## What you will need:

RED HEART® ${ }^{\text {® }}{ }^{\text {Sft }}$ © $: 2(2,3,3)$ ball(s) 4601 Off White

Note: 1 ball is needed for hat only. $1(1,2,2)$ ball(s) are needed for capelet only.

Susan Bates ${ }^{\circledR}$ Crochet Hook: 5.5 mm [l-9 US]

Yarn needle, three $1 / 2$ " ( 13 mm ) shank buttons (for hat), one 1 " (25 mm ) button (for capelet)

GAUGE: 1 ripple (measured from peak to peak) $=2^{1 / 2} 2^{\prime \prime}(6.5 \mathrm{~cm})$ in pattern; 6 rows $=31 / 2^{\prime \prime}(9 \mathrm{~cm})$. CHECK YOUR GAUGE. Use any size hook to obtain the gauge.

## Ripple Hat and Capelet

Your little sweetie will love dressing up with this pretty chevron crochet set. Mom will love that it is easy-care, so she can even wear it for play.

## Capelet directions are for Girl's size Small

(2). Changes for Girl's sizes Medium
(4), Large (6), and X-Large (8) are in parentheses.

Hat measures: $171 / 2$ " ( 44.5 cm ) circumference at brim.
Capelet measures: $8(9,10,11)$ " $[20.5(23$,
$25.5,28) \mathrm{cm}]$ from neck to lower edge x 14
$(16,17,18)$ " [35.5 (40.5, 43, 45.5) cm] long
(at neck edge) x $30(35,37.5,40)$ " $776(89,95$,
$101.5) \mathrm{cm}]$ long (at lower edge).
To Fit Chest: 21 (22, 24, 26)" [53.5 (56, 61, 66) cm].

## Special Stitches

dc2tog $=[Y$, insert hook in next stitch, yo and pull up loop, yo, draw through 2 loops] 2 times, yo, draw through all 3 loops on hook.
dc2tog-over-4 (double crochet 2 together worked over 4 stitches) $=$ *Yo, insert hook in next stitch, yo and pull up loop, yo, draw through 2 loops*, skip next 2 stitches; repeat from * to * once, yo, draw through all 3 loops on hook.
sc2tog = [lnsert hook in next stitch, yo and pull up a loop] twice, yo, draw through all 3 loops on hook.

## Special Technique

Adjustable-ring method: Wrap yarn into a ring, ensuring that the tail falls behind the working yarn. Grip ring and tail firmly between middle finger and thumb. Insert hook through center of ring, yo (with working yarn) and draw up a loop. Work stitches of first round in the ring, working over both strands (the tail and the ring). After the first round of stitches is worked, pull gently, but firmly, on tail to tighten ring.

## Notes

Hat and capelet are made in ripple pattern which consists of a series of (dc, ch 2, dc) "peaks" and skipped-stitch "valleys", with 3 dc worked between peaks and valleys. You may need to work several rows before the ripple is clearly visible.

## HAT

## Ch 73.

Row 1 (right side): Dc in 4th ch from hook (beginning ch counts as first dc), dc in next 3 ch, *skip next 2 ch, dc in next 4 ch, ch 2, dc in next 4 ch ; repeat from * to last 6 ch , skip next $2 \mathrm{ch}, \mathrm{dc}$ in next $2 \mathrm{ch}, 2 \mathrm{dc}$ in next ch, dc in last ch, turn-58 dc and $6 \mathrm{ch}-2$ sps.
Rows 2-7: Ch 3 (counts as first dc here and throughout), 2 dc in next dc, dc in next 2 dc , *skip next 2 dc , dc in next 3 dc , ( $\mathrm{dc}, \mathrm{ch} 2, \mathrm{dc}$ ) in next ch-2 space, dc in next 3 dc; repeat from * across to last 6 dc , skip next 2 dc , dc in next $2 \mathrm{dc}, 2 \mathrm{dc}$ in next dc, dc in top of beginning ch, turn.
Row 8: Ch 3, 2 dc in next dc, dc in next dc, *dc2tog-over-4, dc in next 2 dc, dc2tog over next ch-2 space, dc in next 2 dc; repeat from * across to last 7 dc , dc2tog-over-4, dc in next $\mathrm{dc}, 2 \mathrm{dc}$ in next dc , dc in top of beginning ch, turn-45 sts.
Rows 9 and 10: Ch 3, dc2tog across working last dc2tog over last st and top of beginning ch, turn-12 sts.
Row 11: Ch 1, sc2tog across working last dc2tog over last st and top of beginning ch -6 sts.
Fasten off, leaving a 12 " ( 30.5 cm ) tail for sewing.

## Flower (make 3)

## Make an adjustable ring.

Round 1 (right side): [(Ch 3, 3 dc , ch 3, sc) in ring] 5 times, ch 3, 3 dc in ring, ch 3; join with slip st in first ch of beginning ch-6 petals. Pull gently, but firmly, on beginning tail to tighten ring; tie with end tail to hold ring closed.

