Super Hero Bear Set

In his jumpsuit, monogram belt and super power cape, this bear is ready for hours of fantasy playtime. Crochet him as a gift and make a child feel special.

What you will need:

RED HEART® Super Saver®: 1 skein each of 360 Café Latte **A**, 506 Pool **B**, 324 Bright Yellow **C**, 3620 Glowworm **D**, and 312 Black **E**

Note: Only a small amounts of **D** and **E** are needed.

Crochet Hook: 3.75 mm [US F-5]

Yarn needle, stitch marker, stuffing, ½" [13 mm] button for cape (optional)

GAUGE: 12 sts = 3"; 14 rows = 3" in single crochet. **CHECK YOUR GAUGE.** Use any size hook to obtain the gauge.



RED HEART® Super Saver®, Art. E300 available in solid color 7 oz (198 g), 364 yd (333 m); multicolor, heather and print 5 oz (141 g), 236 yd (215 m), flecks 5 oz (141g), 260 yds (238 m) skeins

SHOP KIT

Doll measures 12" (30.4 cm) tall.

Notes

1. Gauge is not critical for this project. Work tightly so stuffing will not show between stitches.
2. To change color, work last stitch of old color to last yarn over. Yarn over with new color and draw through all loops on hook to complete stitch. Proceed with new color. Fasten off old color.
3. Use photograph as a guide for placement of pieces to be sewn together.

Special Stitch

sc2tog = [Draw up a loop in next st] twice, yarn over and draw through all 3 loops on hook.



HEAD

Beginning at nose with **A**, ch 2.

Round 1 (right side): Work 6 sc in 2nd ch from hook—6 sc. Do not join, work in continuous rounds (spirals). Place a marker for beginning of round. Move marker up as each round is completed.

Round 2: Work 2 sc in each sc around—12 sc.

Round 3: [Sc in next sc, 2 sc in next sc] 6 times—18 sc.

Rounds 4-7: Sc in each sc around.

Round 8: [Sc in next 2 sc, 2 sc in next sc] 6 times—24 sc.

Round 9: Sc in each sc around.

Round 10: Sc in next 9 sc, 2 sc in each of next 6 sc, sc in last 9 sc—30 sc.

Rounds 11 and 12: Sc in each sc around.

Round 13: [Sc in next 4 sc, 2 sc in next sc] 6 times—36 sc.

Rounds 14 and 15: Sc in each sc around.

Round 16: [Sc in next 4 sc, sc2tog] 6 times—30 sc.

Round 17: Sc in each sc around.

Round 18: [Sc in next 3 sc, sc2tog] 6 times—24 sc.

Round 19: [Sc in next 2 sc, sc2tog] 6 times—18 sc.

Round 20: [Sc in next sc, sc2tog] 6 times—12 sc.

Stuff head.

Round 21: Sc in each sc around.

Round 22: [Sc2tog] 6 times—6 sc.

Fasten off, leaving a long tail. Thread tail through the stitches of last round and pull to gather. Weave in end securely.

Facial Features: With **E**, embroider satin stitch eyes and nose, and straight stitch mouth.



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EAR (make 2)

With **A**, ch 2.

Rounds 1 and 2: Work same as Rounds 1 and 2 of head—12 sc.

Round 3: Sc in each sc around.

Round 4: [Sc in next sc, sc2tog] 4 times—8 sc.

Fasten off. Do not stuff ear. Flatten and sew ears to head.



BODY

Beginning at top with **C**, ch 6; taking care not to twist ch, join with slip st in first ch to form a ring.

Round 1 (right side): Ch 1, 2 sc in each ch around—12 sc. Do not join, work in continuous rounds (spirals). Place a marker for beginning of round. Move marker up as each round is completed.

Round 2: [Sc in next sc, 2 sc in next sc] 6 times—18 sc.

Round 3: [Sc in next 2 sc, 2 sc in next sc] 6 times—24 sc.

Round 4: Sc in each sc around.

Round 5: [Sc in next 3 sc, 2 sc in next sc] 6 times—30 sc.

Round 6: Sc in each sc around.

Round 7: [Sc in next 4 sc, 2 sc in next sc] 6 times—36 sc.

Rounds 8-18: Sc in each sc around. Begin stuffing body and continue to stuff until piece is complete.

Divide for Legs

First Leg

Round 19: Sc in next 18 sc, place a marker in the next st; leave the marked st and all remaining sts unworked—18 sc. Work in continuous rounds over the 18 sc just made only, forming a circle for the first leg.

Rounds 20-23: Sc in each sc around.

Round 24: Sc in each sc around; change to **B** in last st.

Boot

Rounds 25-30: With **B**, sc in each sc around.

Round 31: Work 2 sc in each of first 3 sc, sc in next 12 sc, 2 sc in each of last 3 sc—24 sc.

