## What you will need:

**RED HEART® With Love®:** 8 (12) skeins 1562 Jadeite **A**, and 1 skein each of 1201 Daffodil **B**, 1970 Taupe **C**, 1207 Cornsilk **D**, 1101 Eggshell **E**, 1012 Black **F**, 1909 Holly Berry **G**, and 1502 Iced Aqua **H**.

**Note:** Only a small amount of each yarn color **B-H** is needed.

**Susan Bates® Crochet Hook:** 8mm [US L-11] (for snug sack), and 4mm [US G-6] and 3.75mm [US F-5] (for emojis).

3" [7.5 cm] pompom maker, pins (optional), yarn needle.

**GAUGE:** 8 sts = about 4" [10 cm]; 5½ rows = 4" [10 cm] in snug sack pattern, using larger hook with 2 strands of yarn held together. **CHECK YOUR GAUGE. Use any size hook to obtain the gauge.**



**RED HEART® With Love®**, Art. E400 available in solid color 7oz (198 g), 370 yd (338 m), multicolor 5oz (141 g), 230 yd (211 m) and stripes 5 oz (141 g) 223 yds (204 m) skeins

# Emoji Snuggly Sack

Keep your kiddos warm while watching television or while sleeping overnight on the sofa with this fun pocket-style cozy.

This crocheted sack features popular emojis including smiley face, heart eyes, tongue out, tears of joy, kiss, smiling poop and thumbs up.

**Directions are for Child size; changes for Adult size are in parentheses.**

### Finished Measurements

**Child Size:** About 27 x 46" [68.5 x 117 cm].

**Adult Size:** About 32 x 58" [81.5 x 147.5 cm].

### Notes

1. Snug sack is made in one piece, worked back and forth in rows, beginning at top edge. Two strands of yarn held together for maximum coziness and fast completion.
2. Emojis are worked separately, using a single strand of yarn, and sewn to front of snug sack. Use photograph as guide for placement when sewing emojis to sack.

### Special Stitches

**dtr (double treble crochet)** = [Yarn over] 3 times, insert hook in indicated stitch, yarn over and draw up a loop, [yarn over and draw through 2 loops on hook] 4 times.

**sc2tog (single crochet 2 stitches together)** = [Insert hook in next stitch, yarn over and pull up a loop] twice, yarn over and draw through all 3 loops on hook.

## SNUG SACK

### Top Ribbing

With larger hook and 2 strands of **A** held together, ch 9.

**Row 1:** Sc in 2nd ch from hook and in each remaining ch across – 8 sc.

**Rows 2-105 (127):** Ch 1, turn, working in back loops only, sc in each sc across. Do not fasten off.

Body

**Row 1:** Ch 1, do not turn, working along side edge, sc in end of each row across—105 (127) sc.

**Row 2:** Ch 1, turn, hdc in each st across.

**Row 3:** Ch 1, turn, dc in each st across.

**Rows 4-61 (77):** Repeat Rows 2 and 3 for a total of 61 (77) rows in body. Fasten off, leaving a very long tail for seaming.

With yarn tail, sew side edges of piece together.

### Seam Lower Edge:

Place sack on flat surface with long seam running down center of back of sack. If desired, pin lower edges together before seaming.

With larger hook and 2 strands of **A** held together, working along opposite side of foundation and through both thicknesses of lower edge, join yarn with slip st in first st, ch 1, sc in same st, and in each st across. Fasten off.



## SMILEY EMOJI

### Head

With middle size hook and **B**, ch 2.

**Round 1:** Work 6 hdc in 2nd ch from hook; join with slip st in first hdc—6 hdc.

continued...



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**Note:** Work first st of all following rounds in same st as joining.

**Round 2:** Ch 1, 2 hdc in each st around, hdc in space between last st and beginning ch-1; join with slip st in first hdc—13 hdc.

