What you will need:

RED HEART* Super Saver*: 1 skein each of 319 Cherry Red A, 311 White B, 706 Perfect Pink C and 313 Aran

Susan Bates® Crochet Hook: 4mm [US G-6]

Black and Red 6-strand embroidery flosses, yarn needle, stitch marker

GAUGE: 16 sc = 4" [10 cm]; 10 rows = 4" [10 cm] in single crochet. CHECK YOUR GAUGE. Use any size hook to obtain the gauge.

SHOP KIT



Child's Santa Slippers

Children will love wearing these little Santa slippers! You can crochet them in little time and give them to the children in your life.

Slippers measure $5\frac{1}{2}$ (6\frac{1}{2}, 7\frac{1}{2})" [14 (16.5, 19) cm] long.

Directions are for size Childs Small; changes for sizes Medium and Large are in parentheses.

NOTE

Slipper is worked in joined rounds. Sole is worked first and is worked from center to outside edges. Upper is worked separately and sewn on to outside edges of Sole. Hat is worked back and forth in rows and sewn on to Upper piece.

To change color, work last stitch of old color to last yarn over. Yarn over with new color and draw through all loops on hook to complete stitch.

SPECIAL ABBREVIATIONS

sc2tog: [Draw up a loop in next st] twice, yarn over and draw through all 3 loops on hook.

SLIPPER (make 2)

Sole

With A, ch 15 (19, 23).

Round 1 (Right Side): Work 2 sc in 2nd ch from hook, sc in next 8 (10, 12) ch, hdc in next ch, dc in next 3 (5, 7) ch, 5 dc in last ch for toe, turn to work across opposite side of foundation, dc in next 3 (5, 7) ch, hdc in next ch, sc in next 8 (10, 12) ch, 2 sc in last ch; join with slip st in first sc - 33 (41, 49) sts. Place marker for beginning of round.

Round 2: Ch 1, sc in first st, 2 sc in next st, sc in next 13 (17, 21) sts, 2 sc in next st, 3 sc in next st, 2 sc in next st, sc in next 13 (17, 21) sts, 2 sc in next st, sc in last st; join with slip st in first sc - 39 (47, 55) sts.

Round 3: Ch 1, sc in first st, 2 sc in next st, sc in next 16 (20, 24) sts, 2 sc in next st, 3 sc in next st, 2 sc in next st, sc in next 16 (20, 24) sts, 2 sc in next st, sc in last st; join with slip st in first sc - 45 (53, 61) sts.

Round 4: Ch 1, 2 sc in first st, sc in next 18 (22, 26) sts, 2 sc in next st, sc in next st, 2 sc in next st, 2 sc in next st, 2 sc in next st, sc in next st, sc in next st, sc in next st, sc in next 18 (22, 26) sts, 2 sc in last st; join with slip st in first sc - 53 (61, 69) sts. Fasten off.

Upper

Upper is worked from the ankle opening downwards in joined rounds. Turn at the end of each round.

With **B**, ch 29 (37, 45); taking care not to twist ch, join with slip st in first ch to form a ring. Place marker for beginning of round.

Round 1 (Right Side): Ch 1, sc in first 13 (17, 21) ch, 2 dc in next ch, 3 dc in next ch, 2 dc in next ch, sc in next 13 (17, 21) ch; join with slip st in first sc, turn – 33 (41, 49) sts.

Round 2: Ch 1, 2 sc in first st, sc in each st around to last st, 2 sc in last st; join with slip st in first sc, turn – 35 (43, 51) sts

Round 3: Ch 1, sc in first 16 (20, 24) sts, 2 dc in next st, 3 dc in next st, 2 dc in next st, sc in next 16 (20, 24) sts; join with slip st in first sc, turn – 39 (47, 55) sts.

Round 4: Ch 1, sc in each st around; join with slip st in first sc, turn.

Round 5: Ch 1, sc in first 17 (21, 25) sts, 2 dc in each of next 2 sts, 3 dc in next st, 2 dc in each of next 2 sts, sc in next 17 (21, 25) sts; join with slip st in first sc, turn – 45 (53, 61) sts.

Round 6: Repeat Round 2 - 47 (55, 63)

Round 7: Ch 1, sc in first 21 (25, 29) sts, 2 dc in each of next 2 sts, 3 dc in next st, 2 dc in each of next 2 sts, sc in next 21 (25, 29) sts; join with slip st in first sc -53 (61, 69) sts.

Round 8: Ch 1, sc in each st around; join with slip st in first sc, turn. Do not fasten off.

Join Upper to Sole: Hold Wrong Sides of Sole and Upper together, matching sts. Working through both thicknesses, sc in each sc around; join with slip st in first sc. Fasten off.

SANTA HAT

Beginning at bottom edge of hat, with **A**, ch 15.

Row 1: Sc in 2nd ch from hook and each remaining ch across – 14 sc.

Rows 2-5: Ch 1, turn, sc in first sc, sc2tog over next 2 sc, sc to last 3 sc, sc2tog over next 2 sc, sc in last sc - 6 sc remain on last row worked.

Row 6: Ch 1, turn, sc in first sc, [sc2tog over next 2 sc] twice, sc in last sc - 4 sc.

Row 7: Ch 1, turn, [sc2tog over next 2 sc] twice - 2 sc.

Row 8: Ch 1, turn, sc2tog over next 2 sc. Fasten off.

FACE

Beginning at top of face, with **D**, ch 13.

Row 1: Sc in 2nd ch from hook and each remaining ch across – 12 sc.

Rows 2-4: Ch 1, turn, sc in first sc, sc2tog over next 2 sc, sc to last 3 sc, sc2tog over next 2 sc, sc in last sc - 6 sc remain on last row worked. Change to **B** at end of Row 4.

Begin Beard

Row 5: Ch 1, turn, sc in each sc across. Row 6: Ch 1, turn, sc2tog over first 2 sc, sc in next 2 sc, sc2tog over last 2 sc. Fasten off.

Center Face at bottom of Hat and sew in place.

HAT BAND

With **B**, ch 15.

Row 1: Sc in 2nd ch from hook and in each remaining ch across. Fasten off, leaving a long end of yarn to sew in place at bottom of Hat.

NOSE

With **C**, ch 2, work 6 sc in 2nd ch from hook; join to first sc with slip st. Fasten off, leaving long end of yarn. Gather 6 sts together slightly and sew in place.

FINISHING

With black embroidery floss, embroider French knot eyes. With red, embroider couched stitch mouth on Face.

Join **B** at top of Hat with a slip st, ch 1, 3 sc in top of Hat, sc around entire Hat and Head; join with a slip st to first sc, leaving a long end of yarn for sewing in place on front of slipper.

Pompom

With **B**, ch 4, work 11 dc in 4th ch from hook; join to top of beginning ch with slip st. Fasten off, leaving long end of yarn. Gather all sts together and pull tightly to shape pompom. Sew in place.

Weave in ends.

ABBREVIATIONS

A, B, C = Color A, B, C; ch = chain; cm = centimeters; dc = double crochet; hdc = half double crochet; mm = millimeters; sc = single crochet; st(s) = stitch(es); tog = together; [] = work directions in brackets the number of times specified.
