What you will need:

RED HEART* Classic™: 5 skeins 412 Silver C and 4 skeins each 3 Off White A and 1820 Dark Chambray B

Susan Bates® Crochet Hook: 6mm [US J-10]

Yarn needle

GAUGE: 10 sts = 4" (10 cm); 7 rows = 4" (10 cm). CHECK YOUR GAUGE. Use any size hook to obtain the gauge.

Athleisure Striping Throw

Sporty stripes in a cool pattern stitch are perfect for any living area or dorm room space. This crochet throw has a no frills sensibility that can be done in favorite team colors or in fresh new colors that work for you!

Throw measures 46" wide x 60" long (117 x 152.5 cm).

Note

When instructed to work into a V-stitch, insert hook in space between half double crochet stitches of V-stitch.

Special Stitches

reverse sc (reverse single crochet)

= Work single crochet in opposite direction from which you would usually work (left to right if you are right-handed and right to left if you are left-handed). This stitch is also known as crab stitch. It creates a rope-like twisted single crochet edging.

V-st (V-stitch) = 2 hdc in indicated space.

Special Technique

Join with sc = Place a slip knot on hook, insert hook in indicated stitch, yarn over and pull up a loop, yarn over and draw through both loops on hook.

THROW

With A, ch 120.

Row 1 (right side): V-st in 4th ch from hook (beginning ch count as first hdc and first skipped ch), *skip next ch, V-st in next ch; repeat from * across to last 2 ch, skip next ch, hdc in last ch, turn—2 hdc and 58 V-sts. Fasten off.

Row 2: Join B with slip st in first hdc, ch 2 (counts as first hdc here and throughout), V-st in each V-st across, hdc in top of beginning ch, turn.

Row 3: Ch 2, V-st in each V-st across, hdc in top of beginning ch, turn. Fasten off.

Row 4: With A, repeat Row 2. Fasten off. Rows 5 and 6: Repeat Rows 2 and 3. Rows 7-18: Repeat last 3 rows 4 times. Row 19: With A, repeat Row 2. Fasten off.

Row 20: With C, repeat Row 2. Rows 21-37: Repeat Row 3. Do not fasten off until last row is completed.



Row 38: Repeat Row 2. Fasten off.

Row 39: With A, repeat Row 2.

Rows 40-50: Repeat Row 3. Do not fasten off until last row is completed.

Row 51: With C, repeat Row 2.

Row 52: Repeat Row 2.

Rows 53-55: Repeat Row 3. Do not fasten off until last row is completed.

Rows 56 and 57: With **A**, repeat Rows 2 and 3.

Row 58: With **C**, repeat Row 2. Fasten off.

Rows 59-73: Repeat last 3 rows 5 times. Rows 74 and 75: With A, repeat Rows 2 and 3.

Row 76: Repeat Row 2.

Rows 77-85: Repeat Row 3. Do not fasten off until last row is completed.

Row 86: With **A**, repeat Row 2. Fasten off.

Row 87: With C, repeat Row 2.

Rows 88-102: Repeat Row 3. Do not fasten off until last row is completed.

Row 103: Repeat Row 2. Fasten off.

Rows 104 and 105: With **A**, repeat Rows 2 and 3.

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Row 106: Repeat Row 2. Fasten off. Rows 107-120: Repeat last 3 rows 5 times.

Row 121: Repeat Row 2, do not turn. Row 122: Ch 1, reverse sc in every hdc across. Fasten off.

Bottom edging row: With right side of Row 1 facing and working in opposite side of foundation ch, join **A** with sc in last ch, reverse sc in each ch across. Fasten off.

FINISHING

Weave in ends.

ABBREVIATIONS

A, B, C = Color A, Color B, Color C, etc.; **ch** = chain(s); **st(s)** = stitch(es); * = repeat whatever follows the * as indicated.