**Round 3:** Ch 1, [hdc in next st, 2 hdc in next st] 6 times, hdc in last st; join with slip st in first hdc—19 hdc.

**Round 4:** Ch 1, [2 hdc in next st, hdc in next 2 sts] 6 times, 2 hdc in last st; join with slip st in first hdc—26 hdc.

**Round 5:** Ch 1, [hdc in next st, 2 hdc in next st, hdc in next 2 sts] 6 times, hdc in last 2 sts; join with slip st in first hdc—32 hdc.

**Round 6:** Ch 1, [hdc in next 2 sts, 2 hdc in next st, hdc in next 2 sts] 6 times, hdc in last 2 sts; join with slip st in first hdc—38 hdc.

**Round 7:** Ch 1, [2 hdc in next st, hdc in next 5 sts] 6 times, hdc in last 2 sts; join with slip st in first hdc—44 hdc.

**Round 8:** Ch 1, [hdc in next 3 sts, 2 hdc in next st, hdc in next 3 sts] 6 times, hdc in last 2 sts; join with slip st in first hdc—50 hdc.

**Round 9:** Ch 1, hdc in next 2 sts, [hdc in next 3 sts, 2 hdc in next st, hdc in next 4 sts] 6 times; join with slip st in first hdc—56 hdc.

Fasten off, leaving a long tail for sewing.

### Eyes (make 2)

With smallest hook and **F**, ch 2.

**Row 1:** Work 6 hdc in 2nd ch from hook; join with slip st in first hdc.

Fasten off, leaving a long tail for sewing.

### Smile

With smallest hook and **F**, ch 25.

**Row 1:** Working in back bumps only, slip st in 2nd ch from hook, sc in next 22 ch, slip st in last ch.

Fasten off, leaving a long tail for sewing.

Using photograph as a guide, sew eyes to head. Curve smile and sew to head.



## HEART EYES EMOJI

### Head

Make same as Smiley Emoji head.

### Eyes (make 2)

With middle size hook and **G**, ch 4, (2 dtr, 2 dc, ch 1, 2 dc, 2 dtr, ch 3, slip st) in 4th ch from hook.

Fasten off, leaving a long tail for sewing.

### Smile

With smallest hook and **F**, ch 2.

**Row 1:** Sc in 2nd ch from hook—1 sc.

**Row 2:** Ch 1, turn, 2 sc in sc—2 sc.

**Row 3:** Ch 1, turn, sc in first st, 2 sc in last st—3 sc.

**Rows 4-11:** Ch 1, turn, sc in each st across.

**Row 12:** Ch 1, turn, sc in first st, skip next st, sc in last st—2 sc.

**Row 13:** Ch 1, turn, sc2tog—1 sc.

Fasten off, leaving a long tail for sewing.

Using photograph as a guide, sew eyes and smile to head.



## TONGUE OUT EMOJI

### Head

Make same as Smiley Emoji head.

### Eyes (make 2)

With smallest hook and **F**, ch 10.

**Row 1:** Working in back bumps only, slip st in 2nd ch from hook and in next 3 ch, skip next ch, slip st in last 4 ch.

Fasten off, leaving a long tail for sewing.

### Mouth

With smallest hook and **F**, ch 2.

**Row 1:** Sc in 2nd ch from hook—1 sc.

**Row 2:** Ch 1, turn, 2 sc in sc—2 sc.

**Row 3:** Ch 1, turn, sc in first st, 2 sc in last st—3 sc.

**Row 4:** Ch 1, turn, sc in first st, 2 sc in next st, sc in last st—4 sc.

**Row 5:** Ch 1, turn, sc in first st, 2 sc in each of next 2 sts, sc in last st—6 sc.

**Rows 6-11:** Ch 1, turn, sc in each st across.

**Row 12:** Ch 1, turn, sc in first st, [sc2tog] twice, sc in last st—4 sc.

**Row 13:** Ch 1, turn, sc in first st, sc2tog, sc in last st—3 sc.

**Row 14:** Ch 1, turn, sc2tog, sc in last st—2 sc.

**Row 15:** Ch 1, turn, sc2tog—1 sc.

Fasten off, leaving a long tail for sewing.

