What you will need:
RED HEART ${ }^{\oplus}$ With Love ${ }^{\oplus}$ : 5 skeins (35 0z) 1546 Iris

Susan Bates ${ }^{\circledR}$ Crochet Hook: 8 mm [L-11 US]

Yarn needle
GAUGE: 10 sts = 4" (10 cm); 8 rows $=4^{\prime \prime}(10 \mathrm{~cm})$. CHECK YOUR GAUGE. Use any size hook to obtain the gauge given. $70 z$ (198g), 370 yd (338m) and multicolor $50 z$ (141g), 230 yd (211m) skeins


## Lazy Waves Throw

Here's the perfect throw for any room! Simply choose a color that you'll love to relax with and crochet away! The interesting coiled post stitches add a nice chevron texture.

Throw measures 45 " ( 114 cm ) wide $\times 54$ " ( 137 cm ) long.

## NOTES

1. Throw is worked back and forth in alternating rows of double crochet and single crochet.
2. Front post coil stitch is staggered across double crochet rows to create the appearance of waves.
3. When instructed to work into a stitch or space " 2 rows below", work into the row numbered 2 less than the current row. For example, if you are working Row 5, a stitch " 2 rows below" is in Row $5-2$ = Row 3.

## Special Stitch

Front Post Coil St (FPcs) = Yarn over, insert hook from front to back and then to front again around post of indicated stitch, yarn over and pull up loop, [yarn over, insert hook from front to back and then to front again around post of same stitch] twice (7 loops on hook), [yarn over and pull through 2 loops on hook] 6 times.

## THROW

## Ch 109.

Row 1 (right side): Dc in 3rd ch from hook (beginning ch counts as first dc) and in each ch across, turn-107 dc.
Row 2 and all even-numbered rows: Ch 1, sc in each st, turn.
Row 3: Ch 2 (counts as first dc here and throughout), dc in each st, turn.
Row 5: Ch 2, FPcs around the post of next dc 2 rows below, *dc in each of next 7 sts, FPcs around the post of next dc 2 rows below; repeat from * across to last st, dc in last st, turn-14 FPcs; 93 dc.

Row 7: Ch 2, dc in each of next 7 sts, FPcs around the post of next dc 2 rows below, *dc in each of next 7 sts, FPcs around the post of next dc 2 rows below; repeat from * across to last 2 sts, dc in each of last 2 sts, turn-13 FPcs; 94 dc .
Row 9: Ch 2, dc in each of next 6 sts, FPcs around the post of next dc 2 rows below, *dc in each of next 7 sts, FPcs around the post of next dc 2 rows below; repeat from * across to last 3 sts, dc in each of last 3 sts, turn.
Row 11: Ch 2, dc in each of next 5 sts, FPcs around the post of next dc 2 rows below, *dc in each of next 7 sts, FPcs around the post of next dc 2 rows below; repeat from * across to last 4 sts, dc in each of last 4 sts, turn.
Row 13: Ch 2, dc in each of next 4 sts, FPcs around the post of next dc 2 rows below, *dc in each of next 7 sts, FPcs around the post of next dc 2 rows below; repeat from * across to last 5 sts, dc in each of last 5 sts, turn.
Row 15: Ch 2, dc in each of next 3 sts, FPcs around the post of next dc 2 rows below, *dc in each of next 7 sts, FPcs around the post of next dc 2 rows below; repeat from * across to last 6 sts, dc in each of last 6 sts, turn.
Row 17: Ch 2, dc in each of next 2 sts, FPcs around the post of next dc 2 rows below, *dc in each of next 7 sts, FPcs around the post of next dc 2 rows below; repeat from * across to last 7 sts , dc in each of last 7 sts , turn.
Row 19: Ch 2, dc in first st, FPcs around the post of next dc 2 rows below, *dc in each of next 7 sts, FPcs around the post of next dc 2 rows below; repeat from * across to last 8 sts, dc in each of last 8 sts, turn.
Row 21: Repeat Row 5.
Row 23: Repeat Row 19.
Row 25: Repeat Row 17.
Row 27: Repeat Row 15.

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## FINISHING

Weave in ends
