MATERIALS

Red Heart® Amigurumi™ (3.5 oz/100 g; 239 yds/219m)

French Bulldog (9125)

1 ball

Contrast A White

Contrast B Black

Contrast C Grey

Contrast D Aqua

1 ball of yarn will make 2 Puppies.

Size U.S. B/1 (2.25 mm) crochet hook **or size needed to obtain gauge.** Stitch markers. Stuffing. Pair of ¼" [6 mm] safety eyes. Black embroidery floss for nose and mouth.

ABBREVIATIONS

Approx = Approximately

Beg = Beginning

Ch = Chain(s)

Pat = Pattern

PM = Place marker

Rem = Remaining

Rep = Repeat

Rnd(s) = Round(s)

RS = Right side

Sc = Single crochet

Sc2tog = Draw up a loop in each of next 2 sc. Yoh and draw through all 3 loops on hook

Sl st = Slip stitch

St(s) = Stitch(es)

Tog = Together

WS = Wrong side

Yoh = Yarn over hook

MEASUREMENT

Approx 5" [12.5 cm] tall, seated.

GAUGE

22 sc and 24 rows = 4" [10 cm]

To change color, work to last 2 loops on hook and draw new color through last 2 loops and proceed, keeping color change to WS of work.

INSTRUCTIONS

Note: Before start, separate the different color sections of the yarn as follows: Push the rings of color out from center. Find the point where the color changes and cut the yarn. Rep this process for the rem yarn colors. Wind each color into a separate ball.

Do not join at the end of rnd, work in continuous rnds. PM at end of rnd. Move marker up as each rnd is completed.

Version 1

MUZZLE

**With A, ch 2.

1st rnd: 5 sc in 2nd ch from hook.

Do not join. 5 sc. PM at end of rnd.

2nd rnd: 2 sc in each of next 5 sc. 10 sc.

3rd rnd: (1 sc in next sc. 2 sc in next sc) 5 times. 15 sc.

4th rnd: (1 sc in each of next 2 sc. 2 sc in next sc) 5 times. 20 sc.

5th and 6th rnds: 1 sc in each sc around.** Join with sl st in first sc at end of last rnd. Fasten off, leaving a long end for sewing. With black floss, using Straight stitch, embroider nose and mouth onto muzzle as shown in picture.

EARS (make 2)

With B, ch 2.

1st rnd: 5 sc in 2nd ch from hook.

Do not join. 5 sc. PM at end of rnd.

2nd rnd: 1 sc in each sc around.

3rd rnd: 2 sc in each of next 5 sc. 10 sc.

4th and 5th rnds: 1 sc in each sc around.

6th rnd: (1 sc in next sc. 2 sc in next sc) 5 times. 15 sc.

7th rnd: 1 sc in each sc around. Join with sl st in first sc. Fasten off, leaving a long end for sewing.

HEAD

Beg at top of head, with B, ch 2.

1st rnd: 6 sc in 2nd ch from hook.

Do not join. 6 sc. PM at end of rnd.

2nd rnd: Work 2 sc in each of next 6 sc. 12 sc.

3rd rnd: (1 sc in next sc. 2 sc in next sc) 6 times. 18 sc.

4th rnd: (1 sc in each of next 2 sc. 2 sc in next sc) 6 times. 24 sc.

5th rnd: (1 sc in each of next 3 sc. 2 sc in next sc) 6 times. 30 sc.

6th rnd: (1 sc in each of next 4 sc. 2 sc in next sc) 6 times. 36 sc.

7th to 11th rnds: 1 sc in each sc around. Break B at end of last rnd. Join A.

12th to 17th rnds: 1 sc in each sc around.

18th rnd: (1 sc in each of next 4 sc. Sc2tog) 6 times. 30 sts.

19th rnd: 1 sc in each sc around.

20th rnd: (1 sc in each of next 3 sc. Sc2tog) 6 times. 24 sts.

21st rnd: 1 sc in each st around.

Following manufacturer's instructions, attach safety eyes between 14th and 15th rnds, approx 10 sts apart. Lightly stuff muzzle and sew in place between eyes. Stuff head.

22nd rnd: (1 sc in each of next 2 sc. Sc2tog) 6 times. 18 sts.

23rd rnd: (1 sc in next sc. Sc2tog) 6 times. 12 sts.

24th rnd: (Sc2tog) 6 times. 6 sts.

Finish stuffing Head.

Fasten off, leaving a long end. Thread end through all sts of last rnd. Pull tightly. Fasten securely.

BODY

Stripe Pat

With D – 2 rnds

With C – 2 rnds

These 4 rnds form Stripe Pat.

Beg at bottom of body, with D, ch 2. Proceed in Stripe Pat as follows:

1st rnd: 6 sc in 2nd ch from hook **Do not** join. 6 sc. PM at end of rnd.

2nd rnd: 2 sc in each of next 6 sc. 12 sc.

3rd rnd: (1 sc in next sc. 2 sc in next sc) 6 times. 18 sc.

4th rnd: (1 sc in each of next 2 sc. 2 sc in next sc) 6 times. 24 sc.

5th rnd: (1 sc in each of next 3 sc. 2 sc in next sc) 6 times. 30 sc.

6th to 12th rnds: 1 sc in each sc around.

13th rnd: (1 sc in each of next 3 sc. Sc2tog) 6 times. 24 sts.

14th rnd: 1 sc in each st around. Join with sl st in first sc. Fasten off, leaving a long end for sewing body to head.

FRONT LEGS (make 2)

First Leg: With B, ch 2.

1st rnd: 8 sc in 2nd ch from hook. **Do not** join. 8 sc. PM at end of rnd.

Next 9 rnds: 1 sc in each sc around, stuffing leg as you work. Join with sl st in first sc at end of last rnd. Fasten off, leaving a long end.

Sew open end of leg closed.

Second Leg: Work as given for First Leg, working 4 rnds with A, then 5 rnds with B.

BACK LEGS (make 2)

With B, ch 2.

1st rnd: 10 sc in 2nd ch from hook. **Do not** join. 10 sc. PM at end of rnd.

Next 9 rnds: 1 sc in each sc around, stuffing leg as you work. Join with sl st in first sc at end of last rnd. Fasten off, leaving a long end.

TINY TAIL

With B, ch 2.

1st rnd: 6 sc in 2nd ch from hook. **Do not** join. 10 sc. PM at end of rnd

2nd and 3rd rnds: 1 sc in each sc around.

Join with sl st in first sc at end of last rnd. Fasten off, leaving a long end.

FINISHING

Referring to picture as a guide to placement, sew Ears to Head.

Stuff Body and sew to Head.

Sew Front Legs to upper front of Body.

Sew Back Legs to lower front of Body.

Sew Tail to center rear of Body.

Version 2

MUZZLE: Work from ** to ** as given for Version 1. Turn at end of 6th rnd.

Forehead Stripe

Note: Work back and forth in rows.

7th row: (WS). Ch 1. 1 sc in each of next 3 sc. **Turn.** Leave rem sts unworked.

8th to 15th rows: Ch 1. 1 sc in each of next 3 sc. Turn.

Fasten off at end of last row, leaving a long end for sewing.

With black floss, embroider nose and mouth onto muzzle as shown in picture.

EARS and HEAD: With C, work as given for Version 1, omitting color changes.

BODY: With D, work as given for Version 1, omitting color changes.

FRONT LEGS: With A, work as given for Version 1, omitting color changes.

BACK LEGS and TINY TAIL: With C, work as given for Version 1.

FINISHING: Work as given for Version 1.
