What you will need:
RED HEART ${ }^{\circ}$ Cutie Pie"': 2 balls of 512 Destiny

Susan Bates ${ }^{\circ}$ Crochet Hook 5 mm [US H-8]

Yarn Needle
GAUGE: 14 sts and 9 rows in pattern $=4^{\prime \prime}(10 \mathrm{~cm})$. CHECK YOUR GAUGE. Use any size hook to obtain the gauge given. Pie"', Art. E834 available in $3.5 \mathrm{oz}(100 \mathrm{~g}), 326 \mathrm{yd}$ ( 299 m ) balls


Whether you are four or ninety-four, you'll enjoy the comfy softness of this chenille yarn. Crocheted with a combination of front and back post stitches, this is a cowl that will span the seasons.

Scarf measures 64" ( 162.5 cm ) long; 9" ( 23 cm ) wide.

## Special Stitches

Front Post double crochet (FPdc): Yarn over, insert hook from front to back to front again around the post of next st, yarn over draw yarn through st, [yarn over, draw yarn through 2 loops on hook] twice.

Back Post double crochet (BPdc): Yarn over, insert hook from back to front to back again around the post of next st, yarn over, draw yarn through st, [yarn over, draw yarn through 2 loops on hook] twice.

## SCARF

Ch 35.
Row 1 (wrong side): Dc in 4th ch from hook and in each ch across, turn-33 dc. Row 2: Ch 3 (counts as dc here and throughout), FPdc around the post each of next 2 dc, *BPdc around the post of each of next 3 dc , FPdc around the post of each of next 3 dc ; repeat from * across, turn-33 sts. Rows 3-146: Repeat Row 2. Fasten off, leaving a long sewing length.

## Finishing

With yarn needle and sewing length, matching sts, sew last row to foundation ch.
