## What you will need:

Yarn needed for each puppet is listed here. Complete materials list and gauge information is given with each project.

## FLYING MONKEY:

RED HEART ${ }^{\circledR}$ Anne Geddes Baby ${ }^{\text {TM }}$ 1 ball each of 902 Ladybug A, 301 Teddy B and a small amount of 112 Night-Night C

## GOOD WITCH:

RED HEART ${ }^{\circledR}$ Anne Geddes Baby ${ }^{\text {™ }}$ 1 ball each of 702 Rosie A, 504 Robin B, 936 Rocking Horse C, and a small amount of 100 Lily $D$, 226 Bumble E, 801 Bluebell F, 764 Taffy G and 112 Night-Night H

## MEAN WITCH:

RED HEART ${ }^{\circledR}$ Anne Geddes Baby ${ }^{\text {TM }}$ : 1 ball each of 691 Grass A, 112 Night-Night B, 261 Tangerine C, 556 Jam D, and 764 Taffy E.

RED HEART ${ }^{\circledR}$ Anne Geddes Baby ${ }^{\text {™ }}$, Art. 805 available in solid $3.50 z$ $(100 \mathrm{~g}) 334 \mathrm{yd}(305 \mathrm{~m})$ and multi $3.5 \mathrm{oz}(100 \mathrm{~g}) 272 \mathrm{yd}(248 \mathrm{~m})$ balls


## Puppets for Play

Enjoy creative playtime with our Good Witch, Mean Witch and Flying Monkey puppets. These easy to crochet toys will spark the imagination of your favorite child.

## FLYING MONKEY

Finished Size: 61/2" (16.5 cm) circumference
Susan Bates ${ }^{\circledR}$ Crochet Hook: 4 mm [US G-6] (for all puppets)

Stitch marker, yarn needle, pipe cleaner (monkey only)

GAUGE: $22 \mathrm{sc}=4$ " $(10 \mathrm{~cm})$; 26 rows $=4$ " $(10 \mathrm{~cm})$. CHECK YOUR GAUGE. Use any size hook to obtain the gauge.

## Notes

Puppet is worked in continuous rounds without joining, with the right side facing throughout. Place stitch marker to indicate beginning of round and move as rounds are worked

## Special Stitch

Sc2tog = (insert hook in next st, Yo and pull up a loop) twice, Yo and pull through 3 loops on hook. (1 stitch decrease).

## FLYING MONKEY

## Body

With A, ch 2.
Round 1 (Right side): 8 sc in second ch from hook, do not join.
Round 2: (2 sc in next sc, sc in next sc)
around: 12 sc .
Round 3: (2 sc in next sc, sc in next 2 sc) around: 16 sc.
Round 4: (2 sc in next sc, sc in next 3 sc) around: 20 sc .
Round 5: (2 sc in next sc, sc in next 4 sc) around: 24 sc.
Round 6: (2 sc in next sc, sc in next 5 sc) around: 28 sc.
Rounds 7-13: Sc in each sc around.
Round 14: (Sc in next $5 \mathrm{sc}, \mathrm{sc} 2 \mathrm{tog}$ ) around: 24 sc.

Round 15: Sc in each sc around
Round 16: (2 sc in next sc, sc in next 11 sc) around: 26 sc.
Round 17: Sc in each sc around.
Round 18: (2 sc in next sc, sc in next 12 sc ) around: 28 sc.
Round 19: (2 sc in next sc, sc in next 6 sc) around: 32 sc.
Round 20: (2 sc in next sc, sc in next 7 sc ) around: 36 sc .
Round 21: Sc in next 7 sc, ch 5 , skip next 5 sc (arm opening), sc in next 12 sc, ch 5, skip next $5 \mathrm{sc}, \mathrm{sc}$ in each sc around.
Round 22: Sc in each sc and ch around: 36 sc.
Rounds 23-40: Sc in each Sc around.
Round 41: Sc in each sc around, join with slip st to first sc; fasten off.

