What you will need:

RED HEART® Super Saver®: 1 skein each of 334 Buff A, 316 Soft White B, 312 Black C, 319 Cherry Red D, 368 Paddy Green E, and 718 Shocking Pink F

Susan Bates® Crochet Hook:
4 mm [US G-6]

Yarn needle, pins, stuffing, two 1" (25mm) rings, assorted small beads (for necklace), heavy-duty sewing thread, red crayon (to shade cheeks)

GAUGE: 20 sts = 4" (10 cm);
16 rows = 4" (10 cm) in single
crochet. **CHECK YOUR GAUGE.**
Use any size hook to obtain the
gauge.

SHOP KIT



Alejandra's Party Doll

*This sweet doll is ready to enjoy a family
fiesta and be a lovable friend. She is
crocheted easily and will be enjoyed for
years to come.*

Doll measures 16" (40.5 cm) tall

Special Stitch

sc2tog = [Draw up a loop in next st] twice, yarn
over and draw through all 3 loops on hook.

Notes

1. Gauge is not critical for this project. Work
tightly so stuffing will not show between
stitches.
2. To change color, work last stitch of old
color to last yarn over. Yarn over with new
color and draw through all loops on hook
to complete stitch. Proceed with new color.
Fasten off old color.

HEAD AND BODY

Beginning at top of head, with **A**, ch 2.

Round 1: Work 6 sc in 2nd ch from hook—6
sc. Do not join, work in continuous rounds
(spirals). Place a marker for beginning of
round. Move marker up as each round is
completed.

Round 2: Work 2 sc in each sc around—12 sc.

Round 3: [Sc in next sc, 2 sc in next sc] 6
times—18 sc.

Round 4: Sc in each sc around.

Round 5: [Sc in next 2 sc, 2 sc in next sc] 6
times—24 sc.

Round 6: Sc in each sc around.

Round 7: [Sc in next 3 sc, 2 sc in next sc] 6
times—30 sc.

Rounds 8–15: Sc in each sc around.

Round 16: [Sc2tog] 15 times—15 sts.

Rounds 17–19: Sc in each sc around.

Round 20: [Sc in next sc, 2 sc in next sc] 7
times, sc in last sc—22 sc.

Round 21: [Sc in next 10 sc, 2 sc in next sc] 2
times; change to **B** in last sc—24 sc.

Undershirt

Rounds 22–27: With **B**, sc in each sc around;
change to **A** in last sc of Round 27.

Waist

Rounds 28 and 29: With **A**, sc in each sc
around; change to **B** in last sc of Round 29.

Begin Knickers

Rounds 30–35: With **B**, sc in each sc around.
Do not fasten off. Stuff body firmly.

Joining Row: Flatten lower edging, matching
stitches. Working through both thicknesses, sc
across to close lower edge. Fasten off **B**.

ARM (make 2)

Beginning at top of arm, with **A**, ch 2.

Round 1: Work 6 sc in 2nd ch from hook—6
sc. Do not join, work in continuous rounds
(spirals). Place a marker for beginning of
round. Move marker up as each round is
completed.

Round 2: [Sc in next sc, 2 sc in next sc] 3
times—9 sc.

Rounds 3–19: Sc in each sc, stuffing arm as
you go.

Round 20: [Sc2tog] 3 times, sc in last 3 sc—
6 sc.

Round 21: Work 2 sc in next 3 sc, sc in last 3
sc—9 sc.

Rounds 22–24: Sc in each sc around.

Round 25: [Sc2tog] 4 times, sc in last sc—5 sc.
Fasten off, leaving a long tail. Stuff arm.
Thread tail through stitches of last round and
pull gently to close opening. Draw a strand of
A through arm at elbow and pull to form elbow
dimple. Sew arms to sides of body.

LEG (make 2)

Beginning at foot, with **C**, ch 6.

Round 1: Sc in 2nd ch from hook, sc in next
3 ch, 3 sc in last ch; working across opposite
side of foundation ch, sc in next 3 ch, 2
sc in last ch—12 sc. Do not join, work in
continuous rounds (spirals). Place a marker for
beginning of round. Move marker up as each
round is completed.

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Round 2: Work 2 sc in next sc, sc in next 3 sc, 2 sc in each of next 3 sc, sc in next 3 sc, 2 sc in each of next 2 sc—18 sc.

Round 3: Working in back loops only, sc in each sc around; change to **A** in last sc.

Round 4: With **A**, sc in next 6 sc, [sc2tog] 3 times, sc in last 6 sc—15 sc.

Round 5: Sc in next 3 sc, [sc2tog] 3 times, sc in last 6 sc—12 sc.

Round 6: Sc in next 3 sc, [sc2tog] 3 times, sc in last 3 sc—9 sc.

Rounds 7 and 8: Sc in each sc around.

Round 9: Work 2 sc in first sc, sc in each remaining sc around—10 sc.

Rounds 10–27: Sc in each sc around, stuffing leg as you go; change to **B** in last sc.

Round 28: With **B**, sc in each sc around.

Fasten off, leaving a long tail for sewing.

Sew legs to bottom of body.

HAIR

With **C**, ch 34.

Row 1: Sc in 2nd ch from hook and in each remaining ch across, turn—33 sc.

Row 2: Ch 1, [sc in next 9 sc, sc2tog] 3 times, turn—30 sc.

Row 3: Ch 1, [sc in next 8 sc, sc2tog] 3 times, turn—27 sc.

Row 4: Ch 1, [sc in next 7 sc, sc2tog] 3 times, turn—24 sc.

Row 5: Ch 1, [sc in next 6 sc, sc2tog] 3 times, turn—21 sc.

Row 6: Ch 1, [sc in next 5 sc, sc2tog] 3 times, turn—18 sc.

