



CROCHET SKILL LEVEL EASY

What you will need:

RED HEART[®] Soft[®]: 2 balls each 9251 Coral A: 9010 Charcoal B. 4420 Guacamole C, and 9520 Seafoam D: 3 balls 4601 Off White **E**

Susan Bates[®] Crochet Hook: 5.5mm [US I-9]

Yarn needle

GAUGE: Triangle Motif = 5" (12.5 cm) wide at base and 6" (15cm) tall. CHECK YOUR GAUGE. Use any size hook to obtain the gauge given.

MEDILIM

E728, available in solid color 5 oz (141 g), 256 yd (234 m) and print 4 oz (113 g), 204 yd (187 m) balls

SHOP KIT



Colorful Triangle Throw

If you love playing with color, this is the perfect throw for you! You can make it as bright and lively or as soft and restful as you desire. Playful crochet triangles are arranged in two-color rows and edged and joined with off white.

Throw measures 32 x 50" (81 x 127 cm)

SPECIAL STITCH

sc2tog = [draw up a loop in next st] twice, yarn over and draw through all 3 loops on hook.

TRIANGLE MOTIFS

Make 20 with each A and C, and 24 with each **B** and **D**.

Ch 16.

Row 1 (wrong side): Sc in 2nd ch from hook and each ch to end, turn - 15 sc. Rows 2 and 3 (decrease rows): Ch 1, sc2tog over first 2 sts, sc in each st to end, turn. -13 sc.

Row 4: Ch 1, sc in each st to end, turn.

Rows 5-8 (decrease rows): Repeat Row 2 - 9 sc.

Repeat the last 5 rows twice more - 1 st. Fasten off.

Motif Border

Work border the same way for all 88 Triangle Motifs.

Hold Motif upside down with right side facing, and join **E** with slip st at top right corner:

Round 1: Ch 1, 2 sc in same st as yarn join, sc in each st to next corner, 3 sc in corner st, sc in each row edge to next corner, 5 sc in corner st, sc in each sc to end, sc in same st as yarn join, join round with slip st in first sc. Fasten off.

ASSEMBLY

Arrange Motifs following diagram. With E, and whip stitch Motifs together into 8 strips of 11 triangles each, then whip stitch strips together.

EDGING

With right side facing, join **E** with a slip st anywhere along edge of Throw.

Round 1: Ch 1, sc in same st as yarn join, sc in each sc around, working 2 sc in each corner, join with slip st in first sc.

Round 2: Ch 1 sc in each sc around, working 3 sc in each corner, join with slip st in first sc. Round 3: Ch 1, sc in each sc around, join with slip st in first sc.

Round 4: Ch 1, reverse sc around, join with slip st in first sc. Fasten off.

FINISHING

Weave in ends.

ABBREVIATIONS

ch = chain; **sc** = single crochet; **st(s)** = stitch(es); * or ** = repeat whatever follows the * or ** as indicated.
