What you will need:

RED HEART® Soft®: 1 ball 5142
Cherry Red A.

RED HEART® Team Spirit™:
1 skein 940 Red/Blue B.

Susan Bates® Crochet Hook:
5.5mm [US I-9] and 4mm [US G-6]

Stitch marker, yarn needle

GAUGE: 14 sc and 15 rows = 4"
(10cm) using larger hook. **CHECK
YOUR GAUGE.** Use any size hook
to obtain the gauge.

SHOP KIT



Hockey Fan Crochet Hat

*Sport a crochet hat that has you wearing
your hockey socks on top of your hat, or turn
it inside out and have the socks coming out
from the inside keeping your ears warm.*

Hat measures 20 (22)" [51 (56)cm]
circumference

Directions are for size Small. Changes for
size Large are in parentheses

NOTE

Entire hat is worked in back loops only unless
otherwise specified.

SOLID HAT

Round 1 (Right Side): With larger hook and
A, ch 2, 6 sc in 2nd ch from hook. Do not join,
move marker as work progresses—6 sc.

Round 2: 2 sc in back loop only of each sc
around—12 sc.

Round 3: [2 sc in next sc, sc in next sc] 6
times—18 sc.

Round 4: [2 sc in next sc, sc in each of next 2
sc] 6 times—24 sc.

Round 5: [2 sc in next sc, sc in each of next 3
sc] 6 times—30 sc.

Round 6: [2 sc in next sc, sc in each of next 4
sc] 6 times—36 sc.

Round 7: Sc in each sc around.

Round 8: [2 sc in next sc, sc in next 2 sc] 12
times—48 sc.

Round 9: Sc in each sc around.

Round 10: [2 sc in next sc, sc in next 3 sc] 12
times—60 sc.

Round 11: Repeat Round 9.

Round 12: [2 sc in next sc, sc in next 4 sc] 12
times—72 sc.

Round 13: Repeat Round 9.

Size Large Only

Round 14: [2 sc in next sc, sc in next 5 sc] 12
times—84 sc.

All Sizes

Rounds 14-30 (15-32): Sc in each sc around.
Cut A at end of last round; join B.

STRIPED HAT

Rounds 31-45 (33-48): Sc in each sc around.

Size Large Only

Round 49: [Sc2tog, sc in next 5 sc]—72 sc.

Round 50: Sc in each sc around.

All Sizes

Round 46 (51): [Sc2tog, sc in next 4 sc] 12
times—60 sc.

Round 47 (52): Sc in each sc around.

Round 48 (53): [Sc2tog, sc in next 3 sc] 12
times—48 sc.

First Sock

Round 49 (54): Sc in first sc, place marker
in sc just made, sc in next 23 sc, leave
remaining 24 sc unworked.

Round 50 (55): Ch 12, sc in marked sc and in
each of next 23 sc. Sc in each ch—36 sc.

Rounds 51, 53, 55 (56, 58, 60): Sc in each sc
around.

Round 52 (57): [Sc2tog, sc in next 7 sc] 4
times—32 sc.

Round 54 (59): [Sc2tog, sc in next 6 sc] 4
times—28 sc.

Round 56 (61): [Sc2tog, sc in next 5 sc] 4
times—24 sc.

Work 26 more sc rounds. Change to smaller
hook.

Next round: Slip st in back loop of first sc, ch
3, dc in back loop of each sc around, join with
sl st to top of beginning ch-3—24 dc.

Next round: Ch 2, *fpdc in next dc, bpdcc
in next dc; repeat from * around ending with
fpdc and join to top of beginning ch-2.

Repeat last round twice more. Fasten off.

Second Sock

With right side facing, join yarn in first
skipped sc.

Continued...

Round 49 (54): Sc in next 24 sc, sc in free loops of ch 12 of first sock. Work as for first sock.

Insert solid hat into striped hat.

ABBREVIATIONS

bpdfc = back post double crochet; **ch** = chain; **dc** = double crochet; **fpdfc** = front post double crochet; **sc** = single crochet; **sc2tog** = single crochet two stitches together; **st(s)** = stitch(es); **[]** = work directions in brackets the number of times specified.