Arm
With right side facing, join A with slip st in first ch of any arm opening.
Round 1 (Right side): Ch 1, sc in same ch, sc in next 4 ch , next end of row, next 5 sc and in next end of row, do not join: 12 sc.
Rounds 2-6: Sc in each sc around, changing to $\mathbf{B}$ in last sc of Round 6.
Round 7: With B, sc in each sc around.
Round 8: (Sc in next 4 sc, sc2tog) around:
10 sc.
Round 9: Sc in each sc around.
Round 10: Sc2tog around, fasten off leaving a long end for sewing: 5 sc.
Thread yarn needle with long end and weave through 5 remaining sc, draw up firmly and fasten securely.
Repeat for second arm opening.

## Wing (Make 2)

With B and leaving a long end for sewing, ch 2. Round 1 (Right side): 8 sc in second ch from hook, do not join.

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Round 2: (2 sc in next sc, sc in next sc) around: 12 sc .
Round 3: Sc in each sc around.
Round 4: (2 sc in next sc, sc in next 3 sc) around: 15 sc .
Round 5: (2 sc in next sc, sc in next 4 sc) around: 18 sc .
Round 6: Sc in each sc around.
Round 7: Sc in next $5 \mathrm{sc}, \mathrm{sc} 2 \mathrm{tog}$, sc in next 8 sc, 2 sc in next sc, sc in last 2 sc : 18 sc .
Round 8: Sc in next 4 sc , sc2tog, sc in next 9 sc, 2 sc in next sc, sc in last 2 sc : 18 sc .
Round 9: Sc in next 3 sc, sc2tog, sc in next 10 sc, 2 sc in next sc, sc in last 2 sc : 18 sc .
Round 10: (2 sc in next sc, sc in next 5 sc ) around: 21 sc .
Round 11: (2 sc in next sc, sc in next 6 sc) around: 24 sc .
Round 12: Sc in each sc around to last 6 sc, sc2tog 3 times: 21 sc.
Round 13: Repeat Round 12: 18 sc.
Round 14: Sc in each sc around.
Round 15: Sc in each Sc around to last 6 Sc, sc2tog 3 times, fasten off leaving a long end for sewing: 15 sc.
Thread yarn needle with long end and weave through 15 remaining sc, fasten securely.

## Ear (Make 2)

With $\mathbf{B}$ and leaving a long end for sewing, ch 2.
Round 1 (Right side): 6 sc in second ch from hook, do not join.
Round 2: (2 sc in next sc, sc in next 2 sc)
around: 8 sc.
Rounds 3 and 4: Sc in each sc around.
Fasten off leaving a long end for sewing.

## Face

With B, ch 2.
Round 1 (Right side): 8 sc in second ch from hook, do not join.

Round 2: (2 sc in next sc, sc in next sc) around: 12 sc .
Round 3: (2 sc in next sc, sc in next 2 sc ) around: 16 sc .
Round 4: (2 sc in next sc, sc in next 3 sc ) around: 20 sc .
Round 5: (2 sc in next sc, sc in next 4 sc ) around: 24 sc .
Round 6: (Sc in next sc, dc in next 2 sc , hdc in next sc, slip st in next sc) twice; fasten off leaving a long end for sewing.

## Tail

With A, ch 2.
Round 1 (Right side): 5 sc in second ch from hook, do not join.
Rounds 2- 23: Sc in each sc around.
Fasten off leaving a long end for sewing. Cut pipe cleaner to fit Tail and insert in Tail. Thread yarn needle with the long end and weave through 5 remaining sc, draw up firmly and fasten securely.

## FINISHING

Thread yarn needle with Wing long end. Using photo as a guide, sew Wing to Puppet. Repeat for second Wing. Thread yarn needle with Tail long end. Using photo as a guide, sew Tail to Puppet below Wings. Thread yarn needle with Face long end. Using photo as a guide, sew Face to opposite side of Puppet towards beginning rounds. Thread yarn needle with Ear long end. Using photo as a guide, sew Ear to side of Puppet toward beginning rounds. Repeat for second Ear.
Thread yarn needle with a length of $\mathbf{C}$. Using photo as a guide embroider eyes, nose and mouth on Face.

