What you will need:

RED HEART® Super Saver®: 1 skein each 3620 Glowworm A, 722 Pretty 'n Pink B

Susan Bates® Crochet Hooks: 4.25 mm [US G-6]

One ½" (13 mm) headband, 3 Bling Bling Beads (#SUL 51576, Clubhouse Crafts, Advantus Corp.)

GAUGE: 16 sts = 4" (10 cm); 16 rows = 4" (10 cm), in single crochet. 4 shells = 5" (12.5 cm); 10 rows = 4" (10 cm), in shell pattern. **CHECK YOUR GAUGE. Use any size hook to obtain the gauge.**

7 oz (198 g), 364 yd (333 m); multicolor, heather and print 5 oz (141 g), 244 yd (223 m), flecks 5 oz (141 g), 260 yds (238 m) skeins

SHOP KIT



Flower Top Headband

Crochet a cover for a purchased headband and then add some pretty blossoms for a feminine miss. Let her choose her favorite color for the flowers, since flowers don't have to be pink when you crochet them.

HEADBAND

With **A**, ch 55.

Row 1: Sc in 2nd ch from hook and in each remaining ch across, turn—54 sc.

Rows 2–5: Ch 1, sc in each st across, turn. Fasten off, leaving a long tail for sewing. Wrap piece around ½" (13 mm) headband and sew long edges together. Position the seam on the inside of the headband. Sew the ends of piece together. Weave in ends.

Flowers (make 3)

With **B**, ch 17.

Row 1: (Sc, dc, sc) in 2nd ch from hook, (sc, dc, sc) in each remaining ch across. Fasten off, leaving a long tail for sewing. Wind strip into a layered circle (beginning of layered circle is center of flower). Sew flower together at center. Add a bead for decoration. Sew the three flowers to top of headband.

ABBREVIATIONS

A, B, C = Color A, Color B, Color C etc; ch = chain; dc = double crochet; sc = single crochet; st(s) = stitch (es); () = work directions in parentheses into same st; [] = work directions in brackets the number of times specified; * = repeat whatever follows the * as indicated.
