What you will need:
Yarn needed for each puppet is listed here. Complete materials list and gauge information is given with each project.

## BAT:

RED HEART ${ }^{\circledR}$ Anne Geddes Baby ${ }^{\text {™ }}$ 1 ball of 112 Night-Night $A$ and a small amount of 226 Bumble B

## GHOST:

RED HEART ${ }^{\circledR}$ Anne Geddes Baby ${ }^{T M}$ : 1 ball of 100 Lily A and a small amount of 112 Night-Night B

## PUMPKIN:

RED HEART ${ }^{\circledR}$ Anne Geddes Baby ${ }^{\text {Tm }}$ A small amount of 691 Grass A 1 ball of 0261 Tangerine $\mathbf{B}$ and a small amount of 112 Night-Night C RED HEART ${ }^{\circledR}$ Anne Geddes Baby ${ }^{\text {TM }}$, Art. 805 available in solid $3.50 z$ ( 100 g ) $334 \mathrm{yd}(305 \mathrm{~m})$ and multi $3.5 \mathrm{oz}(100 \mathrm{~g}) 272 \mathrm{yd}(248 \mathrm{~m})$ balls

## Halloween Puppets

Enjoy creative playtime with our Bat, Ghost and Pumpkin puppets. These easy to crochet toys will spark the imagination of your favorite child (and will be enjoyed a lot longer than candy).

## Bat Puppet

Finished Size: $61 / 2 "$ ( 16.5 cm ) circumference

Susan Bates® Crochet Hook: 4 mm [US G-6]

Stitch marker, yarn needle

GAUGE: $22 \mathrm{sc}=4$ " (10 cm); 26 rows = 4" $(10 \mathrm{~cm})$. CHECK YOUR GAUGE. Use any size hook to obtain the gauge.

## Notes

Puppet is worked in continuous rounds without joining, with the right side facing throughout. Place stitch marker to indicate beginning of round and move as rounds are worked.

## Special Stitch

Sc2tog = (insert hook in next st, Yo and pull up a loop) twice, Yo and pull through 3 loops on hook. (1 stitch decrease).

## BAT PUPPET

## Body

## With A, ch 2.

Round 1 (Right side): 8 sc in second ch from hook, do not join.
Round 2: (2 sc in next sc, sc in next sc) around: 12 sc .
Round 3: (2 sc in next sc, sc in next 2 sc) around: 16 sc.
Round 4: (2 sc in next sc, sc in next 3 sc ) around: 20 sc .
Round 5: (2 sc in next sc, sc in next 4 sc ) around: 24 sc .
Round 6: (2 sc in next sc, sc in next 5 sc) around: 28 sc.
Rounds 7-13: Sc in each sc around.
Round 14: (Sc in next 5 sc, sc2tog) around: 24 sc.
Round 15: Sc in each sc around.

Round 16: (2 sc in next sc, sc in next 11 sc ) around: 26 sc.
Round 17: Sc in each sc around.
Round 18: (2 sc in next sc, sc in next 12 sc) around: 28 sc.
Round 19: (2 sc in next sc, sc in next 6 sc ) around: 32 sc.
Round 20: (2 sc in next sc, sc in next 7 sc ) around: 36 sc
Round 21: Sc in next 7 sc, ch 5, skip next 5 sc (wing opening), sc in next 12 sc, ch 5, skip next 5 sc , sc in each sc around.
Round 22: Sc in each sc and ch around: 36 sc.
Rounds 23-40: Sc in each sc around.
Round 41: Sc in each sc around, join with slip st to first sc; fasten off.

## Wing (Make 2)

With right side facing, join A with slip st in first ch of any arm opening.
Round 1 (Right side): Ch 1, sc in same ch, sc in next 4 chs, next end of row, next 5 sc and in next end of row, do not join: 12 sc.
Round 2: Sc in each sc around.
Round 3: (2 sc in next sc, sc in next 3 sc ) around: 15 sc .
Round 4: (2 sc in next sc, sc in next 4 sc) around: 18 sc .
Round 5: Sc in each sc around.
Round 6: Sc in next $5 \mathrm{sc}, \mathrm{sc} 2 \mathrm{tog}$, sc in next 8 $\mathrm{sc}, 2 \mathrm{sc}$ in next sc, sc in last 2 sc : 18 sc .
Round 7: Sc in next 4 sc, sc2tog, sc in next 9 $\mathrm{sc}, 2 \mathrm{sc}$ in next sc, sc in last 2 sc : 18 sc .
Round 8: Sc in next 3 sc , sc2tog, sc in next 10 sc, 2 sc in next sc, sc in last 2 sc : 18 sc .
Round 9: (2 sc in next sc, sc in next 5 sc ) around: 21 sc .
Round 10: (2 sc in next sc, sc in next 6 sc ) around: 24 sc .
Round 11: Sc in next 18 sc, sc2tog 3 times: 21 sc .

