What you will need:

RED HEART® Stellar™ 8 oz: 4 balls
9932 Universe **A** and 3 balls 9935
Nova **B**

or

RED HEART® Stellar™: 7 balls
9932 Universe **A** and 6 balls 9935
Nova **B**

Susan Bates® Crochet Hook:
9.0mm [US M-13]

Yarn needle

GAUGE: 9 sts in pattern = 4" (10
cm); 6 rows in pattern = 4½" (11.5
cm). **CHECK YOUR GAUGE.**

**Use any size hook to obtain the
gauge.**

SHOP KIT



Shaded Greys Throw

*Choose this soft, lofty yarn with colors that seem
to melt into each other for you next throw. This
cozy yarn has just a hint of sparkle that shows off
beautifully in this easy crochet pattern.*

**Finished Size: 45" x 59" (114.5 cm x 150.5
cm)**

THROW

With **A**, Ch 98.

Row 1 (Wrong Side): Sc in 2nd ch from
hook and next ch, [ch 3, skip next 3 ch, sc in
next 3 ch] 15 times, ch 3, skip next 3 ch, sc
in last 2 ch, ch 1; turn—97 sts.

Row 2 (Right Side): Sc in first sc, skip next
sc, [5 dc in next ch-3 space, skip next sc, sc
in next sc] 15 times, 5 dc in next ch-3 space,
skip next sc, sc in last sc ch 1; turn—17 sc,
80 dc.

Row 3: Sc in first sc, ch 2, skip next dc, [sc
in next 3 dc, ch 3, skip next (dc, sc, dc)] 15
times, sc in next 3 dc, ch 2, skip next dc, sc
in last sc, ch 3 (counts as a dc); turn—50 sc,
2 ch-2 spaces, 15 ch-3 spaces.

Row 4: 2 dc in ch-2 space, [skip next sc, sc in
next sc, skip next sc, 5 dc in next ch-3 space]
15 times, skip next sc, sc in next sc, 2 dc in
next ch-2 space, dc in last sc, ch 1; turn—16
sc, 81 dc.

Row 5: Sc in first 2 dc, [ch 3, skip next (dc,
sc, dc), sc in next 3 dc] 15 times, ch 3, skip
next (dc, sc, dc), sc in next dc and top of ch-
3, ch 1; turn—49 sc, 16 ch-3 spaces.

Rows 6-78: Repeat Rows 2-5 following this
color sequence: [4 rows **B**, 4 rows **A**] 9 times;
with **A** repeat Row 2 once. At the end of
row 78, do not turn and do not fasten off.

Border

With Right Side up, rotate Blanket to work
across side edge of rows. The beginning of
Row 78 is the beginning of the Border.
Continuing with **A**, 5 dc around post of last
dc of Row 76, sc in edge of Row 74, 5 dc
around post of last dc of Row 72, sc in edge

of Row 70; continue working in side edge of
every other row in this manner, ending with
5 dc around post of last dc of Row 4.

Working along bottom edge by inserting
hook into opposite side of foundation ch,
sc in first st, [5 dc in ch-3 space, sc in center
st of next 3 sts] 15 times, 5 dc in next ch-3
space, skip next st, sc in last st.

Working across other side edge of rows, 5 dc
around post of last dc of Row 4, sc in edge
of Row 6, 5 dc around post of last dc of Row
8, sc in edge of Row 10; continue working in
side edge of every other row in this manner,
ending with 5 dc around post of last dc of
Row 76; join with slip st in first sc of Row 78.
Fasten off and weave in ends.

A, B = Color A, Color B; **ch** = chain; **cm**
= centimeters; **dc** = double crochet; **mm**
= millimeters; **sc** = single crochet; **st(s)**
= stitch(es); **()** = work all directions in
parentheses in the indicated stitch or space;
[] = work directions in brackets the number
of times specified; *** or **** = repeat whatever
follows the * or ** as indicated.



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
