



Post Stitch Throw

Designed by Bendy Carter.

Throw measures 53²/₃" x 64".

Red Heart® "Super Saver®": 10 skeins 316 Soft White

Crochet Hook: 5.5mm [US I-9]
Yarn needle.

GAUGE: Square = 10¹/₂". **CHECK YOUR GAUGE. Use any size hook to obtain the gauge.**

SPECIAL ABBREVIATIONS:

Fptr (front post treble crochet) = Yo twice, insert hook from the front side of the work to back to front again around the post of the indicated st, yo and draw up a loop (4 loops now on hook), yo and draw through two loops (3 loops now on hook) yo and draw through two loops (2 loops now on hook) yo and draw through two loops (1 loop on hook)

Fpdtr (front post double treble crochet) = Yarn over hook three times, then insert hook front to back and front again around indicated stitch. Yarn over hook and draw yarn through stitch (there are five loops on the hook). Yo, draw through two loops (there are now four loops remaining on the hook). yo, draw through two loops (there are now three loops remaining on the hook). Yo, draw through two loops (there are now two loops remaining on the hook). Yo, draw through the last two loops on the hook. One loop remains.

Fptrtr (front post treble (triple) treble crochet) = Yo four times, then insert hook front to back and front again around indicated stitch. Yarn over hook and draw yarn through stitch (there are six loops on the hook). Yo, draw through two loops (there are now five loops remaining on the hook). yo, draw through two loops (there are now four loops remaining on the hook). Yo, draw through two loops (there are now three loops remaining on the hook). Yo, draw through two loops (there are now two loops remaining on the hook). Yo, draw through the last two loops on the hook. One loop remains.

Lfpdtr (left front post double treble) = Fpdtr around post of st 2 rows below and 2 sts to the left.

Rfpdtr (right front post double treble) = Fpdtr around post of st 2 rows below and 2 sts to the right.

Fptrtr cross (front post treble treble cross) = Skip next 3 sts, [fptrtr around next st] 2 times, sc, with hook in front of post sts just made, fptrtr around first skipped st, fptrtr around next skipped st.

Note: All post stitches are worked around post of stitch 2 rows below. Always skip stitches behind post stitches.

THROW

SQUARE (make 30)

Ch 4, join with slip st to form ring.

Round 1: Ch 1, [sc, ch 2] 4 times, join in beginning sc, turn.



Round 2: Slip st in ch-2 space, ch 1, sc in same space, [sc in next sc, (sc, ch 2, sc) in ch-2 space] 3 times, sc in next sc, sc in ch-2 space, ch 2, join in beginning sc, turn.

Round 3: Slip st in ch-2 space, ch 1, sc in same space, [sc in each st across, (sc, ch 2, sc) in ch-2 space] 3 times, sc in each st across, sc in ch-2 space, ch 2, join in beginning sc, turn.

Rounds 4 – 6: Repeat Round 3.

Round 7: Slip st in ch-2 space, ch 1, sc in same space, [*work 3 sc, 2 Rfpdtr, 1 sc, 2 Lfpdtr, 3 sc*, (sc, ch 2, sc) in ch-2 space] 3 times; repeat from * to * 1 time, sc in ch-2 space, ch 2, join in beginning sc, turn.

Round 8 and all even Rounds: Repeat Round 3.

Round 9: Slip st in ch-2 space, ch 1, sc in same space, [*work 5 sc, fptrtr cross, 5 sc*, (sc, ch 2, sc) in ch-2 space] 3 times; repeat from * to * 1 time, sc in ch-2 space, ch 2, join in beginning sc, turn.

Round 11: Slip st in ch-2 space, ch 1, sc in same space, [*work 7 sc, 2 fptr, 1 sc, 2 fptr, 7 sc*, (sc, ch 2, sc) in ch-2 space] 3 times; repeat from * to * 1 time, sc in ch-2 space, ch 2, join in beginning sc, turn.

Round 13: Slip st in ch-2 space, ch 1, sc in same space, [*work 3 sc, 2 Rfpdtr, 4 sc, fptrtr cross, 4 sc, 2 Lfpdtr, 3 sc*, (sc, ch 2, sc) in ch-2 space] 3 times; repeat from * to * 1 time, sc in ch-2 space, ch 2, join in beginning sc, turn.

Round 15: Slip st in ch-2 space, ch 1, sc in same space, [*work 5 sc, 2 fptr, 2 sc, 2 Lfpdtr, 5 sc, 2 Rfpdtr, 2 sc, 2 fptr, 5 sc*, (sc, ch 2, sc) in ch-2 space] 3 times; repeat from * to * 1 time, sc in ch-2 space, ch 2, join in beginning sc, turn.
Fasten off after Round 15, leaving long tail for sewing.

Arrange squares 5 across and 6 down. Sew together.

BORDER

Round 1: Join yarn in ch-2 corner space, ch 1, sc in same space as joining, [*work a multiple of 4 sc across side*, (sc, ch 2, sc) in ch-2 corner space] 3 times; repeat from * to * 1 time, sc in ch-2 corner space, ch 2, join in beginning sc; turn.

Round 2: Repeat Round 3 of Square.

Round 3: Slip st in ch-2 space, ch 1, sc in same space, [*sc, **2 fptr, 2 sc; repeat from ** across to last 3 sts, 2 fptr, sc*, (sc, ch 2, sc) in ch-2 space] 3 times; repeat from * to * 1 time, sc in ch-2 space, ch 2, join in beginning sc. Fasten off. Weave in ends.