## Good Witch Puppet

Finished Size: 6" (15 cm) circumference

GAUGE: $20 \mathrm{hdc}=4 "(10 \mathrm{~cm}) ; 16$ rows $=4$ "
( 10 cm ). CHECK YOUR GAUGE. Use any size hook to obtain the gauge.

## GOOD WITCH

## Body

With A, ch 2.
Round 1 (Right side): 8 sc in second ch from hook, do not join.
Round 2: (2 sc in next sc, sc in next sc) around: 12 sc .
Round 3: (2 sc in next sc, sc in next 2 sc ) around: 16 sc.
Round 4: (2 sc in next sc, sc in next 3 sc ) around: 20 sc.
Round 5: (2 sc in next sc, sc in next 4 sc ) around: 24 sc .
Round 6: (2 sc in next sc, sc in next 5 sc ) around: 28 sc.
Rounds 7-13: Sc in each sc around.
Round 14: (Sc in next $5 \mathrm{sc}, \mathrm{sc} 2 \mathrm{tog}$ ) around: 24 sc.
Round 15: Sc in each sc around.
Round 16: (Sc in next 10 sc, sc2tog) around: 22 sc.
Round 17: Sc in each sc around.
Round 18: (2 sc in next sc, sc in next 10 sc ) around: 24 sc .
Round 19: (2 sc in next sc, sc in next 11 sc) around: 26 sc.
Round 20: Sc in each sc around.
Round 21: (2 sc in next sc, sc in next 12 sc ) around: 28 sc.
Round 22: (2 sc in next sc, sc in next 6 sc )
around, changing to $B$ in last sc: 32 sc.
Round 23: With B, sc in front loop only of each SC around.
Round 24: (2 sc in next sc, sc in next 7 sc ) around: 36 sc.
Round 25: Sc in next 7 sc, ch 5, skip next 5 sc (arm opening), sc in next 12 sc, ch 5, skip next $5 \mathrm{sc}, \mathrm{sc}$ in each sc around.

Round 26: Sc in each sc and ch around: 36 sc . Rounds 27 and 28: Sc in each sc around, changing to C in last sc.
Round 29: With C, (2 hdc in next sc, hdc in next 2 sc ) around: 48 hdc .
Round 30: Hdc in each hdc around.
Round 31: (2 hdc in next hdc, hdc in next 3 hdc) around: 60 hdc.
Rounds 32-39: Hdc in each hdc around.
Round 40: Hdc in each hdc around to last hdc, sc in last hdc changing to $\mathbf{D}$.
Round 41: With D, *slip st in the back loop only of next st, sc in next st, hdc in next st, dc in next st, hdc in next st, sc in next st; repeat from * around; join with slip st to first slip st, fasten off.

## Sleeve (Make 2)

With right side facing, join C with slip st in first ch of any arm opening.
Round 1 (Right side): Ch 1, sc in same ch, sc in next 4 chs, next end of row, next 5 sc and in next end of row, do not join: 12 sc.
Round 2: Sc in each sc around.
Round 3: (2 hdc in next sc, hdc in next hdc) around: 18 hdc.
Rounds 4 and 5: Hdc in each hdc around.
Round 6: (Sc in next hdc, sc2tog) around: 12 sc.
Round 7: Sc in each sc around, changing to A in last st.
Round 8: With A, (sc in back loops only of next 4 sc, sc2tog) around: 10 sc.
Rounds 9-11: Sc in each sc around.
Round 12: Sc2tog around, fasten off leaving a long end for sewing: 5 sc .
Thread yarn needle with long end and weave through 5 remaining sc, draw up firmly and fasten securely.
Repeat for second arm opening.
Continued

## Hair

With E, ch 2.
Round 1 (Right side): 8 sc in second ch from hook, do not join.
Round 2: (2 sc in next sc, sc in next sc) around: 12 sc .
Round 3: (2 sc in next sc, sc in next 2 sc) around: 16 sc.
Round 4: (2 sc in next sc, sc in next 3 sc ) around: 20 sc.
Round 5 : *Ch 28 , work 3 hdc in third ch from hook, (skip next ch, 3 hdc in next ch) twice, hdc in next 21 ch , skip next sc from previous round, slip st in next sc; repeat from * 7 times, (sc in next sc, 2 hdc in next sc, slip st in next sc) twice; fasten off leaving a long end for sewing.