### Tongue

With smallest hook and **G**, ch 4.

**Row 1:** Work 2 sc in 2nd ch from hook, sc in next ch, 2 sc in last ch—5 sc.

**Row 2:** Ch 1, turn, [2 sc in next st, sc in next st] twice, sc in last st—7 sc.

**Row 3:** Ch 1, do not turn, work a total of 7 sc evenly spaced along row ends and opposite side of foundation—7 sc.

**Rows 4 and 5:** Ch 1, turn, sc in each st across.

Fasten off, leaving a long tail for sewing.

Using photograph as a guide, bend eyes into an angle and sew to head. Sew last row of tongue to center of mouth. Sew mouth to head, below eyes. Sew lower part of tongue to head.



## TEARS OF JOY EMOJI

### Head

Make same as Smiley Emoji head.

### Eyes (make 2)

With smallest hook and **F**, ch 9.

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**Row 1:** Slip st in 2nd ch from hook, sc in next 6 ch, slip st in last ch.  
Fasten off, leaving a long tail for sewing.

### Eyebrows (make 2)

With smallest hook and **F**, ch 8.  
Fasten off, leaving a long tail for sewing.

### Tears (make 2)

With middle size hook and **H**, ch 2.  
**Row 1:** Sc in 2nd ch from hook—1 sc.  
**Row 2:** Ch 1, turn, 2 sc in sc—2 sc.  
**Row 3:** Ch 1, turn, sc in first st, 2 sc in last st—3 sc.  
**Row 4:** Ch 1, turn, 2 sc in first st, sc in next st, 2 sc in last st—5 sc.  
**Row 5:** Ch 1, turn, skip first 2 sts, 5 dc in next st, skip next st, slip st in last st—5 dc and 1 slip st.  
**Row 6 (Edging):** Do not turn, sc in end of Row 4 and end of next 3 rows, ch 1 at tip of tear, sc in end of each of first 4 rows, slip st in first dc of Row 5.  
Fasten off, leaving a long tail for sewing.

### Mouth

Make same as heart eyes emoji mouth.

### Teeth

With smallest hook and **E**, ch 15.  
**Row 1:** Working in back bumps only, slip st in 2nd ch from hook, sc in next 12 ch, slip st in last ch.  
Fasten off, leaving a long tail for sewing.

Using photograph as a guide, sew teeth to upper edge of mouth. Sew mouth to head. Curve eyes and sew to head. Curve eyebrows and sew to head, above eyes. Sew tips of tears to outer corner of eyes, continue to sew to head with slight overlap with corners of mouth.



## KISS

### Upper Lip

With middle size hook and **G**, ch 17.  
**Row 1 (right side):** Working in back bumps only, sc in 2nd ch from hook and next ch, hdc in next 2 ch, dc in next 8 ch, hdc in next 2 ch, sc in last 2 ch—16 sts.  
**Row 2:** Ch 1, turn, slip st in first st, sc in next 2 sts, dc in next 10 sts, sc in next 2 sts, slip st in last st.  
**Row 3:** Ch 1, turn, slip st in first 2 sts, sc in next st, hdc in next st, dc in next st, 2 dc in next st, hdc in next st, sc in next 2 sts, hdc in next st, 2 dc in next st, dc in next st, hdc in next st, sc in next st, slip st in last 2 sts—18 sts.  
Do not fasten off.  
Lower Lip  
**Row 4:** Do not turn, work 2 sc in side edge of upper lip, slip st in corner of lower edge of upper lip, ch 16, slip st in opposite corner of lower edge of upper lip, work 2 sc in side edge of upper lip, slip st in first st of Row 3.  
Fasten off.  
**Row 5 (right side):** With right side of piece facing and upper lip at bottom, draw up a loop of **G** in first ch of lower

lip, ch 1, slip st in same ch as joining and in each remaining 15 ch—16 slip sts.

