What you will need:

RED HEART® Super Saver®: 1 skein each of 964 Primary A and 320 Cornmeal B.

Note: 1 skein each makes entire set of 3 projects in any of the sizes.

Susan Bates® Crochet Hooks:
5.5mm [US I-9] for Yoke, Button band, Headband and Booties;
6mm [US J-10]; and 5mm [H-8] for flower.

5 size ½" buttons, Yarn needle,
Sewing thread
Sewing needle

GAUGE: With medium hook, 9 sc = 3" (7.6 cm); 10 rows = 3" (7.6 cm); with largest hook, 1 repeat = 3" (7.6 cm); 4 rows in = 2¾" (7 cm) in Skirt pattern.

SHOP KIT



Fall Baby Set

Crochet this darling dress with Fall-colored yoke and lacy skirt. Then add a ruffle flower headband and corsage and even buttoned booties to complete the look from head to toe!

Directions are given for size **Small (3 months)**. Changes for **Medium (6 months)** and **Large (12 months)** are in parentheses. When there is only 1 number, it is the same for all sizes.

Finished Chest: 19½ (21½, 21½)" (49.5 [54.5, 54.5] cm)

Finished Length: 11½ (11½, 15)" (29 [29, 38] cm)

Note

Garment is made from top down in one piece.

Special Stitches Used

Shell: ([Dc, ch 1] 4 times, dc) in indicated st or space.

Back Post Single Crochet (BPsc): Insert hook from back to front to back again around the post of next st, yarn over, draw yarn through st, yarn over, draw yarn through 2 loops on hook.

Cluster: *Yarn over, insert hook in next st yarn over, draw yarn through st, yarn over, draw yarn through 2 loops on hook; repeat from * 5 more times, yarn over, draw yarn through 7 loops on hook, ch 1.

Single crochet 2 together (sc2tog): Insert hook in next st, yarn over, draw yarn through st, insert hook in next st, yarn over, draw yarn through st, yarn over, draw yarn through 3 loops on hook.

DRESS

Yoke

With **A** and medium hook, ch 43.

Row 1: Sc in 2nd ch from hook, sc in each of next 5 ch, 2 sc in next ch, *sc in each of next 6 ch, 2 sc in next ch; repeat from * across, turn—48 sc.

Row 2: Ch 1, *sc in each of next 7 sc, 2 sc in next sc; repeat from * across, turn—54 sc.

Row 3: Ch 1, *sc in each of next 8 sc, 2 sc in next sc; repeat from * across, turn—60 sc.

Row 4: Ch 1, *sc in each of next 9 sc, 2 sc in next sc; repeat from * across, turn—66 sc.

Row 5: Ch 1, *sc in each of next 10 sc, 2 sc in next sc; repeat from * across, turn—72 sc.

Row 6: Ch 1, *sc in each of next 11 sc, 2 sc in next sc; repeat from * across, turn—78 sc.

Row 7: Ch 1, *sc in each of next 12 sc, 2 sc in next sc; repeat from * across, turn—84 sc.

Row 8: Ch 1, *sc in each of next 13 sc, 2 sc in next sc; repeat from * across, turn—90 sc.

Row 9: Ch 1, *sc in each of next 14 sc, 2 sc in next sc; repeat from * across, turn—96 sc.

Row 10: Ch 1, *sc in each of next 15 sc, 2 sc in next sc; repeat from * across, turn—102 sc.

Sizes M and L Only

Row 11: Ch 1, *sc in next 16 sc, 2 sc in next sc; repeat from * across, turn—108 sc.

All Sizes

Trim Row: Ch 1, working in front loops only, sc in first sc, skip next sc, *(sc, ch 2, sc) in next sc, skip next 2 sts; repeat from * across, sc in last sc—33 (35, 35) ch-2 spaces. Fasten off **A**. Do not turn. Mark this side as right side.

Skirt

Row 1 (RS): With right side and largest hook, working behind Trim Row, working remaining back loops of sts in Row 10 (11, 11) of Yoke, join **B** with a slip st in first st, ch 1, sc in first 11 (13, 12) sc (first front), ch 3, skip next 26 (27, 28) sc (for sleeve), sc in each of next 28 (28, 28) sc (back), ch 3, skip next 26 (27, 28) sc (for sleeve), sc in each of last 11 (13, 12) sc, turn—50 (54, 52) plus 2 ch-3 spaces.

Continued...



Size S Only

Row 2: Ch 1, skip first sc, sc in each sc and in each ch across, turn—55 sc.

Size M Only

Row 2: Ch 1, 2 sc in first sc, sc in each sc and in each ch across, turn—61 sc.

Size L Only

Row 2: Ch 1, *2 sc in first sc, sc in each st across to next ch-3 space, sc in each of next 3 ch; repeat from * once, sc in each st across to last sc, 2 sc in last sc, turn—61 sc.

Begin Lace

Row 3: Ch 1, sc in first sc, *skip next 2 sc, shell in next sc, skip next 2 sc, sc in next sc; repeat from * across, turn—9 (10, 10) shells.

Row 4: Ch 3 (counts as dc here and throughout), dc in first sc, *(sc, ch 3) in each of next 3 ch-1 spaces, sc in next ch-1 space**, (2 dc, ch 1, 2 dc) in next sc; repeat from * across, ending last repeat at **, 2 dc in last sc, turn.

Row 5: Ch 3, dc in first dc, *(sc, ch 3) in each of next 2 ch-3 spaces, sc in next ch-3 space**, (2 dc, ch 1, 2 dc) in next ch-1 space; repeat from * across, ending last repeat at **, 2 dc in last dc, turn.