## Tiara

With F and leaving a long end for sewing, ch 20; join with slip st to form a ring.
Round 1 (Right side): Ch 1, sc in same ch and in each ch around: 20 sc .
Rounds 2-4: Sc in each sc around.
Round 5: *Sc in next sc, dc in next sc, hdc in next sc, slip st in next sc; repeat from * around; fasten off.

## FINISHING

Thread yarn needle with Hair long end. Using photo as a guide, sew Hair to Puppet. Thread yarn needle with Tiara long end. Using photo as a guide, sew Tiara to Puppet.
Thread yarn needle with a length of $G$. Using photo as a guide embroider mouth. Thread yarn needle with a length of $\mathbf{H}$. Using photo as a guide embroider eyes.

## Mean Witch Puppet

Finished Size: 5" (12.5 cm) circumference.

Susan Bates ${ }^{\circledR}$ Crochet Hook: 4 mm [US G-6].

Stitch marker, yarn needle.

GAUGE: $22 \mathrm{sC}=4$ " ( 10 cm ); 26 rows = 4" $(10 \mathrm{~cm})$. CHECK YOUR GAUGE. Use any size hook to obtain the gauge.

## Notes

Puppet is worked in continuous rounds without joining, with the right side facing throughout. Place stitch marker to indicate beginning of round and move as rounds are worked.

## Special Stitch

Sc2tog = (insert hook in next st, Yo and pull up a loop) twice, Yo and pull through 3 loops on hook. (1 stitch decrease).

## MEAN WITCH

## Body

With A, ch 2.
Round 1 (Right side): 8 sc in second ch from hook, do not join.
Round 2: (2 sc in next sc, sc in next sc) around: 12 sc .
Round 3 : ( 2 sc in next sc, sc in next 2 sc ) around: 16 sc.
Round 4: (2 sc in next sc, sc in next 3 sc ) around: 20 sc .
Round 5: (2 sc in next sc, sc in next 4 sc) around: 24 sc .
Round 6: (2 sc in next sc, sc in next 5 sc ) around: 28 sc.
Rounds 7-13: Sc in each sc around.
Round 14: (Sc in next 5 sc , sc2tog) around: 24 sc.

Round 15: Sc in each Sc around.
Round 16: (Sc in next 10 sc , sc2tog) around: 22 sc .
Round 17: Sc in each sc around, changing to $B$ in last st.
Round 18: With B, (2 sc in next sc, sc in next 10 sc ) around: 24 sc .
Round 19: (2 sc in next sc, sc in next 11 sc ) around: 26 sc.
Round 20: Sc in each sc around.
Round 21: (2 sc in next sc, sc in next 12 sc ) around: 28 sc.
Round 22: (2 sc in next sc, sc in next 6 sc) around: 32 sc.
Round 23: (2 sc in next sc, sc in next 7 sc ) around: 36 sc .
Round 24 : Sc in next 7 sc, ch 5 , skip next 5 sc (arm opening), sc in next 12 sc , ch 5 , skip next 5 sc , sc in each sc around.
Round 25 : Sc in each sc and ch around: 36 sc .
Rounds 26-29: Sc in each sc around.
Round 30 : ( 2 sc in next sc , sc in next 8 sc ) around: 40 sc .
Rounds 31-42: Sc in each sc around.
Round 43: *Ch 5, hdc in third ch from hook, dc in next 2 ch, skip next 3 sc from previous round, slip st in next sc) around; fasten off.