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## Yarnspirations"

Round 12: Sc in next 15 sc, sc2tog 3 times: 18 sc.
Round 13: Sc in each sc around.
Round 14: Sc in next 12 sc, sc2tog 3 times, join with slip st to first sc; fasten off leaving a long end for sewing: 15 sc .
Thread yarn needle with long end and weave through 15 remaining sc, fasten securely.

## Ear (Make 2)

With A, ch 2.
Round 1 (Right side): 4 sc in second ch from hook, do not join.
Rounds 2 and 3: Sc in each sc around.
Round 4: (2 sc in next sc, sc in next sc) around: 6 sc
Round 5: Sc in each sc around, join with slip st to first sc; fasten off leaving a long end for sewing.

## Teeth

With B, ch 9 .
Row 1 (Right side): Slip st in second ch from hook, sc in next ch, ch 1 , hdc in next ch, slip st in next 2 ch, sc in next ch, hdc in next ch, dc in next ch, slip st in last ch; fasten off leaving a long end for sewing.

## FINISHING

Thread yarn needle with Ear long end. Using photo as a guide, sew Ear to Puppet. Repeat for second Ear. Thread yarn needle with Teeth long end. Using photo as a guide, sew Teeth to Puppet.
Thread yarn needle with a length of $\mathbf{B}$. Using photo as a guide embroider eyes.

## Ghost Puppet

Susan Bates ${ }^{\circledR}$ Crochet Hook: 4 mm [US G-6]

Stitch marker, yarn needle

GAUGE: $22 \mathrm{sc}=4$ " ( 10 cm ); 26 rows = 4" (10 $\mathrm{cm})$. CHECK YOUR GAUGE. Use any size hook to obtain the gauge.

## Finished Size: 6½" (16.5 cm) circumference

## GHOST PUPPET

## Body

With A, ch 2.
Round 1 (Right side): 8 sc in second ch from hook, do not join.
Round 2: (2 sc in next sc, sc in next sc) around: 12 sc .
Round 3: (2 sc in next sc, sc in next 2 sc ) around: 16 sc.
Round 4: (2 sc in next sc, sc in next 3 sc ) around: 20 sc .
Round 5: ( 2 sc in next sc, sc in next 4 sc ) around: 24 sc .
Round 6: (2 sc in next sc, sc in next 5 sc ) around: 28 sc.
Rounds 7-13: Sc in each sc around.
Round 14: (Sc in next 5 sc, sc2tog) around: 24 sc.
Round 15: Sc in each sc around.
Round 16: (2 sc in next sc, sc in next 11 sc ) around: 26 sc.
Round 17: Sc in each sc around.
Round 18: (2 sc in next sc, sc in next 12 sc ) around: 28 sc.
Round 19: (2 sc in next sc, sc in next 6 sc ) around: 32 sc .
Round 20: (2 sc in next sc, sc in next 7 sc ) around: 36 sc
Round 21: Sc in next 7 sc , ch 5 , skip next 5 sc (wing opening), sc in next 12 sc, ch 5, skip next $5 \mathrm{sc}, \mathrm{sc}$ in each sc around.

Round 22: Sc in each sc and ch around: 36 Sc. Rounds 23-26: Sc in each sc around.
Round 27: (2 sc in next sc, sc in next 8 sc ) around: 40 sc.
Rounds 28-39: Sc in each sc around.
Round 40: *Slip st in next sc, ch2, dc in next
2 sc, hdc in next sc, slip st in next sc, sc in next sc) around, join with slip st to first slip st; fasten off.

## Arm

With right side facing, join A with slip st in first ch of any arm opening.
Round 1 (Right side): Ch 1, sc in same ch, sc in next 4 ch, next end of row, next 5 sc and in next end of row, do not join: 12 sc .
Rounds 2-7: Sc in each sc around.
Round 8: (Sc in next 4 sc, sc2tog) around: 10 sc.
Round 9: Sc in each sc around.
Round 10: Sc2tog around, fasten off leaving a long end for sewing: 5 sc .
Thread yarn needle with long end and weave through 5 remaining sc, draw up firmly and fasten securely.
Repeat for second arm opening.

