What you will need:

RED HEART* With Love*: 2 skeins each 1308 Tan A and 1970 Taupe B, 1 skein each 1207 Cornsilk C, 1201 Daffodil D, 1252 Mango E, 1939 Papaya F, 1701 Hot Pink G, and 1704 Bubblegum H

Susan Bates® Crochet Hook: 10mm [US N-15]

Yarn needle

GAUGE: 9½ sc = 4" [10 cm]; 10 rows = 4½" [11 cm] in single crochet holding two strands of yarn together. CHECK YOUR GAUGE. Use any size hook to obtain the gauge.

color 7oz (198 g), 370 yd (338 m), multicolor 5oz (141 g), 230 yd (211 m) and stripes 5 oz (141 g), 223 yd (204 m) skeins

SHOP KIT



Bright Stripes Reversible Throw

Crocheting this throw with two strands of yarn, gives it a nice weight, adds color interest and speeds your crocheting along. This throw has the bonus of looking the same on both sides making it reversible! Finished Throw measures 45" [114 cm] x 54" [137 cm].

NOTES

Throw is reversible.

Throw is worked with two strands of yarn held together throughout.

THROW

With one strand each of $\bf C$ and $\bf D$ held together, ch 93.

Row 1: Sc in 3rd ch from hook (2 skipped ch count as first ch-1 space), [ch 1, skip next ch, sc in next ch] 45 times – 91 sts.

Row 2: Ch 2 (counts as first ch-1 space here and throughout), turn, [sc in ch-1 space, ch 1, skip next st] 45 times, sc in last ch-1 space of row – 91 sts.

Rows 3-4: Repeat Row 2.

Rows 5-6: With two strands of **C**, repeat Row 2.

Rows 7-10: With one strand of **C** and **D** held together, repeat Row 2.

Rows 11-14: With one strand of **E** and **F** held togeth-er, repeat Row 2.

Rows 15-16: With two strands of **E**, repeat Row 2.

Rows 17-20: With one strand of **E** and **F** held togeth-er, repeat Row 2.

Rows 21-24: With one strand of **G** and **H** held togeth-er, repeat Row 2.

Rows 25-26: With two strands of **G**, repeat Row 2.

Rows 27-30: With one strand of **G** and **H** held togeth-er, repeat Row 2.

Rows 31-34: With one strand of **F** and **H** held togeth-er, repeat Row 2.

Rows 35-36: With two strands of **F**, repeat Row 2.

Rows 37-40: With one strand of **F** and **H** held togeth-er, repeat Row 2.

Rows 41-44: With one strand of **A** and **B** held togeth-er, repeat Row 2.

Rows 45-46: With two strands of **B**, repeat Row 2.

Rows 47-50: With one strand of **A** and **B** held togeth-er, repeat Row 2.

Row 51-52: With one strand of C and D held together, repeat Row 2.

Rows 53-102: Repeat Rows 3-52. **Rows 103-120:** Repeat Rows 3-20.

Fasten off.

Border

Round 1: With one strand of A and B held together, join yarn in first ch-1 space of Row 120 with a slip st, ch 1 (does not count as a st here and throughout), [sc in next ch-1 space, ch 1, skip next st] across row, (sc, ch 1, sc) all in last ch-1 space, turn to work along side edge, [ch 1, skip next sc along end of row, sc in next row] along side edge, turn to work along opposite edge of foundation ch, ch 1, (sc, ch 1, sc) all in first ch-1 space, [ch 1, skip next st, sc in next ch1 across row to last ch-1 space. ch 1, (sc, ch 1, sc) all in last ch-1 space, turn to work along opposite side edge, [ch 1, skip next row, sc in next row] along side edge, turn to work along beginning edge, ch 1, (sc, ch 1, sc) all in first ch-1 space, slip st in first sc.

Rounds 2-4: Slip st to first ch-1 space, ch 1, (sc in next ch-1 space, ch 1, skip next st) in each ch-1 space around, working (sc, ch 1, sc) in each corner ch-1 space.

Rounds 5-6: With two strands of **B**, repeat Round 2.

Rounds 7-10: With one strand of **A** and **B** held to-gether, repeat Round 2. Fasten off.

FINISHING

Weave in ends.

ABBREVIATIONS

A, B, C = Color A, B, C; ch = chain; cm = centimeters; mm = millimeters; sc = single cro-chet; st(s) = stitch(es); [] = work directions in brackets the number of times specified; () = work directions in parenthesis the number of times specified.