**Row 6:** Ch 1, turn, skip first st, sc in next 15 sts, slip st in beginning ch—16 sts.

**Row 7:** Ch 1, turn, skip the slip st, slip st in first sc, sc in next st, hdc in next st, 2 hdc in next st, [dc in next st, 2 dc in next st] 3 times, dc in next st, 2 hdc in next st, hdc in next st, sc in next st, slip st in last st—20 sts.

**Row 8:** Ch 1, turn, slip st in first 6 sts, sc in next st, hdc in next st, [dc in next st, 2 dc in next st] twice, hdc in next st, sc in next st, slip st in next 6 sts, slip st in beginning ch—23 sts.

Fasten off, leaving a long tail for sewing.



## SMILING POOP (make 2)

### Poop

With middle size hook and **C**, ch 2. **Row 1:** Hdc in 2nd ch from hook—1 hdc. **Row 2:** Ch 1, turn, 2 hdc in st—2 hdc. **Row 3:** Ch 1, tur, 2 hdc in each st across—4 hdc. **Row 4:** Ch 1, turn, [2 hdc in next st, hdc in next st] twice—6 hdc. **Row 5:** Ch 1, turn, 3 dc in first st, hdc in next 4 sts, 3 dc in last st—10 sts.

**Row 6:** Ch 1, turn, skip first st, 3 dc in next st, hdc in next 6 sts, 3 dc next st; leave last st unworked—12 sts.

**Row 7:** Ch 1, turn, skip first st, 3 hdc in next st, 2 dc in next st, dc in next 6 sts, 2 dc in next st, 3 hdc in next st; leave last st unworked—16 sts.

**Row 8:** Ch 1, turn, skip first st, slip st in next 2 sts, 5 dc in next st, dc in next 7 sts, 5 dc in next st, slip st in next 2 sts; leave remaining sts unworked—21 sts.

**Row 9:** Ch 1, turn, skip first st, sc in first 2 sts, 4 hdc in next st, hdc in next 13 sts, 4 hdc in next st, sc in next st; leave remaining sts unworked—24 sts.

**Row 10:** Ch 1, turn, skip first st, slip st in next 2 sts, (hdc, 3 dc) in next st, 2 dc in next st, dc in next 13 sts, 2 dc in next 2 sts, (3 dc, hdc) in next st, slip st in next 2 sts; leave remaining sts unworked—29 sts.

**Row 11:** Ch 1, turn, skip first st, slip st in next 4 sts, 5 dc in next st, dc in next 15 sts, 5 dc in next st, slip st in next st; leave remaining sts unworked—30 sts.

**Row 12:** Ch 1, turn, slip st in first 4 sts, (slip st, dc) in next st, 4 dc in next st, dc in next 13 sts, 4 dc in next st, (dc, slip st) in next st; leave remaining sts unworked—29 sts.

**Edging:** Ch 1, do not turn, work sc sts evenly around entire outer edge of piece; join with slip st in first sc.  
Fasten off, leaving a long tail for sewing.

## Eye Whites (make 2)

With smallest hook and **E**, ch 5.  
**Row 1:** Work 3 hdc in 2nd ch from hook, hdc in next 2 ch, 4 hdc in last ch; working along opposite side of foundation ch, hdc in next 2 ch, hdc in last ch; join with slip st in first hdc—12 hdc.

continued...

Fasten off, leaving a long tail for sewing.

### Pupils (make 2)

With smallest hook and **F**, ch 3.

**Row 1:** Work 3 sc in 2nd ch from hook, (3 sc, slip st) in last ch.

Fasten off, leaving a long tail for sewing. Sew one pupil to the center of each eye.

### Smile

With smallest hook and **E**, make same as Heart Emoji smile.

Using photograph as a guide, sew eyes and smile to poop.



### THUMBS UP (make 2)

With middle size hook and **D**, ch 11.