## Mouth

With B, ch 3.
Round 1 (Right side): 5 hdc in third ch from hook; fasten off leaving a long end for sewing.

## FINISHING

Thread yarn needle with Mouth long end. Using photo as a guide, sew Mouth to Puppet. Thread yarn needle with a length of B. Using photo as a guide embroider eyes.

## Pumpkin Puppet

Susan Bates ${ }^{\circledR}$ Crochet Hook: 4 mm [US G-6
Stitch marker, yarn needle

GAUGE: 22 sC = 4" (10 cm); 26 rows = 4" ( 10 cm ). CHECK YOUR GAUGE. Use any size hook to obtain the gauge.

## Finished Size: 7" (18 cm) circumference

## PUMPKIN PUPPET

## Body

With A, ch 2.
Round 1 (Right side): 6 sc in second ch from hook, do not join.
Rounds 2 and 3: Sc in each sc around.
Round 4: (Sc in next sc, sc2tog) around: 4 sc.
Round 5: Sc in each sc around, changing to B in last st.
Round 6: With B, 2 sc in each sc around: 8 sc Round 7: (2 sc in next sc, sc in next sc) around: 12 sc .
Round 8: (2 sc in next sc, sc in next 2 sc ) around: 16 sc.
Round 9: (2 sc in next sc, sc in next 3 sc) around: 20 sc
Round 10: (2 sc in next sc, sc in next 4 sc) around: 24 sc .
Round 11: (2 sc in next sc, sc in next 5 sc) around: 28 sc
Rounds 12-18: Sc in each sc around.
Round 19: (Sc in next 5 sc, sc2tog) around: 24 sc.
Round 20: Sc in each sc around.
Round 21: (2 sc in next sc, sc in next 11 sc) around: 26 sc
Round 22: Sc in each sc around.
Round 23: (2 sc in next sc, sc in next 12 sc ) around: 28 sc
Round 24: (2 sc in next sc, sc in next 6 sc) around: 32 sc .
Round 25: (2 sc in next sc, sc in next 7 sc ) around: 36 sc
Round 26: Sc in next 7 sc , ch 5 , skip next 5 sc (arm opening), sc in next 12 sc, ch 5 , skip next 5 sc, sc in each sc around.

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## Yarnspirations"

Round 27: Sc in each sc and ch around: 36 sc. Rounds 28-31: Sc in each sc around.
Round 32: (2 sc in next sc, sc in next 8 sc) around: 40 sc .

Rounds 33-44: Sc in each sc around
Round 45: (Sc in next 8 sc , sc2tog) around: 36 sc.
Round 46: Sc in each Sc around, join with slip st to first Sc; fasten off.

## Arm

With right side facing, join A with slip st in first ch of any arm opening.
Round 1 (Right side): Ch 1, sc in same ch, sc in next 4 ch, next end of row, next 5 sc and in next end of row, do not join: 12 sc.
Rounds 2-7: Sc in each Sc around
Round 8: (Sc in next 4 sc, sc2tog) around:
10 sc.
Round 9: Sc in each sc around.
Round 10: Sc2tog around, fasten off leaving a ong end for sewing: 5 sc.
Thread yarn needle with long end and weave through 5 remaining sc, draw up firmly and fasten securely.
Repeat for second arm opening.

## Eye (Make 2)

With C, ch 3.
Round 1 (Right side): 2 hdc in third ch from hook; fasten off leaving a long end for sewing.

## Mouth

With C, ch 3.
Round 1 (Right side): 5 hdc in third ch from hook; fasten off leaving a long end for sewing.

## FINISHING

Thread yarn needle with Mouth long end. Using photo as a guide, sew Mouth to Puppet. Thread yarn needle with Eye long end. Using photo as a guide, sew Eye to Puppet. Repeat for second Eye.
Thread yarn needle with a length of C. Using photo as a guide embroider nose.

A, B, C, etc = Colors A, B, C, etc; ch = chain; $\mathrm{cm}=$ centimeter; $\mathrm{dc}=$ double crochet; hdc = half double crochet; $\mathbf{m m}=$ millimeter; sc = single crochet; st(s) = stitch(es); tog = together; Yo = yarn over ( ) = work instructions in parentheses as indicated.
