# What you will need:

RED HEART\* Super Saver\*: 1 (1, 2) skeins 530 Orchid A and 2 (3, 4) skeins 3862 Jade B

Susan Bates® Crochet Hook: 5.5mm [US I-9]

Yarn needle

**GAUGE:** 12 sc = 4'' (10 cm); Rows 4-9 = 4'' (10 cm). **CHECK YOUR GAUGE.** Use any size hook to obtain the gauge.

# Mermaid Fantasy Blanket

Feel pretty as a mermaid as you cozy up under the perfect blanket. Escape to a wonderland as you read and share your dreams with your doll. This blanket is easy to crochet in favorite colors.

Directions are for size Toddler. Changes for sizes Child and Adult are in parentheses.

Blanket measures 28 (34, 36)" [71 (86.5, 91.5) cm] in wide x 34 (42, 51)" [86.5 (106.5, 129.5) cm] long, measured flat and without fin.

#### Note

To change color, work last stitch of old color to last yarn over. Yarn over with new color and draw through all loops on hook to complete stitch. Proceed with new color. Cut old color.

### **BLANKET**

With A, ch 86 (104, 110).

Row 1 (right side): Sc in 2nd ch from hook and in each ch across, turn—85 (103, 109) sc.

**Row 2:** Ch 1, sc in each sc across; change to **B**, turn.

Row 4: Ch 1, sc in each sc across, turn.
Row 4: Ch 1, sc in first sc, \*skip next 2 sc,
5 dc in next sc skip next 2 sc sc in next

5 dc in next sc, skip next 2 sc, sc in next sc; repeat from \* across, turn—15 (18, 19) sc and 70 (85, 90) dc.

Row 5: Ch 3 (counts as first dc here and throughout), 2 dc in first sc, skip first 2 dc, sc in next dc, \*skip next 2 dc, 5 dc in next sc, skip next 2 dc, sc in next dc; repeat from \* across, skip last 2 dc, 3 dc in last sc, turn—15 (17, 18) sc and 66 (86, 91) dc.

**Row 6:** Ch 1, sc in first dc, \*skip next 2 dc, 5 dc in next sc, skip next 2 dc, sc in next dc; repeat from \* across, working last sc in top of beginning ch, turn.

**Row 7:** Repeat Row 5. Repeat Rows 6 and 7 until piece

measures 34 (42, 51)" [86.5 (106.5, 129.5) cm] long, ending on a Row 7.

# **Decrease for Fin**

Row 1: Ch 1, sc in first st, \*ch 1, skip next st, sc in next st; repeat from \* across, turn—41 (52, 55) sc.

#### Sizes Toddler and Adult only:

Row 2: Repeat Row 1—21 (28 sc).

#### Size Child only:

Row 2: Ch 1, sc in first sc, \*ch 1, skip next sc, sc in next sc; repeat from \* across to last sc, sc in last sc, turn—26 sc.

#### All sizes:

Row 3: Ch 1, sc in each sc across, turn.

Row 4: Repeat Row 3; change to B.

#### Fin

**Row 1:** Ch 1, 3 sc in each sc, turn—63 (78, 84) sc.

Row 2: Ch 3, dc in next 25 (33, 34) sts, hdc in next 3 (3, 4) sts, sc in next 5 (4, 6) sts, hdc in next 3 (3, 4) sts, dc in last 26 (34, 35) sts, turn—4 (5, 6) sc, 6 (8, 8) hdc, and 52 (68, 70) dc.

Repeat Row 2 until fin measures 11 (13½, 16)" [28 (34.5, 40.5) cm] long. Fasten off.

## **FINISHING**

Weave in ends.

#### **ABBREVIATIONS**

A, B, C = Color A, Color B, Color C, etc.;
ch = chain(s); dc = double crochet;
sc = single crochet; st(s) = stitch(es);
\* = repeat whatever follows the \* as
indicated.
