## What you will need:

RED HEART ${ }^{\text {® }}$ Classic $^{\text {TM }}: 5$ skeins 412 Silver A, 3 skeins 334 Tan C, and 2 skeins 12 Black B

Susan Bates ${ }^{\text {® }}$ Crochet Hook: 5.5mm [US I-9]

Yarn needle

GAUGE: $7 \mathrm{dc}=2^{\prime \prime}(5 \mathrm{~cm})$; 3 rows = $2^{\prime \prime}(5 \mathrm{~cm})$. CHECK YOUR GAUGE. Use any size hook to obtain the gauge.

RED HEART ${ }^{*}$ Classic ${ }^{(T M}$, Art. E267 available in solid color 3.5 oz ( 100 g ), 190 yd ( 174 m ), prints \& multicolor 3 oz ( 85 g ), 146 yd ( 134 m ) skeins


## Squares in Stripes Throw

Modern sporty stripes are great for the man of the house or for a son to take with him to the dorm. Crochet it in neutrals or favorite team colors for his relaxation spot.

Throw measures $45^{\prime \prime}$ wide $\times 56$ " long ( $114.5 \times 142 \mathrm{~cm}$ ).

## Notes

Throw is worked back and forth in turned rows. At midpoint (Row 49), order of rows and colors is reversed.

## THROW

With A, ch 145.
Row 1 (right side): Dc in 4th ch from hook (beginning ch count as first dc) and in each ch across, turn-143 dc.
Row 2: Ch 4 (counts as first dc, ch 1 here and throughout), skip next dc, dc in next dc, *ch 1, skip next dc, dc in next dc; repeat from * across, working last dc in top of beginning ch, turn-72 dc and 71 ch-1 spaces.
Row 3: Ch 3 (counts as first dc here and throughout), [dc in next ch-1 space, dc in next dc] 3 times, * ch 1 , skip next ch-1 space, dc in next dc, [dc in next ch-1 space, dc in next dc] 3 times; repeat from * across, working last dc in 3rd ch of beginning ch, turn-126 dc and 17 ch-1 spaces.
Rows 4 and 5: Ch 3, dc in next 6 dc , *ch 1, skip next ch-1 space, dc in next 7 dc; repeat from * across, working last dc in top of beginning ch, turn.
Row 6: Repeat Row 2; change to B.
Row 7: Ch 3, dc in each dc and ch-1 space across, working last dc in 3rd ch of beginning ch; change to C, turn-143 dc.

Rows 8-13: Repeat Rows 2-7; change to A at end of last row.
Rows 14-21: Repeat Rows 2-5 twice.
Rows 22 and 23: Repeat Rows 6 and 7 .
Rows 24-32: Repeat Rows 14-22; change to $\mathbf{B}$ at end of last row.
Rows 33-42: Repeat Rows 13-22; change to $\mathbf{B}$ at end of last row.
Rows 43-48: Repeat Rows 7-12.
Row 49: Repeat Row 7; change to C.
Row 50: Repeat Row 2

Rows 51-54: Repeat Rows 5-2; change
to $\mathbf{B}$ at end of last row.
Row 55: Repeat Row 7; change to A
Row 56: Repeat Row 2.
Rows 57-64: Repeat Rows 5-2 twice; change to $\mathbf{B}$ at end of last row.
Row 65: Repeat Row 7 .
Rows 66-74: Repeat Rows 56-64.
Rows 75-85: Repeat Rows 55-65.
Rows 86-96: Repeat Rows 50-60.
Row 97: Ch 3, dc in each dc and ch-1 space across, working last dc in 3rd ch of beginning ch. Fasten off.

## FINISHING

Weave in ends.

A, B, C = Color A, Color B, Color C, etc.; ch = chain(s); dc = double crochet; st(s) = stitch(es); [ ] = work directions in brackets the number of times specified; * = repeat whatever follows the * as indicated.