Row 6: Ch 3, dc in first dc, *sc in next ch-3 space, ch 3, sc in next ch-3 space**, (2 dc, ch 1, 2 dc) in next ch-1 space; repeat from * across, ending last repeat at **, 2 dc in last dc, turn.

Row 7: Ch 1, sc in first dc, *shell in next ch-3 space**, sc in next ch-1 space; repeat from * across, ending last repeat at **, sc in last dc.

Sizes S and M Only

Rows 8-11: Repeat Rows 4-6. At end of last row, change to **A**. Fasten off **B**. With **A**, repeat Row 7. Fasten off **A**.

Size L Only

Rows 8-14: Repeat Rows 4-7 once; then repeat Rows 4-6 once. At end of last row, change to **A**. Fasten off **B**. With **B**, repeat Row 7. Fasten off **A**.

Button Band

Row 1: With right side facing, with medium hook, join **B** with slip st in top left-hand corner of left front edge, ch 1, sc evenly across to bottom edge, turn.

Rows 2-3: Ch 1, sc in each sc across, turn. Fasten off.

Buttonhole Band

Row 1: With right side facing, join **B** with slip st in bottom right-hand corner of right front, ch 1, sc evenly across to neck edge, turn.

Row 2: Mark 3 evenly-spaced buttonhole positions on edge of Yoke as pictured, ch 1, sc in each sc across, working (ch 1, skip next sc) at each marker, turn.

Row 3: Ch 1, sc in each st and space across. Fasten off.

Flower (make 1 for Sweater)

With smallest hook and **B**, leaving at least 6" (15 cm) yarn tail, ch 2.

Round 1: Work 10 sc in top loop only of 2nd ch from hook, join with a slip st in first sc, cinch yarn tail to secure the ring and secure—10 sc.

Round 2: Ch 1, 2 sc in each sc around, join with a slip st in first sc—20 sc.

Round 3: Ch 1, Working behind sts in Round 2, *BPsc around the post of sc in Round 1, ch 2; repeat from * around, join with a slip st in first sc—10 ch-2 spaces.

Round 4: Slip st in first ch-2 space, ch 1, *(sc, hdc, dc, 3 tr) in ch-2 space, ch 3, slip st in 3rd ch from hook for picot, (3 tr, dc, hdc, sc) in next ch-2 space; repeat from * around, join with a slip st in first sc—5 petals. Fasten off **B**.

Finishing

With yarn needle, attach Flower as shown in photo. Weave in ends. With sewing needle and thread, sew buttons to left front opposite buttonholes.

HEADBAND

Row 1: With medium hook and **A**, ch 4, do not skip a stitch, slip st in back loop of each ch across, turn—4 slip sts.

Row 2: (Do not ch 1 at beginning of slip st rows) Slip st in back loop of each st across, turn—4 sts.

Repeat Row 2 until Headband measures 14 (15, 15)" (35.5 [38, 38] cm). Fasten off, leaving a sewing length. Note: Headband will stretch up to 4" (10 cm) more. With yarn needle, sew the last row to foundation ch. Weave in ends.

Flower

Work same as Sweater Flower.

Finishing

With yarn needle, sew Flower to Headband over seam as pictured. Weave in ends.

BOOTIE (make 2)

Sole

With medium hook and **B**, ch 8 (10, 12).

Round 1: 3 sc in 2nd ch from hook, sc in each of next 2 (3, 4) ch, hdc in each of 3 (4, 5) ch, 3 sc in last ch, working across opposite side of foundation ch, hdc in each of next 3 (4, 5) ch, sc in each of next 2 (3, 4) ch, join with slip st in first sc—16 (20, 24) sts.

Round 2: Ch 1, 2 sc in first sc, sc in next sc, 2 sc in next sc, sc in each of next 2 (3, 4) sc, hdc in each of next 3 (4, 5) hdc, 2 sc in next sc, sc in next sc, 2 sc in next sc, hdc in each of next 3 (4, 5) hdc, sc in each of next 2 (3, 4) sc, join with a slip st in first sc—20 (24, 28) sts.

Round 3: Ch 1, 2 sc in first sc, sc in each of next 2 sc, 2 sc in next sc, sc in each of next 3 (4, 5) sc, hdc in each of next 3 (4, 5) hdc, 2 sc in next sc, sc in each of next 3 sc, 2 sc in next sc, hdc in each of next 3 (4, 5) hdc, sc in each of next 2 (3, 4) sc, with **A**, slip st to first sc—24 (28, 32) sts. Fasten off **B**.

Sides

Round 1: With **A**, ch 1, working in back loops only, sc around, slip st to first sc—24 (28, 32) sc.

Round 2: Ch 1, sc in each st around—24 (28, 32) sc.

Round 3: Ch 1, sc in each of first 14 (16, 18) sc, cluster over next 6 sts, sc in each of next 4 (6, 8) sc, with **B**, join with a slip st in first sc—19 (23, 27) sts. Fasten off **A**.

Round 4: With **B**, ch 1, sc in each of first 2 sc, [sc2tog over next 2 sts] twice, sc in each of next 13 (17, 21) sts, join with slip st in first sc—17 (21, 25) sc. Fasten off

Strap

With **B**, ch 10, slip st in 5th ch from hook, slip st in each ch across. Fasten off **B**. Using photo as a guide and yarn needle, attach Strap to top of Bootie. Sew button opposite buttonhole of Strap.

Weave in ends.

A, B = color A, B; **ch** = chain; **dc** = double crochet; **sc** = single crochet; **st(s)** = stitch(es);
() = work directions in parentheses into same st; [] = work directions in brackets the number of times specified; * = repeat whatever follows the * as indicated.
