Cozy Home Throw

Perfect for any room, this reversible throw is easily personalized using the combination of three colors shown or any colors you wish. You'll reach for its warmth when the weather is cool to keep you feeling nice and cozy.

What you will need:

RED HEART® Comfort®: 2 balls 3180 Lavender **A**, 1 ball each 3151 Navy **B** and 3220 Charcoal **C**

Susan Bates® Crochet Hook:
6.5mm [US K-10½]

Yarn needle

GAUGE: 12 sts = 4" [10 cm]; 8 rows = 4" [10 cm] in pattern st.
CHECK YOUR GAUGE. Use any size hook to obtain the gauge.



RED HEART® Comfort®, Art E707D available in solid color 16 oz (454 g), 867 yds (792 m) and multicolor 12 oz (340 g) 649 yds (593 m) balls

Throw measures 46" x 55" [117 x 140 cm]

NOTE

Throw is worked back and forth in rows from lower edge to top.

SPECIAL ABBREVIATIONS

Fpdc: (front post double crochet) Yo, insert hook from front to back then to front, going around post of indicated st, draw up a loop, [yo and draw through 2 loops on hook] twice. Skip st behind the Fpdc.

Shell: Work 3 dc in same st or space.

THROW

With **A**, ch 130.

Row 1 (Right Side): Working in back loops only, sc in 2nd ch from hook, *ch 1, skip next ch, sc in next ch; repeat from * to end of row; turn – 129 sts; 65 sc and 64 ch-1 spaces.

Row 2: Ch 1, sc in first sc, *ch 1, skip next ch-1 space, sc in next sc; repeat from * to end of row; turn.

Row 3: Ch 3 (counts as dc here and throughout), dc in next ch-1 space and each sc and ch-1 space to end of row; turn.

Row 4: Ch 1, sc in first dc, *ch 1, skip next dc, sc in next dc; repeat from * to end of row; turn. Fasten off.

Row 5 (Right Side): With right side facing, join **B** in first st with slip st, ch 1, sc in first sc, *Fpdc around dc of Row 3, sc in next sc; repeat from * to end of row. Do not turn at end of row. Fasten off.

Row 6 (Right Side): With right side facing, join **A** in first st with a slip st, ch 1, sc in first sc, *ch 1, skip next Fpdc, sc in next sc; repeat from * to end of row; turn.

Row 7: Repeat Row 2.

Row 8: Repeat Row 3.

Row 9: Repeat Row 4.

Row 10: With **C**, repeat Row 5.

Rows 11-14: Repeat Rows 6-9.

Row 15: With **B**, repeat Row 5.

Rows 16-125: Repeat Rows 6-15 – 13 **B** stripes and 12 **C** stripes total.

Rows 126-128: Repeat Rows 6-8. Fasten off.

Border

Round 1: With right side facing and working alongside edge, join **C** in last row with a slip st, sc in same st, [sc 154 sts evenly spaced alongside edge, working sc in each sc row and 2 sc in each dc row, to next corner, turn to work along next edge, (sc, ch 2, sc) in corner dc, sc 126 sts evenly spaced across to next corner, (sc, ch 2, sc) in corner dc] twice, slip st in first sc to join; turn – 568 sc total; 128 sc along top and bottom edges and 156 sc along each side.

Round 2: *[Ch 1, sc in next sc, sc in next sc] to last st before next corner, ch 1, skip next sc, (sc, ch 2, sc) in corner ch-2 space; repeat from * around, slip st in first sc.

Round 3: Sc in each ch-1 space and sc around, working (sc, ch 2, sc) in each corner ch-2 sp, slip st in first sc – 584 sc total; 132 sc along top and bottom edges and 160 sc along each side. Fasten off.

Round 4: With right side facing, join **B** with a slip st in 5th sc to left of right top corner ch-2 space, ch 1, sc in same sc, *skip next sc, shell in next sc, skip next sc, sc in next sc; repeat from * around, working 5 dc in each corner ch-2 space, slip st in first sc.

Round 5: Sc in same sc,*ch 1, (sc, ch 2, sc) in center dc of next shell, ch 1, sc in next sc; repeat from * around, working [ch 1, skip next dc, (sc, ch 2, sc) in next dc, (sc, ch 3, sc) in next dc, (sc, ch 2, sc) in next dc, slip last dc] in each corner 5-dc, slip st in first sc to join. Fasten off.

FINISHING

Weave in ends.

ABBREVIATIONS

A, B, C = Color A, B, C; **ch** = chain; **cm** = centimeters; **dc** = double crochet; Fpdc = Front post double crochet; **mm** = millimeters; **st(s)** = stitch(es); **yo** = yarn over; **[]** = work directions in brackets the number of times specified; *** or **** = repeat whatever follows the * or ** as indicated.