## FINISHING

Sew top of hat closed and seam sides together.
Push button shank through center of flower and sew in place. Using photograph as a guide, sew flowers in a cluster on front of hat, off-center.
Weave in all ends.

## CAPELET

Ch 123 (143, 153, 163).
Row 1 (right side): Dc in 4th ch from hook (beginning ch counts as first dc), dc in next 3 ch, *skip next 2 ch , dc in next $4 \mathrm{ch}, \mathrm{ch} 2$, dc in next 4 ch ; repeat from * to last 6 ch , skip next 2 ch , dc in next $2 \mathrm{ch}, 2$ dc in next ch, dc in last ch, turn- $98(114,122,130)$ dc and 11 (13, $14,15)$ ch- 2 sps.
Rows 2-7 (9, 10, 12): Ch 3 (counts as first dc here and throughout), 2 dc in next dc, dc in next 2 dc , *skip next 2 dc , dc in next 3 dc , (dc, ch 2 , dc) in next ch-2 space, dc in next 3 dc; repeat from * across to last 6 dc , skip next 2 dc , dc in next $2 \mathrm{dc}, 2 \mathrm{dc}$ in next dc, dc in top of beginning ch, turn.
Row 8 (10, 11, 13): Ch 3,2 dc next dc, dc in next 2 dc , *skip next 2 dc , dc in next 3 dc, dc in next ch-2 space, ch 2, dc2tog over same ch-2 space and next dc, dc in next 2 dc ; repeat from * to last 6 dc , skip next 2 dc ,
dc in next $2 \mathrm{dc}, 2 \mathrm{dc}$ in next dc, dc in top of beginning ch, turn- $87(101,108,115) \mathrm{dc}$ and $11(13,14,15) \mathrm{ch}-2 \mathrm{sps}$.
Row 9 (11, 12, 14): Ch 3,2 dc next dc, dc in next 2 dc , *skip next 2 dc , dc in next 2 dc, dc in next ch-2 space, ch 2, dc2tog over same ch-2 space and next dc, dc in next 2 dc; repeat from * to last 6 dc , skip next 2 dc , dc in next $2 \mathrm{dc}, 2 \mathrm{dc}$ in next dc, dc in top of beginning ch, turn-76 $(88,94,100)$ dc and $11(13,14,15)$ ch- 2 sps.
Row 10 (12, 13, 15): Ch 3, 2 dc next dc, dc in next 2 dc , *skip next 2 dc , dc in next 2 dc , dc in next ch-2 space, ch 2, dc2tog over same ch-2 space and next dc, dc in next dc; repeat from * to last 6 dc , skip next 2 dc , dc in next 2 $\mathrm{dc}, 2 \mathrm{dc}$ in next $\mathrm{dc}, \mathrm{dc}$ in top of beginning ch, turn-65 $(75,80,85)$ dc and $11(13,14,15)$ ch-2 sps.
Row 11 (13, 14, 16): Ch 3 , 2 dc next dc, dc in next 2 dc , *skip next 2 dc , dc in next dc, dc in next ch-2 space, ch 2, dc2tog over same ch-2 space and next dc, dc in next dc; repeat from * to last 6 dc , ch 2 , skip next 2 dc , dc in next 2 $\mathrm{dc}, 2 \mathrm{dc}$ in next dc , dc in top of beginning ch , turn-54 $(62,66,70)$ dc and $11(13,14,15)$ ch-2 sps.
Row 12 (14, 15, 17): Ch 3,2 dc next dc, dc in next 2 dc , *skip next 2 dc , dc in next dc, dc in next ch-2 space, ch 2, dc2tog over same ch-2 space and next dc; repeat from * to last 6 dc , ch 2 , skip next 2 dc , dc in next $2 \mathrm{dc}, 2 \mathrm{dc}$ in next dc, dc in top of beginning ch, turn-43 $(49,52,55) \mathrm{dc}$ and $11(13,14,15) \mathrm{ch}-2 \mathrm{sps}$. Row 13 (15, 16, 18): Ch 3, 2 dc next dc, dc in next 2 dc , *skip next 2 dc , dc in next ch-2 space, ch 2 , dc2tog over same ch-2 space and next dc; repeat from * to last 6 dc , ch 2 , skip next 2 dc , dc in next $2 \mathrm{dc}, 2 \mathrm{dc}$ in next dc, dc in top of beginning ch, turn-32 (36, 38, $40) \mathrm{dc}$ and $11(13,14,15) \mathrm{ch}-2 \mathrm{sps}$.

Row 14 (16, 17, 19): Ch 1, sc in first 2 sts, ch 4, skip next 3 st, sc in next st (buttonhole made), *2 sc in next ch-2 space, sc in next 2 sts; repeat from * to last 4 sts, sc in last 4 sts, turn-51 $(59,63,67)$ sc and $1 \mathrm{ch}-4 \mathrm{sp}$.
Row 15 (17, 18, 20): Ch 1 , sc in each sc to ch-4 space, 4 sc in ch-4 space, sc in last 2 sc-55 (63, 67, 71). Fasten off.

## FINISHING

Sew button opposite buttonhole.
Weave in all ends. Block lightly if necessary.
