What you will need:

RED HEART* Scrubby Sparkle™: 1 ball each 8931 Pink Grapefruit A, 8930 Watermelon B, 8001 Marshmallow C, and 8570 Grape D

RED HEART* Scrubby Smoothie™: 1 ball each 9235 Lemony E, 9311 White F, and 9373 Brite Pink G

Susan Bates* Crochet Hook: 6.5mm [US K-10½]

Yarn needle, button, headband, craft glue, small artificial flowers

GAUGE: Gauge is not critical for this project.

SHOP KIT



Unicorn Tail & Crochet Horn Headband

Playing pretend just got more magical! This headband and tail will be your little unicorn's favorite dress up set!

TAIL Belt

With **F**, ch 76.

Rows 1: Sc in 2nd ch from hook, sc in each ch across - 75 sc.

Rows 2-6: Ch 1, turn, sc in each sc across.

Row 7: Ch 1, turn, sc in next 35 sts, ch 5, skip 5 sc for tassel hole, sc in next 35 sts.

Row 8: Ch 1, turn, sc in each sc and ch across - 75 sts.

Fasten off.

Sew button to one end of belt, pushing button between sts to secure closed.

Tassels (Make 2)

With **A**, **B**, **D**, **E** and **G**, cut 50 strands total, each 28" [71 cm] long. Split into 2 groups of 25 lengths. Cut three 6" [15 cm] lengths of **G**. Wrap one short length of **G** around center of one group and knot to secure. Fold in half at tied edge. Repeat to make a second tassel. Position both tassels together. Wrap third length of **G** around both tassels, 1" [2.5 cm] from ties and knot to secure. Use yarn needle to tuck ends in center of tassel. Push tied ends of tassels through skipped sts in center of belt.

HORN

Holding one strand of ${\bf C}$ and ${\bf F}$ together, ch 13.

Rows 1: Sc in 2nd ch from hook, sc in each ch across – 12 sc.

Row 2: Ch 1, turn, sc in each sc across.

Row 3: Ch 1, turn, skip first sc, sc in next 11 sc - 11 sc.

Row 4: Ch 1. turn, sc in each sc across.

Row 5: Ch 1, turn, skip first sc, sc in next 10 sc - 10 sc.

Row 6: Ch 1, turn, sc in each sc across.

Row 7: Ch 1, turn, skip first sc, sc in next 9 sc - 9 sc.

Row 8: Ch 1, turn, sc in each sc across.

Row 9: Ch 1, turn, skip first sc, sc in next 8 sc - 8 sc.

Row 10: Ch 1, turn, sc in each sc across.



Row 11: Ch 1, turn, skip first sc, sc in next 7 sc - 7 sc.

Row 12: Ch 1, turn, sc in each sc across.

Row 13: Ch 1, turn, skip first sc, sc in next 6 sc - 6 sc.

Row 14: Ch 1, turn, sc in each sc across.

Row 15: Ch 1, turn, skip first sc, sc in next 5 sc - 5 sc.

Row 16: Ch 1, turn, sc in each sc across.

Row 17: Ch 1, turn, skip first sc, sc in next 4 sc - 4 sc.

Row 18: Ch 1, turn, sc in each sc across.

Row 19: Ch 1, turn, skip first sc, sc in

next 3 sc - 3 sc.

Row 20: Ch 1, turn, sc in each sc across.

Row 21: Ch 1, turn, skip first sc, sc in next 2 sc - 2 sc.

Row 22: Ch 1, turn, sc in each sc across.

Row 33: Ch 1, turn, skip first sc, sc in

next sc.

Fasten off, leaving a long tail to sew up horn.

Roll up Horn triangle and sew closed. Sew onto headband.

EARS (make 2)

With **F**, ch 10.

Row 1: Dc in 4th ch from hook, dc in next 2 ch, hdc in next 2 ch, sc in next ch, 3 sc in last ch, turn to work along opposite edge of foundation ch, sc in next ch, hdc in next 2 ch, dc in next 3 ch, dc in first ch of beginning ch-3 - 16 sts.

Row 2: Ch 3, turn, dc in next 4 sts, hdc in next 2 sts, sc in next st, 3 sc in next st, sc in next st, hdc in next 2 sts, dc in next 4 sts, dc in top of beginning ch. Fasten off, leaving a long tail for sewing.

Sew onto headband.

Attach flowers with craft glue or sew in place.

Weave in ends.

Abbreviations

A, B, C = Color A, B, C; **ch** = chain; **cm** = centimeters; **dc** = double crochet; **hdc** = half double crochet; **mm** = millimeters; **sc** = single crochet; **st(s)** = stitch(es).