#### Wrist and Palm

**Row 1 (right side):** Working in back bumps only, sc in 2nd ch from hook and in each remaining ch across—10 sc.

**Rows 2-5:** Ch 1, turn, sc in each st across.

**Row 6:** Ch 1, turn, 2 sc in first st, sc in each st to last st, 2 sc in last st—12 sc.

**Row 7:** Ch 1, turn, sc in first st, 2 sc in next st, [sc in next 2 sts, 2 sc in next st] 3 times, sc in last st—16 sc.

**Rows 8-12:** Ch 1, turn, sc in each st across.

**Row 13:** Ch 1, turn, skip first st, sc in next 15 sts—15 sc.

**Rows 14-18:** Ch 1, turn, sc in each st across.

Index Finger

**Row 1 (right side):** Ch 1, turn, sc in first 3 sts; leave remaining sts unworked for other 3 fingers.

**Rows 2-9:** Ch 1, turn, sc in each st across.

**Row 10:** Ch 1, turn, skip first st, sc in next st, slip st in last st.

Fasten off, leaving a long tail for sewing. Middle Finger

**Row 1 (right side):** With right side facing, skip first unworked st of last row of palm following index finger, join **D** with slip st in next st, ch 1, sc in same st and in next 2 sts; leave remaining sts unworked for other 2 fingers—3 sc.

**Rows 2-12:** Ch 1, turn, sc in each st across.

**Row 13:** Ch 1, turn, skip first st, sc in next st, slip st in last st.

Fasten off, leaving a long tail for sewing. Ring Finger

**Row 1 (right side):** With right side facing, skip first unworked st of last row of palm following middle finger, join **D** with slip st in next st, ch 1, sc in same st and in next 2 sts; leave remaining sts unworked for pinky finger—3 sc.

**Rows 2-10:** Ch 1, turn, sc in each st across.

**Row 11:** Ch 1, turn, skip first st, sc in next st, slip st in last st.

Fasten off, leaving a long tail for sewing. Pinky Finger

**Row 1 (right side):** With right side facing, skip first unworked st of last row of palm following middle finger, join **D** with slip st in next st, ch 1, sc in same st and in next 2 sts—3 sc.

**Rows 2-8:** Ch 1, turn, sc in each st across.

**Row 9:** Ch 1, turn, skip first st, sc in next st, slip st in last st.

Fasten off, leaving a long tail for sewing. Thumb

With right side facing, join **D** with slip st in end of Row 8 of palm on pointer finger side of palm.

**Row 1:** Ch 1, sc in same row end, sc in next 3 row ends—4 sc.

**Rows 2-4:** Ch 1, turn, sc in each st across.

**Row 5:** Ch 1, turn, skip first st, sc in next 2 sts, 2 sc in last st—4 sc.

**Rows 6-8:** Ch 1, turn, sc in each st across.

**Row 9:** Ch 1, turn, skip first st, sc2tog, slip st in last st.

Fasten off, leaving a long tail for sewing. Using photograph as a guide, fold fingers in half and sew to palm. For first emoji, fold fingers to the right side of the palm. For second emoji, fold fingers to the wrong side of the palm.



## FINISHING Pompoms

Following package directions, make 3 pompoms with **G** and 2 pompoms with **B**. Attach pompoms to lower edge of sack, spacing them evenly and alternating colors.

Place snug sack on a flat surface.

### Notes

- If desired, arrange and pin emojis to sack before sewing.
- Insert a magazine inside the sack and behind each emoji as you sew to prevent sewing through both layers of sack.
- Using photograph as a guide, sew emojis to front of snug sack. Sew around entire edge of each emoji to secure to sack.

Weave in any remaining ends.

### ABBREVIATIONS

**A, B, C, etc.** = Color A, B, C, etc.; **ch** = chain; **dc** = double crochet; **hdc** = half double crochet; **sc** = single crochet; **st(s)** = stitch(es); **()** = work directions in parentheses into same st; **[ ]** = work directions in brackets the number of times specified.
