## What you will need:

**RED HEART® Team Spirit™:** 1 skein 947 Royal/White

**Susan Bates® Crochet Hook:** 6mm [US J-10]

13" [33 cm] x 13" [33 cm] foam stadium seat, stitch holder or safety pin, yarn needle

**GAUGE:** 12 sc = 4" [10 cm]; 12 rows = 4" [10 cm] in single crochet. **CHECK YOUR GAUGE.** Use any size hook to obtain the gauge.

# Crochet Stadium Seat Cover

*Crochet a cover for a purchased seat cushion and enjoy comfort at your next sporting event. It's the perfect gift for any sports fan!*

SHOP KIT

**Sized to fit a 13" [33 cm] x 13" [33 cm] foam sporting seat, available at most sporting goods stores**

## SPECIAL ABBREVIATIONS

**sc2tog:** [Draw up a loop in next st] twice, yarn over and draw through all 3 loops on hook.

## SEAT COVER (Make 2)

Ch 32.

**Row 1:** Sc in 2nd ch from hook and each ch across – 31 sts.

**Rows 2-5:** Ch 1, turn, 2 sc in first sc, sc in each sc to last sc, 2 sc in last sc – 39 sc on last row worked.

**Rows 5-24:** Ch 1, turn, sc in each sc across.

**Row 25:** Ch 1, turn, sc2tog, sc in each sc to last 2 sc, sc 2tog – 37 sc.

**Rows 26-32:** Ch 1, turn, sc in each sc across.

**Row 33:** Ch 1, turn, sc2tog, sc in each sc to last 2 sc, sc2tog – 35 sc.

**Rows 34-35:** Ch 1, turn, sc in each sc across.

## Shape First Side

**Row 36 (Right Side):** Ch 1, turn, sc2tog, sc in next 10 sc, leave remaining sts unworked – 11 sc.

**Row 37:** Ch 1, turn, sc in next 9 sc, sc2tog – 10 sc.

**Row 38:** Ch 1, turn, sc2tog, sc in next 8 sc – 9 sc.

**Row 39:** Ch 1, turn, sc in next 7 sc, sc2tog – 8 sc.

Cut yarn, placing last loop of st on a stitch holder or safety pin to be picked up on Joining Row.

## Shape Second side

**Row 36 (Right Side):** Skip next 11 unworked sc on Row 35, join yarn with ch 1 in next sc, sc in same sc, sc in 10 sc, sc2tog – 11 sc.

**Row 37:** Ch 1, turn, sc2tog, sc in next 9 sc – 10 sc.

**Row 38:** Ch 1, turn, sc in next 8 sc, sc2tog – 9 sc.

**Row 39:** Ch 1, turn, sc2tog, sc in next 7 sc – 8 sc. Fasten off.

**Joining Row 40 (Right Side):** With right side facing, join yarn in st on stitch holder or safety pin on First Side, ch 1, turn, sc2tog, sc across next 6 sc, ch 11, working across sts of Second Side, sc in next 6 sc, sc2tog.

**Row 41:** Ch 1, turn, sc2tog, sc in next 5 sc, sc in next 11 ch, sc in next 5 sc, sc2tog – 23 sc.

**Row 42:** Ch 1, turn, sc in each sc across.

**Row 43:** Ch 1, turn, sc2tog, sc in each sc to last 2 sts, sc2tog – 21 sc.

**Row 44:** Ch 1, turn, sc2tog, sc in each sc to last 2 sts, sc2tog – 19 sc. Fasten off.

## Outside Edging

**Round 1:** With right side facing and working along opposite edge of foundation ch, join yarn in last ch of Row 1, sc in same ch, sc in next 30 ch, turn to work alongside edge, work 44 sc evenly spaced alongside edge, turn to work along top edge, sc across next 19 sc, turn to work along opposite side edge and work 44 sc evenly spaced along edge to first sc, slip st in first sc to join – 138 sc.

**Round 2:** Ch 1, turn, sc in each sc around, slip st in first sc.

Fasten off, leaving a long tail for sewing.

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### Handle Lining

**Round 1:** With right side facing, join yarn in first skipped sc of Row 35 with ch 1, sc in same sc, sc in next 10 sc, turn to work alongside edge of Second Side, work 6 sc evenly spaced alongside edge, turn to work opposite edge of ch-11, sc in each ch of ch-11, turn to work along side edge of First Side, work 6 sc evenly spaced along side edge, slip st in first sc to join – 34 sc.

**Round 2:** Ch 1, turn, sc in each sc around, slip st in first sc.  
Fasten off, leaving a long tail for sewing.

### FINISHING

With wrong sides together, sew Seat Covers together alongside and bottom edges, leaving space to insert foam seat. Insert foam seat. Sew remaining sides and top closed. Overlap Handle pieces and sew closed.

Weave in ends.

### Abbreviations

**ch** = chain; **cm** = centimeters; **mm** = millimeters; **sc** = single crochet; **st(s)** = stitch(es); **tog** = together.