Row 7: Ch 1, [sc in next 4 sc, sc2tog] 3 times, turn—15 sc.

Row 8: Ch 1, [sc in next 3 sc, sc2tog] 3 times, turn—12 sc.

Row 9: Ch 1, [sc in next 2 sc, sc2tog] 3 times, turn—9 sc.

Row 10: Ch 1, [sc in next sc, sc2tog] 3 times, turn—6 sc.

Fasten off, leaving a long tail. Thread tail through last 6 sts and pull to gather. Use remainder of tail to sew side edges together for back seam. Sew hair to head.

Braid: With **C**, [ch 42, hdc in 3rd ch from hook and in each remaining ch across] 3 times.

Fasten off. Braid the 3 strips together. Cut a length of **D** and tie around end of braid to secure, then wrap the length of **D** around end of braid for about 1" (2.5 cm), thread end of length to inside of wraps to secure. Sew braid to hair.

FLOWER

(make 3 – 1 with **B** and 2 with **F**)

Ch 7.

Row 1: Sc in 2nd ch from hook and in each remaining ch across, turn—6 sc.

Row 2: (Slip st, ch 1, 2 hdc) in first sc (first petal made), *ch 1, (slip st ch 1, 2 hdc) in next sc; repeat from * across—6 petals.

Fasten off, leaving a long tail. With tail, sew side of first petal to side of last petal, then thread remainder of tail through bases of petals and pull to gather. Sew flower to top of hair.

EAR (make 2)

With **A**, ch 2.

Row 1: Work 5 sc in 2nd ch from hook.

Fasten off, leaving a long tail. Sew ears in place.

DRESS

Beginning at top, with **B**, ch 25.

Row 1: Sc in 2nd ch from hook and in each remaining ch across, turn—24 sc.

Rows 2–9: Ch 1, sc in each sc across, turn.

Row 10: Ch 3 (counts as first dc here and throughout), working in back loops only, 2 dc in first sc, 3 dc in each remaining sc across, turn—72 dc.

Row 11: Ch 1, sc in each dc across, turn.

Row 12: Ch 3, working in back loops only, dc in each sc across, turn.

Rows 13–22: Repeat last 2 rows 5 times.

Row 23: Repeat Row 11.

Row 24: Slip st in next sc, skip next sc, 3 hdc in next sc, *skip next sc, slip st in next sc, skip next sc, 3 hdc in next sc; repeat from * across to last sc, slip st in last sc.

Fasten off, leaving a long tail for sewing back seam (but, do not sew back seam until instructed).

Skirt Ruffle

Row 1: With right side facing, hold dress upside down, join **E** with slip st in first unworked front loop of Row 11, ch 3, dc in same st as joining, dc in next front loop, *2 dc in next front loop, dc in next front loop; repeat from * across, turn.

Rows 2 and 3: Ch 3, dc in each dc across, turn. Fasten off, leaving a long tail.

With **D**, work another ruffle in unworked front loops of Row 15.

With **E**, work another ruffle in unworked front loops of Row 19.

Sew side edges of dress together for back seam. With tails, sew edges of ruffles together.

Collar Ruffle

With **B**, ch 37.

Row 1: Sc in 2nd ch from hook and in each remaining ch across, turn—36 sc.

Row 2: Ch 3, dc in first sc, 2 dc in each remaining sc across, turn—72 dc.

Row 3: *Ch 1, slip st in next dc; repeat from * across.

Fasten off, leaving a long tail.

Note: You may find it easier to place the dress on the doll before attaching the collar ruffle. With tail, sew short edges together for back seam of collar. Pin collar evenly to top of dress, matching back seams and center fronts. Sew center 6 stitches of collar ruffle to center 6 stitches of top of dress on the front and the back, leave remaining portion of collar ruffle unsewn for armholes.

WAIST TIE

With **F**, ch 50.

Row 1: Hdc in 3rd ch from hook and in each remaining ch across, do not fasten off; hold tie at left side of waist of dress to work in unworked front loops of Row 9, hdc in each unworked loop of Row; ch 50, hdc in 3rd ch from hook and in each remaining ch across. Fasten off. Tie ends of waist tie into a large bow.

FINISHING

Weave in ends. Sew rings to ears for earrings.

Necklace: String about 12" (30.5 cm) of beads onto strong sewing thread and tie ends of thread together securely. Place on doll and sew a few stitches at back of neck to secure. Place clothing and accessories on doll.

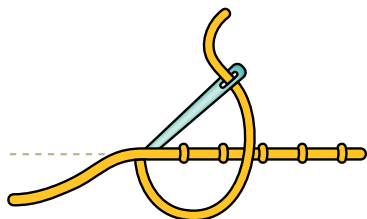
Embroider Face

With **C**, embroider satin stitch eyes and couched stitch eyebrows. With **A**, embroider satin stitch nose. With **D**, embroider a couched stitch smile. With red crayon, gently rub color onto face for cheeks.

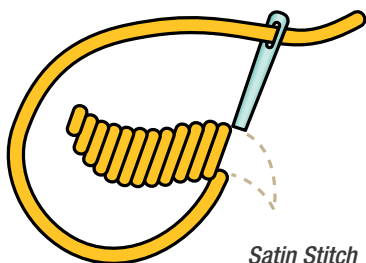
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ABBREVIATIONS

A, B, C, D, E, and F = Color A, B, C, D, E, and F;
ch = chain; **dc** = double crochet; **hdc** = half
 double crochet; **sc** = single crochet; **st(s)** =
 stitch (es); **()** = work directions in parentheses
 into same st; **[]** = work directions in brackets
 the number of times specified; ***** = repeat
 whatever follows the ***** as indicated.
