## COZY COUNTRY AFGHAN Intermediate Skill Level

Afghan measures approximately 51" x 64".

**RED HEART®** "Light & Lofty®", Art E708, (6 oz /140 yard solid and 4.5 oz / 105 yard multi) skeins: 3 skeins No. 9632 Pine **CA**, 6 skeins No. 9380 Antique Blue **CB**, and 6 skeins No. 9330 Cape Cod **CC**.

**Crochet Hook:** 8 mm [US L-11]. Yarn Needle.

**GAUGE:** 7 sts = 4"; 5 rows = 4".

CHECK YOUR GAUGE. Use any size hook to obtain the gauge.

AFGHAN: With CB, ch 104.

Row 1 (Right Side): (Dc, ch 2, 2 dc) all in 4<sup>th</sup> ch from hook, \* skip next 3 ch, (2 dc, ch 2, 2 dc) in next ch – shell made; rep from \* across, DO NOT TURN. Fasten off CB.

**Row 2:** With right side facing, join **CA** at beg of Row 1 in ch-2 sp of first shell, ch 1, \* (2 sc, ch 2, 2 sc) all in ch-2 sp of shell; rep from \* across, DO NOT TURN. Fasten off **CA**.

Row 3: With right side facing, join CC at beg of Row 2 in ch-2 sp of first shell, ch 1, 2 sc in same ch-2 sp, \* tr in next corresponding sp between shell and next shell 2 rows below, pulling tr up to current level of work, 2 sc in ch-2 sp of next shell; rep from \* across. DO NOT TURN. Fasten off CC.

**Row 4:** With right side facing, join **CB** in 2<sup>nd</sup> sc, ch 3 (first dc) (dc, ch 2, 2 dc) in same sc, \* skip next tr and sc, shell in next sc; rep from \*across. DO NOT TURN. Fasten off **CB**.

Row 5: Rep Row 2.

Row 6: Rep Row 3.

**Rows 7-75:** Rep Rows 4-6 until a total of 75 rows are completed, DO NOT TURN. Fasten off

**BORDER:** With right side facing, join CC in top right-hand corner sc.

Rnd 1: Ch 3 (first dc) 2 dc in same sc, dc in each st across, 3 dc in last st, turn, working down side of afghan, 3 dc in first sc row-end, \* 2 dc over each row-end of next 2 dc rows, skip next sc row; rep from \* to within last 2 rows, 2 dc in row-end st of next row, 3 dc in next sc row end, working across bottom of foundation ch, 3 dc in first ch, dc in each ch across to within last ch, 3 dc in last ch, working up side of afghan, 3 dc in row-end st of first dc Row, 2 dc in next row-end st of next dc row, skip next sc; rep from \* to within last 2 rows, 2 dc in row-end st of next dc row, 3 dc in row-end st of last row; join with sl st to top of beg ch 3.

Rnd 2: Ch 3 (first dc), dc in next dc, (ch 3, sl st) in top of last dc made, \* dc in each of next 2 dc, (ch 3, sl st) in top of last dc made; rep from \* around to last dc, dc in last dc, join with sl st to top of beg ch 3. Fasten off. Weave in ends.
