## What you will need:

RED HEART ${ }^{\text {T }}$ Soft $^{\circledR}$ : 3 balls 9010 Charcoal A, 2 balls each 9274 Biscuit B and 4360 Cocoa C

Susan Bates ${ }^{\star}$ Crochet Hook: 6 mm [US J-10] and 5mm [US $\mathrm{H}-8]$

GAUGE: $12 \mathrm{dc}=4^{\prime \prime}$ [10 cm]; 7 rows $=4^{\prime \prime}[10 \mathrm{~cm}]$ in double crochet using larger hook. CHECK YOUR GAUGE. Use any size hook to obtain the gauge.

RED HEART ${ }^{*}$ Soft ${ }^{\text {® }}$ Art E728 available in solid color 5 oz (141 g), 256 yd (234 m); multicolor 4 oz (113 g), 204 yd ( 187 m ); and heathers 4 oz $(113 \mathrm{~g}), 212 \mathrm{yd}(194 \mathrm{~m})$ balls


## Menswear Throw

Looking for a throw to make your guy that he will appreciate more than a sweater, this is it! Choose a trio of his favorite shades and you'll find your way into his heart through his warm toes.

Finished Throw measures 48" [122 cm] x 62" [157 cm].

## THROW

With B and larger hook, ch 131.
Row 1 (Right Side): Sc in second ch from hook, dc in next ch, [sc in next ch, dc in next ch] across - 130 sts.
Row 2: Ch 1, turn, sc in first st, dc in next st, [sc in next st, dc in next st] across. Rows 3-10: Change to A, ch 3 (counts as first dc here and throughout), turn, dc in each st across.
Rows 11-12: Change to B, repeat Row 2
Rows 13-14: Change to C, ch 3 , turn, dc in each st across.
Rows 15-16: Change to B, repeat Row 2. Rows 17-24: Change to A, ch 3, turn, dc in each st across.
Rows 25-26: Change to B, repeat Row 2 .
Rows 27-30: Change to C, ch 3, turn, dc in each st across.
Rows 31-32: Change to B, repeat Row 2.
Rows 33-40: Change to A, ch 3, turn, dc in each st across.
Rows 41-42: Change to B, repeat Row 2.
Rows 43-44: Change to A, ch 3, turn, dc in each st across.
Rows 45-46: Change to B, repeat Row 2.
Rows 47-54: Change to A, ch 3, turn, dc in each st across.
Rows 55-56: Change to B, repeat Row 2.
Rows 57-60: Change to C, ch 3, turn, dc in each st across.
Rows 61-62: Change to B, repeat Row 2.
Repeat Rows 3-56. Fasten off.

## Border

Round 1: With right side facing ready to work along last row and smaller hook, join C in first st with a slip st, ch 1, work 3 sc in first st, sc in each st across to last st, 3 sc in last st, turn to work along side edge, sc evenly along side edge, turn to
work along opposite edge of foundation ch, 3 sc in first st, sc in each st to last st, 3 sc in last st, turn to work along opposite side edge, sc evenly along side edge to first st, slip st in first st.

Rounds 2-5: Ch 1, sc in each sc around working 3 sc in center sc in each corner 3 -sc, slip st in first sc. Fasten off.

## FINISHING

Weave in ends.
