MAKE THIS

WHAT YOU'LL NEED



YARN

- **Red Heart® Super Saver®**
(7 oz/198 g; 364 yds/333 m)

COLORS

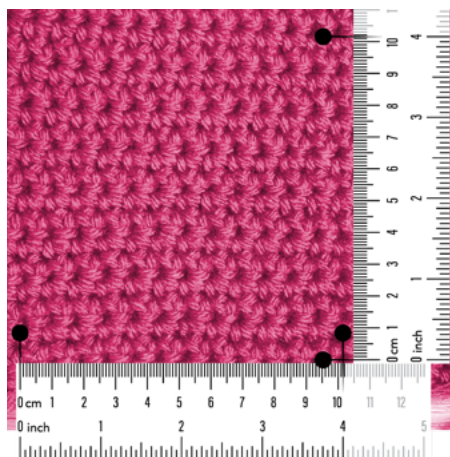
Note: 1 Heart requires approx 54" [137 cm] of yarn.

TOOLS

- Size U.S. I/9 (5.5 mm) Susan Bates® Silvalume® crochet hook **or size needed to obtain gauge.**
- Susan Bates® yarn needle.
- Tape measure.

GAUGE

12 **single crochet** (sc) and 15 rows = 4" [10 cm].

ABBREVIATIONS

Approx =	Rem = Remaining
Approximately	Rnd(s) = Round(s)
Ch = Chain(s)	Sl st = Slip stitch
Dc = Double crochet	St(s) = Stitch(es)
Hdc = Half double	Tog = Together
crochet	Yoh = Yarn over hook

INSTRUCTIONS

USING THIS GUIDE

Click on the underlined words throughout the pattern to access our library of helpful tools.

NOTE

- **Chain** (ch) 3 at start of round (rnd) counts as **double crochet** (dc).

MEASUREMENTS

Approximately (approx) 2" [5 cm] wide x 1½" [4 cm] tall.

HEART (make 3 in each color)

Make a slip knot and place it on the hook.

Slip knot

Make a loop with yarn and fold it on itself to make a pretzel shape.

Then draw through to make slip knot.

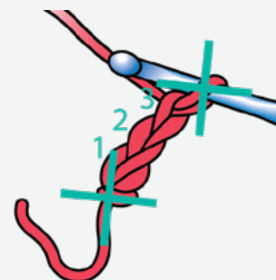
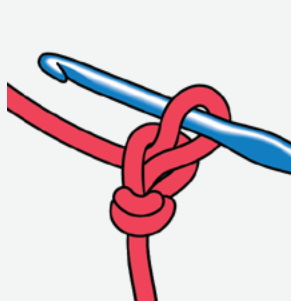
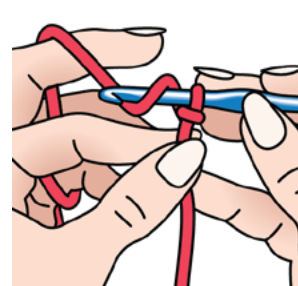
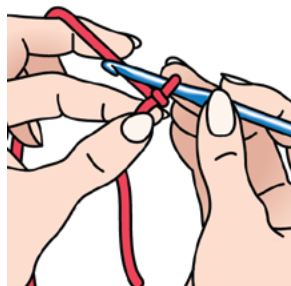
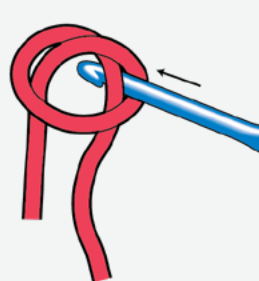
Chain (ch) 3. Slip stitch in first chain to form a ring.

Chain

Yarn over hook (Yoh), draw through loop – 1 chain made.

Repeat (rep) last step twice more – 3 chains made.

INSTRUCTIONS

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Approximately

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Slip stitch

Insert hook into first ch. Yoh and pull the yarn through both the work and the loop on the hook in one movement.



1st rnd: Ch 3 (counts as **double crochet** [dc]). Work 2 dc in ring.

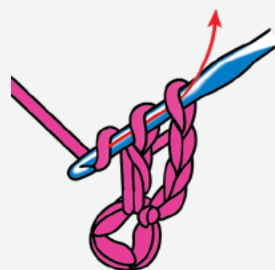
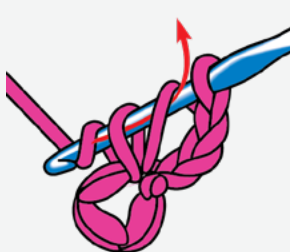
Double crochet

Yoh and insert hook into ring.

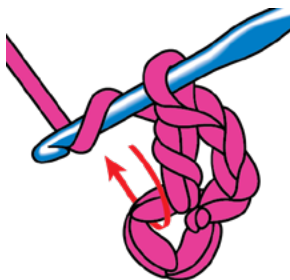


Yoh and draw through first 2 loops on hook.

Yoh and draw through remaining (rem) 2 loops on hook – 1 double crochet made.



Rep last steps once more – 2 dc made.

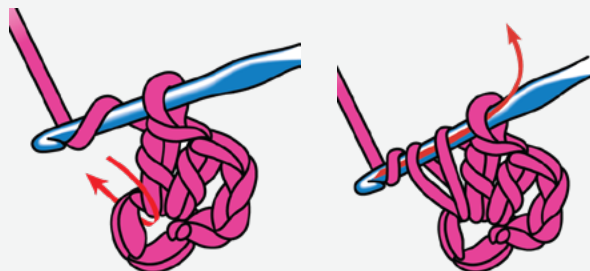
INSTRUCTIONS

3 half double crochet (hdc) in ring.

Half double crochet (1 hdc)

Yoh and insert hook into ring (st).

Yoh and draw through all 3 loops on the hook in one movement.



Rep last steps twice more –

3 half double crochet (hdc) made.

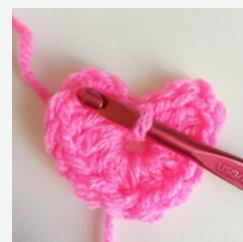
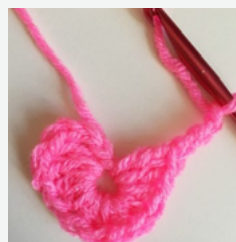
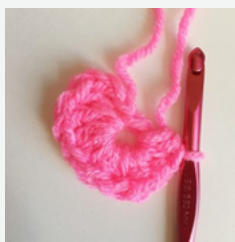


1 dc in ring.

3 hdc in ring.

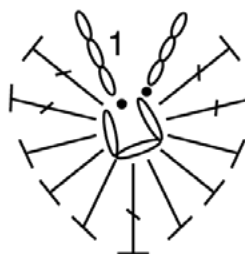
2 dc in ring. Ch 3.

Sl st in ring.



STITCH KEY

- = chain (ch)
- = slip stitch (sl st)
- ┐ = half double crochet (hdc)
- ┘ = double crochet (dc)

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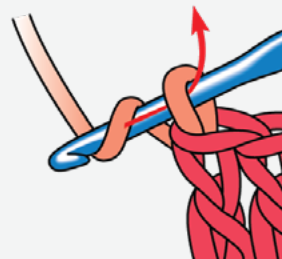

INSTRUCTIONS

Fasten off and cut yarn.

To permanently fasten off the yarn, cut the yarn leaving a long tail. Pull end of yarn through loop on the hook and pull gently to tighten.



Tie the beginning and end tails together (tog) on back of Heart.

Weave in all yarn tails.
