

## Child's Pirate Costume

Pirates are one of the most popular costumes. Both boys and girls will love this fun set for Halloween and beyond. The belt/scarf can be worn either way.

Designed by Kim Guzman.
SIZE: Child size 4-6.
Finished measurements: Hat circumference measures $18^{\prime \prime}$ at base. Belt measures 4 " $\times 54^{\prime \prime}$.

RED HEART® "Super Saver®: 1 skein each 312 Black A, 319 Cherry Red (for boy version) or 373 Petal Pink B (for girl version), and 0316 Soft White C

Crochet Hooks: 6.5 mm [US K-10 $1 / 2$ ] and 5 mm [US H-8]. Stitch marker, yarn needle.

GAUGE: Hat: $9 \mathrm{sc}=4$ "; after Round $5=3.5^{\prime \prime}$ across. CHECK YOUR GAUGE. Use any size hook to obtain the gauge. Gauge not critical for eye patch and sash.

Note: Rounds are not joined until instructed otherwise.
Place stitch marker to mark beginning of each round.

## HAT

Round 1: With larger hook and A, ch 2; 5 sc in 2nd ch from hook - 5 sc.
Round 2: Work 2 sc in each sc around - 10 sc.
Round 3: [Sc in next sc, 2 sc in next sc] 5 times -15 sc .
Round 4: [Sc in next $2 \mathrm{sc}, 2 \mathrm{sc}$ in next sc] 5 times - 20 sc .
Round 5: [Sc in next $3 \mathrm{sc}, 2 \mathrm{sc}$ in next sc] 5 times -25 sc .
Round 6: [Sc in next $4 \mathrm{sc}, 2 \mathrm{sc}$ in next sc] 5 times -30 sc .
Round 7: [Sc in next $5 \mathrm{sc}, 2 \mathrm{sc}$ in next sc] 5 times -35 sc .
Round 8: [Sc in next $6 \mathrm{sc}, 2 \mathrm{sc}$ in next sc] 5 times -40 sc .
Rounds 9-20: Sc in each sc around.
Round 21: [Sc in next $7 \mathrm{sc}, 2 \mathrm{sc}$ in next sc] 5 times -45 sc .
Round 22: [Sc in next $8 \mathrm{sc}, 2 \mathrm{sc}$ in next sc] 5 times -50 sc .
Round 23: [Sc in next 9 sc , 2 sc in next sc] 5 times -55 sc .
Round 24: [Sc in next $10 \mathrm{sc}, 2 \mathrm{sc}$ in next sc] 5 times - 60 sc .
Round 25: [Sc in next $11 \mathrm{sc}, 2 \mathrm{sc}$ in next sc] 5 times -65 sc .
Round 26: [Sc in next $12 \mathrm{sc}, 2$ sc in next sc] 5 times - 70 sc .
Round 27: [Sc in next $13 \mathrm{sc}, 2$ sc in next sc] 5 times -75 sc .
Round 28: [Sc in next $14 \mathrm{sc}, 2$ sc in next sc] 5 times -80 sc .
Round 29: [Sc in next $15 \mathrm{sc}, 2 \mathrm{sc}$ in next sc] 5 times - 85 sc .
Round 30: [Sc in next $16 \mathrm{sc}, 2$ sc in next sc] 5 times - 90 sc.
Round 31: [Sc in next $17 \mathrm{sc}, 2$ sc in next sc] 5 times - 95 sc .
Round 32: [Sc in next 18 sc, 2 sc in next sc] 5 times 100 sc .
Round 33: [Sc in next $19 \mathrm{sc}, 2$ sc in next sc] 5 times 105 sc.
Round 34: [Sc in next 20 sc, 2 sc in next sc] 5 times 110 sc.
Round 35: [Sc in next 21 sc, 2 sc in next sc] 5 times; join with slip st to first sc -115 sc .

## Joining Rounds

Rounds 36-37: Ch 1 , sc in each sc around; join with slip st to first sc
Fasten off A.
Round 38: Join B with slip st to last sc; ch 1 , sc in each sc around; join with slip st to first sc.

Round 39: Ch 1, sc in each sc around, join with slip st to first sc.
Fasten off B.

## Skull

Row 1: With smaller hook and C, ch 3; 2 sc in 2nd ch from hook, sc in last ch; turn - 3 sc.
Row 2: Ch 1, 2 sc in first $\mathrm{sc}, \mathrm{sc}$ in next $\mathrm{sc}, 2 \mathrm{sc}$ in last sc ; turn - 5 sc .
Row 3: Ch 1, sc in each sc across; turn.
Row 4: Ch 1, sc in first sc, [2 sc in next sc, sc in next sc] 2 times; turn - 7 sc.
Row 5: Ch 1, sc in each sc across; turn
Row 6: Ch 1, skip first sc, sc in next 4 sc, skip 1 sc , sc in last sc; turn - 5 sc.
Row 7: Ch 1, skip first sc, sc in next 2 sc, skip 1 sc, sc in last sc; turn - 3 sc.
Fasten off, leaving 10" tail for seaming to hat.

## Cross Bones (Make 2)

Row 1: With smaller hook and C, ch 2; 4 sc in 2nd ch from hook, slip st to first sc of 4 sc group; do not fasten off.
Row 2: Ch 11, 4 sc in 2nd ch from hook, slip st to first sc of 4 sc group.
Fasten off, leaving 10 " tail for seaming to hat.

## FINISHING

Hat
First Join: With yarn needle and strand of B, baste yarn to last st worked; skip 26 sc, sew next sc to basted st. Fasten off.
Second Join: With yarn needle and second strand of B, skip 10 sc from first join, baste yarn to next sc; skip 26 sc, sew next sc to basted st. Fasten off.
Third Join: With yarn needle and third strand of B, skip 10 sc from second join, baste yarn to next sc; skip 26 sc, sew next sc to basted st. Fasten off.
Weave in ends.

## Applique

With yarn needle and strand of C, place bones in an " $X$ " configuration and seam to hat as shown. Layer skull over cross bones and seam to hat. With yarn needle and A, make skull face details as shown.
Weave in ends.

## EYE PATCH

Row 1: With larger hook and $\mathbf{A}$, ch 5; skip first ch, sc in next 4 chs; turn - 4 sc.
Row 2: Ch 1, 2 sc in first sc, sc in next $2 \mathrm{sc}, 2 \mathrm{sc}$ in last sc; turn - 6 sc .
Rows 3-4: Ch 1, sc in each across; turn.
Row 5: Ch 1, sc in each sc across; at end of row, ch 30 (first tie made).
Fasten off.
To work second tie, join A with slip st to side of first sc of row 5; ch 30.
Fasten off.
Weave in ends.

## BELT

Row 1: With larger hook and B, ch 11; sc in 2nd ch from hook and in each ch across; turn - 10 sc .
Rows 2-3: Ch 1, sc in each sc across; turn.
Row 4: Ch 4 (counts as first tr), skip first sc, tr in each sc across; turn - 10 tr.
Rows 5-7: Ch 1, sc in each st across; turn.
Repeat Rows 4-7 19 times.
Fasten off.
Weave in ends.