## Arm (Make 2)

With right side facing, join B with slip st in first ch of any arm opening.
Round 1 (Right side): Ch 1 , sc in same ch, sc in next 4 chs , next end of row, next 5 sc and in next end of row, do not join: 12 sc.
Rounds 2-6: Sc in each sc around, changing
to $\mathbf{A}$ in last st of Round 6 .
Round 7: With A, sc in back loops only of each sc around.
Round 8: (Sc in next $4 \mathrm{sc}, \mathrm{sc} 2 \mathrm{tog}$ ) around:
10 sc .
Round 9: Sc in each sc around.
Round 10: Sc2tog around, fasten off leaving a
long end for sewing: 5 sc .

Thread yarn needle with long end and weave through 5 remaining sc, draw up firmly and fasten securely.
Repeat for second arm opening.

## Sleeve

With right side facing, join B with slip st in front loop only in first st of Round 10 of Arm. Round 1 (Right side): *Ch 3, slip st in second ch from hook, sc in next ch, skip next sc on Round 10 , slip st in front loop only of next sc; repeat from * around; fasten off.
Repeat for second Arm.

## Nose

With $\mathbf{A}$, ch 2.
Round 1 (Right side): 4 sc in second ch from hook, do not join.
Rounds 2 and 3: Sc in each sc around.
Round 4: (2 sc in next sc, sc in next sc)
around: 6 sc.
Round 5: Sc in each sc around, join with slip st to first sc; fasten off leaving a long end for sewing.

## Hair Strands (Make 10)

With C, ch 20.
Round 1 (Right side): 3 hdc in third ch from hook, (skip next ch, 3 hdc in next ch) around to last ch, slip st in last ch; fasten off leaving a long end for sewing.

## Hat

With B, ch 2.
Round 1 (Right side): 6 sc in second ch from hook, do not join.
Rounds 2 and 3 : Sc in each sc around.
Round 4: (2 sc in next sc, sc in next 2 sc ) around: 8 sc.
Rounds 5-8: Sc in each sc around.
Round 9: (2 sc in next sc, sc in next 3 sc ) around: 10 sc .

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## Yarnspirations"

Round 10: (2 sc in next sc, sc in next 4 sc) around: 12 sc.
Rounds 11-14: Sc in each sc around.
Round 15: (2 sc in next sc, sc in next 2 sc) around: 16 sc.
Round 16: (2 sc in next sc, sc in next 3 sc) around: 20 sc.
Round 17: (2 sc in next sc, sc in next 4 sc) around, changing to $\mathbf{D}$ in last st: 24 sc . Rounds 18 and 19: With D, sc in each sc around, changing to $\mathbf{B}$ in last st of Round 19. Round 20: With B, sc in each sc around. Round 21: ( 2 sc in next sc, sc in next 3 sc ) around: 30 sc.
Round 22: (2 sc in next sc, sc in next 4 sc) around; fasten off leaving a long end for sewing: 36 sc.

## FINISHING

Thread yarn needle with Nose long end. Using photo as a guide, sew Nose to Puppet. Thread yarn needle with Hair Strands long end. Using photo as a guide, sew Hair Strands to Puppet. Repeat for remaining Hair Strands Thread yarn needle with a length of $\mathbf{B}$. Using photo as a guide embroider eyes and eyebrows. Thread yarn needle with a length of E. Using photo as a guide embroider mouth. Thread yarn needle with a length of C . Using photo as a guide embroider square on Hat. Thread yarn needle with Hat long end. Using photo as a guide, sew Hat to Puppet.

## ABBREVIATIONS

A, B, C, etc = Colors A, B, C, etc; ch = chain; $\mathrm{cm}=$ centimeter; $\mathrm{dc}=$ double crochet; hdc $=$ half double crochet; $\mathbf{m m}=$ millimeter; $\mathbf{s c}$ $=$ single crochet; st(s) = stitch(es); tog = together; $\mathrm{Y}_{0}=$ yarn over; ( ) = work instructions in parentheses as indicated.
