2 sc in next sc; repeat from \* around ¬– 24 sc.

**Round 4:** \*Sc in each of next 2 sc, 2 sc in next sc; repeat from \* around – 32 sc.

**Round 5:** \*Sc in each of next 3 sc, 2 sc in next sc; repeat from \* around – 40 sc.

Continued...





**Round 6:** \*Sc in each of next 4 sc, 2 sc in next sc; repeat from \* around – 48 sc.

**Round 7:** \*Sc in each of next 5 sc, 2 sc in next sc; repeat from \* around – 56 sc.

**Round 8:** \*Sc in each of next 6 sc, 2 sc in next sc; repeat from \* around – 64 sc.

**Round 9:** \*Sc in each of next 7 sc, 2 sc in next sc; repeat from \* around – 72 sc. Do not fasten off.

## Size L Only

**Round 10:** \*Sc in each of next 8 sc, 2 sc in next sc; repeat from \* around – 80 sc. Do not fasten off.

## All Sizes Sides

Work now progresses in rows.

Row 1 (wrong side): Ch 1, turn, sc in each of first 53 (61) sts, turn, leaving remaining sts unworked.

Work even in patt until Sides measure 5 (6)" (12.5 [15] cm) from beginning. Fasten off **A**.

#### **Attached Scarf**

Row 1: With C, ch 32, with right side of Bonnet facing, \*working across side edge of Side, [sc2tog over next 2 row-end sts]\*; repeat from \* to \* across to back neck edge, starting in base of last st worked, [sc2tog over next 2 sts], then work [sc2tog over next 2 sts] 9 times across back neck, repeat from \* to \* across other side edge of Sides, ch 33, turn.

Row 2 (wrong side): With C, hdc in 3rd ch from hook, hdc in each ch and st across – 94 (98) hdc. Drop C to be picked up later. Do not turn.

Row 3: With wrong side facing, join D with a slip st in beginning ch-2 of Row 2, ch 2 (counts as hdc here and throughout), hdc in each st across, turn. Drop D to be picked up later.

Row 4 (right side): Pick up C through last st of previous row, ch 2, hdc in each st across. Drop C to be picked up later. Do not turn.

**Row 5:** Pick up **D** through last st of previous row, ch 2, hdc in each st across, turn. Drop **D** to be picked up later.

Repeat Rows 4-5 once, then repeat Row 3 once. Fasten off **C** and **D**. Weave in ends.

# BOOTS (make 2) Cuff

With **A**, ch 24, and without twisting ch, join into a ring with a slip st in first ch.

Round 1: Ch 2, hdc in each ch around; join with a slip st in top of beginning ch-2 – 24 hdc.

Round 2: Ch 2, hdc in each hdc around; join with a slip st in top of beginning ch-2.

Repeat Round 2 until cuff measures 4" (10 cm) from beginning. Fasten off **A**.

#### Foot

**Round 1:** With right side facing, skip first 8 sts, join **C** with a slip st in next st, ch 1, sc in each st around; join with a slip st in first sc - 24 sc. **Round 2:** Ch 1, sc in each sc around; join with a slip st in first sc.

### Instep

Work now progresses in rows.

**Row 1:** Ch 1, sc in each of first 9 sts, turn, leaving remaining sts unworked – 9 sts.

Rows 2-4 (6): Ch 1, sc in each sc across, turn. Row 5 (7): Ch 1, sc2tog over next 2 sts, sc in each of next 5 sts, sc2tog over last 2 sts -7 sts. Fasten off.

#### **Continue Foot**

Work now progresses in rounds.

**Round 1:** With right side facing, join **C** 8th st at center back of heel, ch 2 (counts as hdc), hdc in each of next 7 sts, working in row-end sts, work 4 (6) hdc evenly space across edge

of instep, 2 hdc in corner, hdc in each of 7 sts across toe, 2 hdc in corner, work 4 (6) hdc evenly space across edge of instep, hdc in each of next 7 sts on back of heel; join with a slip st in top of beginning ch-2 - 34 (38) sts **Rounds 2-3:** Ch 2, hdc in each st around join with a slip st in top of beginning ch-2. Fasten off.

#### Sole

**Round 1:** With right side facing, join **B** with a slip st in first st, ch 1, skip first st, sc2tog over next 2 sts, sc in each of next 12 (14) sts, sc2tog over next 2 sts, sc in next st, sc2tog over next 2 sts, sc in each of next 12 (14) sts, sc2tog over next 2 sts; join with a slip st in first st - 29 (33) sts.

Round 2: Ch 1, sc2tog over next 2 sts, sc in each of next 10 (12) sts, sc2tog over next 2 sts, sc in next st, sc2tog over next 2 sts, sc in each of next 10 (12) sts, sc2tog over next 2 sts; join with a slip st in first st -25 (29) sts. Round 3: Ch1, sc2tog over next 2 sts, sc in each of next 8 (10) sts, sc2tog over next 2 sts, sc in next st, sc2tog over next 2 sts, sc in each of next 8 (10) sts, sc2tog over next 2 sts; join with a slip st in first st -21 (25) sts.

Round 4: Ch 1, sc2tog over next 2 sts, sc in each of next 6 (8) sts, sc2tog over next 2 sts, sc in next st, sc2tog over next 2 sts, sc in each of next 6 (8) sts, sc2tog over next 2 sts; join with a slip st in first st – 17 (21) sts. Fasten off, leaving a 12" (30.5) sewing length. Sew Sole seam closed, lengthwise. Weave in ends. Fold cuff down.

#### **ABBREVIATIONS**

A, B, C, D = color A, B, C, D; ch = chain; hdc = half double crochet; sc = single crochet; st(s) = stitch(es); [] = work directions in brackets the number of times specified; \* or \*\* = repeat whatever follows the \* or \*\* as indicated.
