

## Cow Slippers

Create a pair of slippers with kitschy style. These cute stuffed heifers are an easy crochet project that will bring on the fun!

## Directions are for Adult's Size Medium.

One size fits $8-91 / 2$ " foot.
RED HEART ${ }^{\text {® }}$ "Super Saver"": 1 skein 373 Petal Pink A, 2 skeins 313 Aran B, 1 skein each 312 Black $\mathbf{C}$ and 334 Buff D .

Crochet Hook: 4mm [US G-6].
Yarn needle; poly-fil stuffing.
GAUGE: 16 sts = 4 "; 5 rounds $=11 / \mathrm{s}^{\prime \prime}$ in sc rounds. CHECK YOUR GAUGE. Use any size hook to obtain the gauge.

## SPECIAL ABBREVIATION

Sc2tog = [draw up a loop in next st] twice, yo and draw through all 3 loops on hook.

## SLIPPER

## Snout (Make 2)

Round 1: With A ch 2; 6 sc in 2nd ch from hook; join with a slip st in first sc.
Round 2: Ch 1, 2 sc in each sc around; join - 12 sc .
Round 3: Ch $1,2 \mathrm{sc}$ in first sc , sc in next sc, [ 2 sc in next sc, sc in next sc] 5 times; join - 18 sc.
Round 4: Ch 1, 2 sc in first sc, sc in next 2 sc , [2 sc in next sc, sc in next 2 sc ] 5 times; join -24 sc . Fasten off; this is the lower edge of the Snout.

## Outer Slipper (Make 2)

Row 1 (Right Side): With right side facing attach B in back loop of an sc at the upper edge of Snout; ch 1 , sc in back loop of same sc as joining, [ 2 sc in back loop of next sc , sc in back loop of next sc] 11 times, 2 sc in last sc; do NOT join; TURN - 36 sc.
Now work all sts in both loops as usual.
Row 2: Ch 1, sc in first 4 sc , $[2 \mathrm{sc}$ in next sc, sc in next 8 sc] 3 times, 2 sc in next sc, sc in last 4 sc ; turn -40 sc .
Row 3: Ch 1, sc in first 4 sc , $[2 \mathrm{sc}$ in next sc, sc in next 9 sc] 3 times, 2 sc in next sc, sc in last 5 sc ; turn -44 sc . Continue in sc increasing 4 sts evenly spaced until there are 64 sts. Then work even in sc until $101 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ from beginning, end wrong side row.

## Shape Heel

Next Row: Ch 1, sc in first 4 sc, * [sc2tog, sc in next 4 sc; repeat from * across; turn - 54 sts.
Next Row: Ch 1, sc in first 4 sc , [sc2tog, sc in next 3 sc ] 10 times; turn - 44 sts.
Next Row: Ch 1, sc in first 4 sts, [sc2tog, sc in next 2 sts] 10 times; turn - 34 sts.
Next Row: Ch 1, sc in first 4 sc, [sc2tog, sc in next sc] 10 times; turn - 24 sts.
Next Row: Ch 1, sc in first 4 sc, [sc2tog] 10 times; turn 14 sts.
Next Row: Ch 1, [sc2tog] 7 times; turn - 7 sts.
Next Row: Ch 1, sc in first sc, [sc2tog] 3 times -4 sts.
Fasten off.

## Lining Slipper (Make 2)

Toe: With B ch 5.
Row 1 (Right Side): Sc in 2nd ch from hook and in each ch across; turn - 4 sc.
Row 2: Ch 1, 2 sc in each sc across; turn -8 sc .
Row 3: Ch 1 , sc in first sc, [ 2 sc in next sc, sc in next sc] 3 times, 2 sc in last sc ; turn - 12 sc .
Row 4: Ch 1, sc in first 2 sc , $[2 \mathrm{sc}$ in next sc, sc in next 2 sc] 3 times, 2 sc in last sc; turn - 16 sc .
Row 5: Ch 1, sc in first 3 sc , [ 2 sc in next sc, sc in next 3 sc] 3 times, 2 sc in last sc; turn - 20 sc .

Row 6: Ch 1, sc in first 4 sc, [2 sc in next sc, sc in next 4 $\mathrm{sc}] 3$ times, 2 sc in last sc; turn -24 sc .
Row 7: Ch 1, sc in first 5 sc , [2 sc in next sc, sc in next 5 sc] 3 times, 2 sc in last sc; turn -28 sc .
Row 8: Ch 1, sc in first 6 sc, [2 sc in next sc, sc in next 6 sc] 3 times, 2 sc in last sc; turn -32 sc.
Work even in sc until $81 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ from beginning, end wrong side row.

## Shape Heel

Next Row: Ch 1, sc in first 2 sc, [sc2tog, sc in next 3 sc] 6 times; turn - 26 sc.
Next Row: Ch 1, sc in first 2 sc, [sc2tog, sc in next 2 sc$] 6$ times; turn - 20 sc.
Next Row: Ch 1, sc in first 2 sc, [sc2tog, sc in next sc] 6 times; turn - 14 sc.
Next Row: Ch 1, [sc2tog] 7 times; turn - 7 sc.
Next Row: Ch 1, sc in first sc, [sc2tog] 3 times - 4 sc. Fasten off.

## Ears (Make 4)

Row 1 (Right Side): With B, ch 4; sc in 2nd ch from hook and in each ch across; turn - 3 sc .
Row 2: Ch 1, 2 sc in first sc, sc in next sc, 2 sc in last sc; turn - 5 sc .
Rows 3-6: Ch 1, sc in each sc across; turn.
Row 7: Ch 1, sc2tog, sc in next sc, sc2tog; turn - 3 sc.
Row 8: Ch 1, draw up a loop in each of 3 remaining sc, yo and through all loops on hook. Fasten off.

## Horns (Make 4)

With D ch 2; 6 sc in 2nd ch from hook; do not join rounds. Work 6 more rounds even in sc. Fasten off.

## Spots (Make 8)

Round 1: With C ch 2; 6 sc in 2nd ch from hook; join with a slip st in first sc.
Round 2: Ch 1, 2 sc in each sc around; join - 12 sc.
Round 3: Ch 1, 2 sc in first sc, sc in next sc, [2 sc in next sc, sc in next sc] 5 times; join - 18 sc.
Round 4: Ch 1, 2 sc in first sc, sc in next 2 sc, [2 sc in next sc, sc in next 2 sc$] 5$ times; join -24 sc . Fasten off.

## FINISHING

Sew center front seam of outer slipper from snout to foot opening for 5 ". Sew center back seam of outer slipper from heel to foot opening for $11 / 2^{\prime \prime}$. Sew center front seam of lining slipper from toe to foot opening for $21 / 2^{\prime \prime}$. Sew center back seam of lining slipper from heel to foot opening for $11 / 2$. Join foot opening of lining to foot opening of slipper by 1 round sc along edge through both thicknesses,
stuffing slipper firmly. Sew on ears, horns, and spots as shown. Embroider eyes with C Straight Stitch eyelashes. Embroider nostrils with C Straight Stitch.