Rounds 32-35: Sc in each sc around.

Round 36: [Sc in next 2 sc, sc2tog] 6 times—18 sc.

Stuff leg.

Round 37: [Sc in next sc, sc2tog] 6 times—12 sc.

Fasten off, leaving a long tail. Thread tail through the stitches of last round and pull to gather. Weave in end securely.

Second Leg

With right side facing, join **A** with sc in marked st following first leg.

Round 19: Sc in each remaining unworked st following first leg.

Rounds 20-23: Sc in each sc around.

Round 24: Sc in each sc around; change to **B** in last st.

Boot

Rounds 25-37: Work same as Rounds 25-37 of first leg.

Fasten off, leaving a long tail. Thread tail through the stitches of last round and pull to gather. Weave in end securely. Sew head to top of body.

ARM (make 2)

With **A**, ch 2.

Rounds 1 and 2: Work same as Rounds 1 and 2 of head—12 sc.

Rounds 3-5: Sc in each sc around.

Round 6: [Sc2tog] twice, sc in remaining 8 sc—10 sc.

Rounds 7-16: Sc in each sc around.

Fasten off. Stuff arms and sew to body.

SLEEVE (make 2)

With **C**, ch 15.

Row 1: Sc in 2nd ch from hook and in each remaining ch across, turn—14 sc.

Rows 2-4: Ch 1, sc in each sc across, turn.

Fasten off, leaving a long tail for sewing. Slip sleeve around upper part of arm and sew in place.

BOOT TOP (make 2)

Beginning at top of boot with **B**, ch 21.

Row 1: Sc in 2nd ch from hook and in each remaining ch across, turn—20 sc.

Row 2: Ch 3 (counts as dc), dc in each sc across, turn.

Fasten off, leaving a long tail for sewing. Place boot top around top of boot and sew in place.



CAPE

Collar

With **B**, ch 21.

Row 1 (right side): Sc in 2nd ch from hook and in each remaining ch across, turn—20 sc.

Row 2: Ch 1, *sc in next 3 sc, 2 sc in next sc; repeat from * across, turn—25 sc.

Row 3: Ch 1, *sc in next 4 sc, 2 sc in next sc; repeat from * across, turn—30 sc.

Row 4: Ch 1, sc in each sc across. Fasten off.

Body of Cape

Row 1 (right side): Turn collar upside down to work in chains along opposite side of foundation ch, join **B** with slip st in first ch, ch 6, sc in same ch as last slip st (button loop made), sc in each remaining ch across, turn—20 sc and one ch-6 button loop.

Row 2: Ch 3 (counts as dc here and throughout), dc in first sc, 2 dc in each remaining sc across, turn—40 dc.

Rows 3-12: Ch 3, dc in each dc across, turn.

Fasten off. Sew button just below collar, opposite button loop. Button cape around neck.

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STAR

With **D**, ch 2.

Round 1: Work 5 sc in 2nd ch from hook—5 sc. Do not join, work in continuous rounds (spirals). Place a marker for beginning of round. Move marker up as each round is completed.

Round 2: Work 2 sc in each sc around—10 sc.

Round 3: *Slip st in next sc, ch 4, slip st in 2nd ch from hook, sc in next ch, dc in next ch (point made), skip next sc of Round 2; repeat from * around; join with slip st in first slip st—5 points. Fasten off, leaving a long tail for sewing. Sew star to center back of cape.

BELT

With **D**, ch 6.

Row 1: Sc in 2nd ch from hook and in each remaining ch across, turn—5 sc.

Rows 2–38: Ch 1, working in back loops only, sc in each sc across, turn.

Fasten off, leaving a long tail for sewing. Sew belt around bear's waist.

Belt Buckle

With **B**, ch 6.

Round 1: Sc in 2nd ch from hook and in next 3 ch, 3 sc in last ch; working along opposite side of foundation ch, sc in next 3 ch, 2 sc in last ch—12 sc.

Do not join, work in continuous rounds (spirals). Place a marker for beginning of round. Move marker up as each round is completed.

Round 2: Work 2 sc in next sc, sc in next 3 sc, 2 sc in each of next 3 sc, sc in next 3 sc, 2 sc in each of last 2 sc—18 sc.

Round 3: *Sc in next 2 sc, 2 sc in next sc; repeat from * around; join with slip st in first sc—24 sc.

Fasten off, leaving a long tail for sewing. With **C**, embroider a chain stitch "S" on buckle. Sew buckle to center of belt.

FINISHING

Weave in any remaining ends.

ABBREVIATIONS

A, B, C, D, and E = Color A, B, C, D, and E; **ch** = chain; **dc** = double crochet; **sc** = single crochet; **st(s)** = stitch (es); **[]** = work directions in brackets the number of times specified; * = repeat whatever follows the * as indicated.
